COMPETITOR INFORMATION

Item 1: Recce Briefing

The roads are not closed for reconnaissance. Please, keep to the left at all times and drive with your headlights on.

To get the most out of doing reconnaissance we suggest that you maintain a distance of 50 to 100m between cars. This enables you to have an unimpeded view of the road ahead of you.

Please observe a maximum speed limit of 80km/hr in stage, and don't stop unless you have to e.g. to change a tyre. We are going to split the field into two groups, Cars 1 to 20 will enter first, followed a few minutes later by cars 21 to 49. Please obey all road rules during touring, particularly after SS13 through to SS15.

We are touring through parts of the Millbrook stage and the residents are not expecting us. Please observe a maximum speed of 60km/hr through this gravel area on both Friday recce and Sunday event.

Pohe Island SSS9/10 will now be reced on Friday 8th November.

Competitors are to assemble at the Service Out Control or TC 0 as per the diagram on Page 21 of the roadbook.

As per the Competitor Information we will convoy in groups of 10 to travel through the start. Note that cars are not to stop on the roadway.

So in summary:

- Stay alert on the roads
- Don't get distracted
- Keep to the left
- Don't cross the centre line
- Observe the speed limits.
