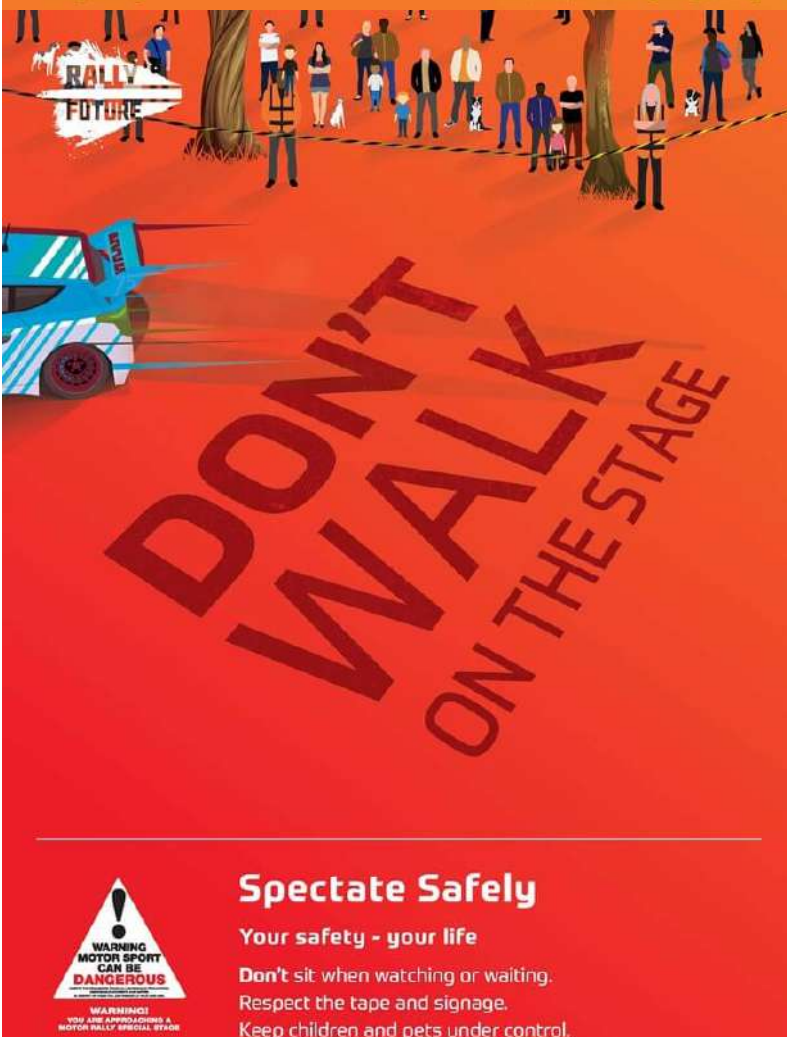

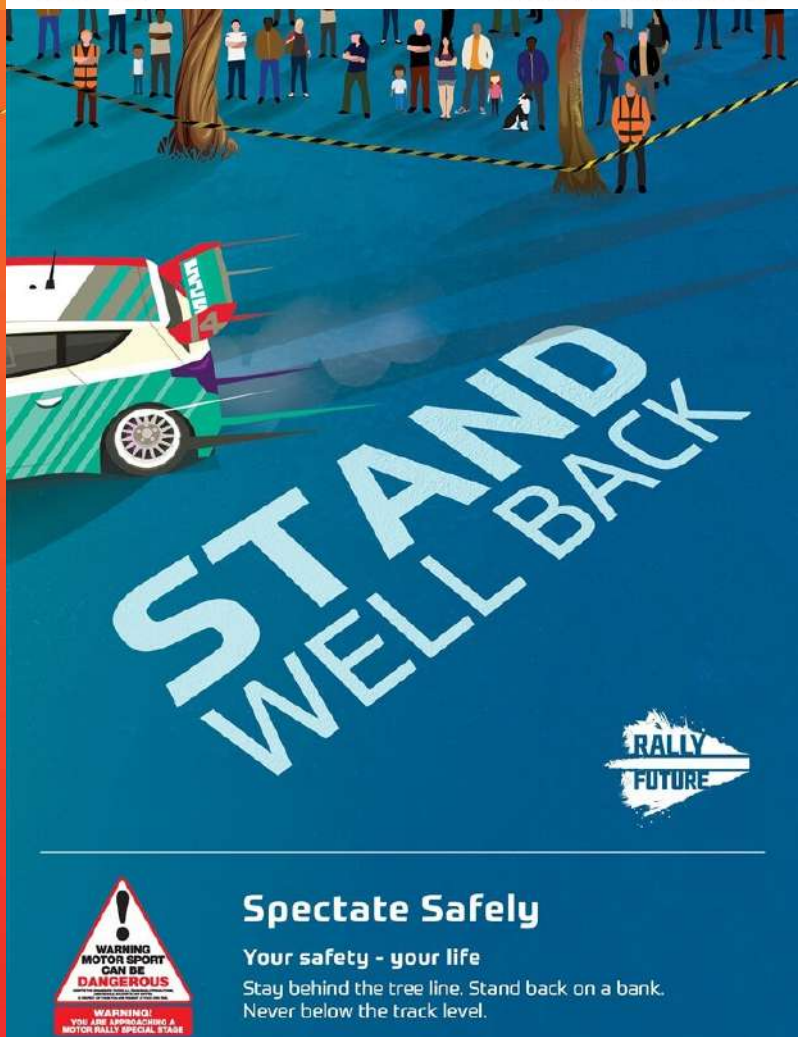

#### **Junction 11**

This will be the main spectator area and will have catering facilities and toilets. To reach the Spectator area, from Pickering head east along the A170 to Ebberston. At the crossroads turn left and head north. Follow the road for approximately 5 miles until you reach the Forest Drive. Continue along the Forest Drive to Bickley and at the phone box turn left. From here follow the 'Spectator' arrows. Please adhere to the one way system and exit the forest via Birch Hall.

#### **Junction 10**

From Pickering head north towards Newton-on-Rawcliffe for 4 miles and continue through the village towards Stape. Keep right at the top of Stape bank and follow the road down the other side. Continue through Stape down the hill, following the road round to left at the bottom. Continue up the hill, and enter the forest on the right hand side. Spectator points will then be arrowed once in the forest.

### Junction 10

From Pickering head west along the A170 towards Kirkbymoorside and turn right towards Wrelton. Continue through Wrelton to the village of Cropton. In Cropton follow the road round to the left and down Cropton Bank for approximately 1.5 miles. The entrance to the forest is on the right hand side, signposted 'Spiers House Caravan and Camping.' The spectator point will be arrowed from here.
