

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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Preamble

BAUHAUS ROYAL RALLY OF SCANDINAVIA 2024 will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations (RRSR), the National Sporting Regulations which comply with the FIA regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and the WADA/NADA Codes and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations shall apply. Modifications, amendments and/or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated Bulletins (issued by the organiser or the Stewards). Additional information will be published in Rally Guide, issued on 21 May.

2.10 General / Communication

During the event, individual and general communication between all rally officials (rally control/CoC, rally secretariat, CRO, Stewards, technical staff etc.) and the competitors/crew members will primarily and as far as possible be conducted electronically (Cellphone, Email, Sportity, WhatsApp).

For this purpose, each competitor is required to nominate one official representative, who shall be authorised for the purpose of receiving any official notifications. As some of these notifications can be issued while rally cars are on stages, this person can neither be the driver nor the co-driver. This person should be a team representative who will be based in the service park during the event.

4 ENTRIES

4.1 Closing date for entries

The closing date for entries is Tuesday 28th May at 23:59 (CET).

4.2 Entry procedure

Drivers wishing to participate in BAUHAUS ROYAL RALLY OF SCANDINAVIA 2024 must register on the FIA's online platform before the entries closing date. Priority drivers must complete the electronic form available at the WEBSITE: https://registrations.fia.com/rally

Non-priority drivers must complete the electronic form available at the WEBSITE:

https://registrations.fia.com/ercswe





Please note that the FIA registration platform requires a user ID and a password to access the entry system. The FIA will need time to register you in the system and open your user account. Please do not wait until the last moment to make your entry in order not to miss the entry closing date. The user account application is available through a link on the registration page stated above.

The entry will only be accepted if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee. To be accepted, competitors must send a proof of payment of the entry fee by e-mail with the VAT-number of the company (if paid by such) to competitor@ercroyalrally.com

by the closing date of entries. Foreign drivers must submit an approval from their ASN in the same e-mail.

4.3 Number of competitors accepted and classes

4.3.1 Number of competitors

The number of entrants is limited to 80 cars. If more than 80 entries are received, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

4.3.2 Participation of rally cars

For participation of rally cars, the article 12 of RRSR will be followed.

4.4.4 Private competitor, non-priority RC4 / RC5

Private competitor = The Competitor is the driver or the co-driver (with an International Competitor's licence).

Non-priority drivers from Sweden and Norway, with the car entered by the driver or the co-driver (with an International Competitor's licence)

4.4.10 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- a) to candidates whose entry has not been accepted.
- b) in case of the rally not taking place.

The organisers may refund part of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reason of "force majeure" (duly certified by their ASN), are unable to start in the rally. This must be applied for in writing giving the reason for the claim including bank and account details.

4.6 Documents required for Administrative Checks

When sending the online registration entry form to the FIA, the competitors are also required to send the following documents to competitor@ercroyalrally.com by 9 June at the latest.





The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by:

- Proof of payment of the total amount of entry fees (incl. VAT)
- Copies of the Competitor and Driver and Co-driver competition licences
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver driving licences
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver passports or Identity cards
- Driver's declaration and undertakings forms, signed by the driver and the co-driver
- ASN authorisation, where applicable
- One promotional photo for driver and co-driver
- First page of the car homologation papers with the number, group and cylinder capacity
- Copies of the car's registration papers
- Copies of the insurance cover (third parties) for the rally car (Green Card)
- Certificate of completion for the FIA eLearning Course on FIA Safety Tracking Device
- Copy of the entry form duly signed
- Copy of On-board camera Authorisation (where requested see RRSR Art. 18.1)

By sending the signed entry form, the competitor and the crew submit themselves to the sporting jurisdictions specified in the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the 2024 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations (RRSR Art. 22.5).

According to Art. 3.9.4 of the Code, foreign competitors (drivers and co-drivers) need to present their ASN (National Sporting Authority) authorisation giving permission to participate in BAUHAUS Royal Rally of Scandinavia 2024.

5 INSURANCE

Eligible for the rally including Qualifying stage/Shakedown.

5.1 Traffic Insurance

All cars participating in the rally must have a valid obligatory traffic insurance towards third parties. In Sweden, the "Green Card" (International Motor Insurance Card) system is applied. For cars coming from countries outside the Green Card system and EEA-countries, a Nordic frontier insurance must be taken at the border. Traffic insurance guarantee competitor's cover for civil responsibility towards third parties on road sections. The organiser will issue third party insurance cover for foreign registered cars valid on special stages (incl. shakedown).

5.2 Insurance amounts

Maximum compensation in case of damage is SEK 300 000 000.

