## 1. Authority

1.1 – The Event shall be known as “Copyworld SA Autocross Championship + WalkyPark Rallysprint & Regularity” and hereafter referred to as “the Event” and will be a State Championship/Series Autocross & Multi-Club Rallysprint/Regularity Event.

1.2 – The Promoter of the event is Walkerville All Cars Club

1.3 – The event will be conducted under:

- The International Sporting Code of the FIA.
- The National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia.
- The Speed and Non-Speed Event Standing Regulations.
- The Motorsport Australia Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy the Motorsport Australia Come and Try Policy.
- The [Walky Park 2024 Series Regulations](#) as available on the WACC Facebook, Website and Sportivity App (Virtual Noticeboard)
- These Supplementary Regulations and any further Supplementary Regulations or Bulletins which may be issued.
- The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).
- Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

### 3. Event Program & Distance

3.1 – The event will be run as per the schedule in the [Walky Park 2024 Series Regulations](#) (Section 1 Article 4 - Page 7)

3.2 – As per Section 1, Article 20, 20.2 to 20.4

The event will be divided into three categories: Rallysprint, AutoCross & Regularity with each group running in the order as listed.

3.3. – Autocross will have a maximum stage distance of 4km, The RallySprint will have a maximum stage distance of 8km. No stage will be less than 900m in any category. The event will have between 4 & 14 runs.

### 4. Electric and Hybrid Vehicles

WACC is pleased to be a leader in providing a sustainable path into gravel motorsports both now and into the future by facilitating the ability for Electric and Hybrid vehicles hereafter referred to as “EV” to run at Walky Park

4.1 - Prior to any new EV competing WACC must have access to the appropriate Emergency Response Guides.

4.2 - If your EV is not on the list below, please contact the series coordinator prior to entering your first event so that WACC can get the appropriate Emergency Response Guides before your first event.

4.3 - Current list of EV's that WACC has Emergency Response Guides for:

- Mitsubishi Outlander PHEV

4.4 - At the first event for any new EV the EV must present to the area in front of Brian Shultz Shed no later than 07:45 so that a familiarization session can be had with all officials. This is a requirement to ensure the safety of our officials so that they can be briefed on the EV's specific safety systems.

### 5. Catering

5.1 – Breakfast and Lunch will be available on Sunday

5.2 – Complimentary food & drinks will be provided for all officials.

5.3 – **This is a CASH-FREE EVENT.** We offer multiple alternative payment methods, including EFTPOS; however, cash transactions will not be accepted on the day.

## 6. Media

6.1 – WACC Strongly encourages Accredited Media to attend our events, it is up to the Photographer, Videographer or Drone Pilot hereafter all referred to as “Media” to ensure that they have the correct accreditations from Motorsport Australia before attending.

6.2 – Non-Accredited media are also welcome at WACC Events but must remain within the Pits Area and Public viewing areas only.

6.3 – Media are expected to follow the rules and stipulations as laid out in section 30 of the 2023 Walky Park Series Regulations.

6.4 – The use of drones at this event has been authorized as per the series regulations to the following accredited pilots: Ellie Brice & Tamara Brice

## 7. Camping

7.1 – Camping at the Venue is encouraged, and the venue will be open from Friday night until Sunday evening.

7.2 – There are 24/7 toilet facilities, but no showers. There is no electricity available once the generator is turned off.

7.3 – Please contact the Secretary or [walkypark@wacc.asn.au](mailto:walkypark@wacc.asn.au) for further details if you intend to Camp.



## 8. Walky Park Series Regulations

8.1 – Please read the relevant sections of the [Walky Park Series Regulations](#) in conjunction with these Supplementary Regulations.

8.2 – Competitors will be expected to have read the following relevant sections for this Event:

- Section 1: General Regulations – All Events
- Section 2: Rallysprint Specific Regulations – RallySprint Competitors Only
- Section 3: Rally Regularity Specific Regulations - Regularity Competitors Only
- Section 4: Autocross Specific Regulations – AutoCross Competitors Only
- Section 7: End of Year Awards
- Section 8: Entry Fees and Details

8.3 – This Round does not have a Khanacross or RallySkills component, therefore Competitors have been advised that Section 5 and Section 6 will not apply to this event.

