

## Questions and answers from both Competitors' Briefings

Q. Is it allowed to read the stage diagrams from an Ipad instead of printing?

A. **No.** NCR 7.2.22.17 and 18 *"Information devices ... mounted within the cockpit must use a mechanical means of attachment sufficiently robust to withstand anticipated stresses and vibration and must not present any sharp edges or projections in the vicinity of the Driver's or Passenger's body or helmet. Where possible a secondary means of attachment should also be used. Suction mounts are not acceptable as the primary mounting method"*

Q. Will the window number stickers also be for sale?

A. We are providing the yellow numbers for rear windows at no charge.

Q. Are competition numbers required to be fitted before scrutineering?

A. **Yes**

Q. Can we leave cars securely on site on Saturday evening without the owner being on site?

Q. Can we leave cars un-securely on Saturday night?

A. There will be a single security man on-site. We cannot guarantee security. You may leave vehicles at Cadwell Park overnight Saturday/Sunday at your own risk.

Q. The virtual board thing you get times off at the event, my phone has absolutely no signal there? is there somewhere I can get the info? I don't do technology

A. **No.** Results will be on the results providers' web-site. We would hope that at least one member of each team has a smart phone and can use a web-browser. There are mobile phone cell sites at Cadwell Park and our previous experience has been a good signal on all networks.

Q. Could you confirm where to upload the documents tyre declaration, etc?

A. See page 4 of the Road Book

Q. What is the latest time competitors have to be in the venue on Sunday morning?

A. We recommend aiming to be on-site for 08:00 there may well be heavy spectator traffic and queues at the circuit entrance.

Q. Is the tyre form to be printed by us, or provided at rally HQ?

A. We shall issue the tyre form to you – there is no need for you to print it.

Q. Will you actually be penalising for hitting stage furniture?

A. If hitting stage furniture is reported to us by our marshals, then yes, we shall apply penalties,

Q. can we just turn up for scrutineering on Saturday if booked for Sunday

A. Yes, **but not the other way round**. If you have not said you want Sunday scrutineering, but then find you do, you need to get in touch with us. Sunday scrutineering is strictly limited by the available time.