Maximum compensation regarding organiser liability insurance is SEK 125 000 000.

5.3 Limitation of Indemnity

The organiser declines any liability concerning the consequences caused by any fraudulent action taken by the competitor, may this be against the rules and regulations of the rally or against the laws of the country.

Any service vehicles or reconnaissance cars, even those bearing the official identification of the organiser, may under no circumstances be considered as official participants of the rally, hence their insurance policies remain the sole responsibility of the owner.





6 ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Restrictions

Advertising for tobacco, tobacco products and smokers' requisites is forbidden in Sweden. Advertising for alcohol is restricted by law and is not allowed on competing cars, service cars, equipment and/or clothing.

6.2 The organiser's advertising

The organiser's advertising on the doors and roof plate will be BAUHAUS.

6.3 Identification

Competition numbers and rally plates according to the 2024 FIA RRSR, Art. 27, will be provided by the organiser. See also Appendix 4.

Numbers and plates must be affixed on the rally car before the car is brought to scrutineering and must be visible throughout the duration of the rally.

The following stickers will be affixed to the car by the scrutineers:

At scrutineering:

A check card, size 6 cm x 6 cm (at roll-cage driver's side)

Before the start for Section 1:

A "2 minutes" sticker (on the roof over the windscreen, co-driver's side) on cars with a start interval of 2 minutes.

7 TYRES

All tyres must comply with Art. 13 of the RRSR in conjunction with Appendix V of the RRSR.

7.1.1 Tyres for all ERC1, ERC3 and ERC4 priority competitors

Tyres must be supplied by an FIA-nominated tyre company. A list of nominated tyre manufacturers for the FIA European Rally Championship is published on https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/117

7.1.2 Tyres for Junior ERC Championship

For the Junior ERC Championship, only Hankook tyres, sold at the rallies by the Junior ERC Championship tyre supplier, are eligible.

A driver may use only those tyres that have been registered for his car. Any tyre registered for a driver at a previous rally must be presented at the tyre supplier for checking and new registration before it can be used on a rally by the same driver.

Competitors registered for the Junior ERC Championship must use the following type of tyres:

7.2 Quantities of tyre

The quantities of tyres for use during the rally by all drivers are as follows:

The maximum quantity for Junior ERC drivers for whole event is 12 tyres to be chosen from the list below:

For competitors eligible to take part in Qualifying, tyres will be taken from the overall quantity, except the spare wheel(s) fitted in the car.

For Free Practice and Shakedown tyres will not count for the overall quantity.

7.3 Tyre Marking

Only tyres marked by the Scrutineers may be used. Any infringement to this rule will be reported to the Stewards.

7.3.1 Tyre marking locations

- At the Qualifying stage (Technical Zone between the TC and Start)
- After TC 0
- After TC 1C, 5C, 9E and 13C

7.3.2 Tyres checking

Tyres will be checked for their conformity during the rally.

7.4 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

Free tyres for gravel.

8 FUEL

Fuel must be in compliance with Appendix J art. 252.9 (RRSR art 62)

For environmental and safety reasons, all competitors must refuel in the designated refuel areas. Except as detailed in the regulations for the change of fuel tank, RRSR art 58.

8.1 Fuel restrictions for Junior ERC

Competitors in the Junior ERC Championship are allowed to use only pump filling station fuel (gasoline type 98) from the following petrol station:

Service crews are allowed to fill this fuel in their cans or drums and refuel Junior ERC cars in designated Refuelling Areas.





8.2 Refuelling

8.2.1 Refuelling Areas

Except as detailed in Art. 58 of FIA RRSR, competitors may refuel only in the designated Refuelling Areas and commercial filling stations marked in the Road Book.

8.2.2 Refuelling procedure

Solely for the purpose of assisting with the refuelling procedure of their car, two team members of each crew with the team passes may access the Refuelling Area. In order to access the Refuel area, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava.

Engines must be switched off throughout the refuelling operation. It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling. At the Refuel area, the competitor is responsible to protect the ground with an Environmental mat which shall be composed of an absorbent upper part and an impermeable lower part.

8.3 Commercial filling stations

There will not be any options to use commercial filling stations during this rally.

8.4 Refuelling during the Rally

Refuel area will be as follows:

Thursday 13 June Service park 09:00 – 15:00 and 17:00 – 19:00

Friday 14 June Service park (after TC 1C and 5C)

Remote refuel Södra Ås after SS 3 and 7

Saturday 15 June Service park (after TC 9E and 13C)

Remote refuel Ölmhult after SS 11 and 15

9 RECONNAISSANCE

See also Art. 35 in the 2024 RRSR.