8.4 – No navigators, co-drivers, or passengers are allowed in Autocross at Walky Park, except for juniors who were under the age of 18 on 01/01/2024. Juniors entered in the Autocross component of the event may carry an approved WACC coach for instruction and safety at any time, including during timed runs, at the request of either the Junior or their parent or guardian. — **This rule supersedes Section 4, Article 2, 2.6 of the [Walky Park Series Regulations](#)**

8.5 – In relation to 8.4 when carrying a Coach/Instructor the coach must be either an experienced competitor, a parent/guardian that is approved by the CoC or alternatively the holder of a Motorsport Australia Coaching License – **Any competitor who is entered in the Championship or Series and is also Instructing/Coaching a Junior must have completed their timed run prior to being a passenger.**

8.6 – RallySprint competitors both Drivers and Navigators will only be required to hold a Motorsport Australia Speed License — **This rule supersedes Section 2, Article 2, 2.1 & 2.2 of the [Walky Park Series Regulations](#)**

8.7 – Where there is any divergence between the current Motorsport Australian Manual of Motorsport, the current SA AutoCross Sporting Regulations, the Walky Park Series Regulations, and these Supplementary Regulations. The Walky Park Series Regulations and the event Supplementary Regulations, Further Regulations and or Bulletins will take precedence.

8.8 – The CoC will chose tracks from the Walky Park Autocross & Rallysprint track license documents and run the tracks as per the requirements of those documents as approved by Motorsport Australia.

**8.9 - Competitors who wish to enter both the Rallysprint and Autocross will be seeded in the RallySprint Category. If a chosen layout for RallySprint competitors exceeds 4km the flying start location for the RallySprint and Autocross may be at different points along the course to maintain compliance with Autocross Regulations. In such case competitors who are dual entered will be timed for both distances and receive results in both categories**

8.10 – RallySprint and Regularity Flying Start and Finish will be indicated by an orange cone with a pink pool noodle on top. Autocross Flying Start and Finish will be indicated by an orange cone with a blue pool noodle on top.



## 9. Entry Details - Price

9.1 – Entries for this event will close on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> of July at 22:00 (10PM)

9.2 – Entry Fees for this event will be as follows:

- **\$150.00 – SA Autocross Championship/Series – Adult & Junior**
- **\$130.00 – Multi-Club RallySprint or Regularity Only**
- **\$75.00 – Multi-Club RallySprint Juniors - U18 on 01/01/2024**

9.2 - Competitors who wish to enter both the SA Autocross & Multi-Club RallySprint are only required to pay a single fee of \$150.00

9.3 - Navigators must complete an entry form on the portal otherwise they will be treated as noncompetitive passengers. – The entry cost for navigators is included as part of the driver's entry fee.

9.3 – [Entry will be via the Motorsport Australia Event Portal.](#)

## 10. Passengers, Navigators/Co-Drivers

10.1 – Adult AutoCross Competitors may not carry Passengers, Navigators or Co-Drivers

10.2 – RallySprint Competitors may carry noncompetitive passengers on any run.

10.3 – RallySprint Competitors may have a Navigator/Co-Driver but are not required to have one.

10.4 – Regulatory competitors MUST have a Navigator.

10.5 – Passengers can be carried on all runs by all competitors except those excluded in 10.1 but when carrying passengers, drivers must abide by the motorsport Australia passenger ride policy and the rules as laid out in Section 1, Article 33, 33.1 – 33.10 of the Walky Park Series Regulations.

10.6 – Navigators/Co-Drivers Must be entered using the Motorsport Australia Portal as only Navigators/Co-Drivers with a valid entry in the portal will receive points in the club championship.

**10.7 – RallySprint and Regularity Navigators wishing to receive points in the championship must collect a timecard from Ellie Brice prior to the start of competition.**

## 11. Regularity

11.1 – Due to the nature of the venue and tightness of tracks the average speed target times of 62 – 68kph proved unachievable at Round 1 and had to be lowered.

11.2 – Target times will be included in the front of the PDF issued roadbook and all target times will have an average speed between 48kph and 68kph. — **This rule supersedes Section 3, Article 1, 2.12 of the [Walky Park Series Regulations](#)**

11.3 – Regularity Navigators will be required to check in using supplied time cards as would be expected at a full rally event on the correct minuet with the nominated control person as per Section 7 Article 4 4.1- 4.3 of the [Walky Park Series Regulations](#)

11.4 – The nominated control person for check in will be Ellie Brice.

11.5 – This will be the first event using timecards at Walky Park so we ask for patience while we iron out any bugs, and look forward to feedback on how to improve the process.



## 11. Sportity

11.1 – All event documentation and forms will be available on the event virtual notice board - Sportity APP and website, this will be the primary source of information pre-event, post-event and throughout and will be used at all events this season.
