It is recommended that in addition to retaining a copy of this bulletin all parties modify the text of the regulations according to the following:

Item 1. **Supplementary Regulations Article 3. Major Officials**, Motorsport NZ Steward

Remove Wayne Scott and **replace** with Adam Simmons

Reason to advise a change of Officials

Item 2. **Supplementary Regulations Article 5.9 New competitors briefing**

Change of time, now to be held on Friday 12th May 1500hrs.

Reason to advise the change of time

Item 3. **Supplementary Regulations Article 18.2 Finish Procedures**, NZRC Cat 5A, 5B and One Day Competitors

The finish of the rally for Day One only competitors will now be the Stop control SSS10 Pohe Island 2.

Reason to advise change of final control.

Item 4. **Supplementary Regulations Article 18.7 Rejoins**

Delete- TC10D – exit TC from Service Park

Replace with - TC10B – Exit TC Overnight Parc Ferme

Delete- A competitor who rejoins shall not feature in the final results as per Sch R, Part One, Art 27, of the current MSNZ Manual. Allcomers Competitors who finish Leg 1 at TC8A will rejoin at TC8C and be classified in the final results.

Replace with- A competitor who rejoins after submitting a Temporary Withdrawl, shall not feature in the final results as per Sch R, Part One, Art 27, of the current MSNZ Manual.

Allcomers and NZRC Cat 5A, 5B, and 5C Competitors who finish Leg 1 at the Stop Control of SSS10 will rejoin at TC10B and be classified in the final results.
