This Bulletin deals primarily with key information needed after arriving at Brands Hatch and complements information in Bulletin One and the Supplementary Regulations.

The following Supplementary Regulations are amended:

#### SR 8 Championships:

#### **SR13 DOCUMENTATION / SIGNING ON**

Motorsport UK-issued electronic competition licences and associated QR codes are acceptable.

Anyone who does have a competition licence issued but is unable to produce it will be referred to the Motorsport UK Steward who should be able to check validity.

Signing on should be completed on-line where possible but can be done in-person at event documentation in exceptional circumstances.

#### SR14.5 Brands Hatch Access Tickets

Six MSV-issued tickets for each crew were sent at the weekend to the registered email address for each co-driver - these give venue access on Saturday morning. We are aware of some issues with business / corporate email systems rejecting these messages so please first check your junk mail folders and then contact the Event Secretary for replacements to be sent to an alternative email address (ideally personal, eg gmail).

Access to the service area is restricted to competing and service vehicles. Any additional crew vehicles can be parked in the trailer parking area above the scrutineering bay - see map in Bulletin One. The Vehicle Pass included in this bulletin must be used to gain access past the Kentagon Gate on Saturday.

#### SR 21.4 Tyres

Motorsport UK and Chelmsford Motor Club take their environmental and sustainability accreditations very seriously and require a self-declaration of tyres used to be made online through the Damage Declaration form - link is in the Road Book. This must be completed by all competitors, even if you are unfortunate enough to retire from the event.

The maximum number of tyres the event is permitted to allow by Motorsport UK is 12 (NCR Ch13 App.16 Art 7.11). Where there is significantly heavy rainfall the Clerk of the Course may issue a Competitor Bulletin through Sportity (and communicated during the rally) declaring a 'wet' event, the use of wet tyres will be permitted outside of the specified allowance on the grounds of safety.

Please help us evaluate our environmental impact and your compliance by recording the quantity and approximate wear of all tyres used.