9.1 Procedure for reconnaissance registration

The competitor must send the organiser in advance an information form (see Website/Rally Guide) to competitor@ercroyalrally.com, including details of the reconnaissance car, mobile phone number and place where the competitor is accommodated.

The form must be signed and submitted by Tuesday 4 June 2024 at 23.59 CET at the latest.

All reconnaissance and rally materials may be collected by the nominated competitor representative, holding a written proxy as follows:

Administrative checks will be carried out at the same time as registration for recce.

Identification numbers, given at the registration, shall be affixed on the car (windscreen at the top corner, co-drivers side) and kept visible for the duration of the reconnaissance period.





9.2 Participation in reconnaissance only

Any driver holding an appropriate international licence but not entered in the rally may apply to take part in the reconnaissance. The regulations on reconnaissance must be respected in their entirety. A registration form for this purpose will be sent on request. The final permission for taking part in recce is left to the discretion of the organiser. An administrative fee will be charged (see 4.4.7 Reconnaissance Only).

9.3 Tracking system for reconnaissance

All competitors must make one IOS or Android smartphone available and equip their reconnaissance cars with a smartphone-based application RS Lite developed by the FIA official supplier STATUS AWARNESS SYSTEM (SAS). SAS will distribute individual event access codes during the reconnaissance registration.

9.4 Specific and national restrictions

9.4.1 Passages

Crews are authorised to drive a maximum of 2 times through each special stage in accordance with the schedules given in Appendix 2. The special stages must be driven in the same direction as the rally, at a reduced speed and fully respecting the Traffic Laws. All special stages are run twice during the rally but may only be driven as one stage during recce. All passages through the special stages will be recorded by the marshals. Timecards will not be used.

9.4.2 Speed limits

The maximum speed allowed during reconnaissance is 70 km/h on special stages, unless another speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or by written instructions in the Road Book (or in Bulletins). All crews are reminded of Art. 34.2 in the RRSR.

10 ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Document checks will be done online, before the event, but original documents along with the duly signed entry form must be brought to the administrative checks.

Notwithstanding the RRSR, Art. 30.1, drivers and co-drivers are not required to report personally to the administrative checks.

11.2 Mud flaps

Fitting of transversal mud flaps (all wheels) is mandatory in conformity with Appendix J, Art. 252.7.7.

11.3 Windows

Silvered or tinted films are allowed on rear and rear side windows only (Appendix J, Art. 253.11). Antishatter film must be used according to the same article. Window nets are not allowed.

11.4 Drivers' safety equipment

At scrutineering competitors must produce all items of clothing including helmets and head restraints intended to be used. Condition of the equipment and compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III will be checked. Also, see Appendix 5 of these Supplementary Regulations for safety information.

11.5 Noise level

At any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with Appendix J. See also RRSR Art. 18.3.

11.6 FIA Safety tracking device (RRSR Art. 18.2 and 53.2.1)

All competitors must make provisions in their rally cars for the installation of the FIA Safety Emergency Console System, and the system must be installed before the car is brought to scrutineering. For installation and operating instructions see Appendix 6.

Systems may be collected either by the crew or a representative.

No deposit will be collected for the rally safety tracking equipment, but all the damage caused will be invoiced afterwards.

The FIA Safety Emergency Console System devices must be removed in the final parc fermé. They must be returned no later than 20:00 on Saturday 15 June to STATUS AWARNESS SYSTEM (SAS) at the HQ. Should a crew retire, the equipment must be returned immediately to SAS.

11.7 Sealing (RRSR, Art. 16)

Sealing of the cars will be carried out according to RRSR Art. 16. Therefore, all underbody protection must be removed for scrutineering, but must be kept with the car for weight checks.

Car's chassis and cylinder block will also be marked (RRSR, Art. 31.1.6). Sealing wires must be installed according to the instructions given.

After pre-rally scrutineering, any change of sealed component must be notified by the competitor to the following e-mail: erc-technical@fia.com. This notification must be received prior to the change of part.

11.8 Homologation forms (RRSR, Art. 31.1.4)

All cars must have available a complete certified homologation form (the Code, Appendix J, Art. 251.2.1.8) at scrutineering. In addition, homologation forms for the catalytic converter and roll cage (if homologated), and any certificate for the safety fuel cell must be with the car at scrutineering.

11.9 On-board Cameras (RRSR, Art. 18)

Competitors wishing to use an on-board camera must apply via the ERC Accreditation Portal at least one week before the start of reconnaissance.

Authorised cameras will be identified by an adhesive decal and must be mounted in the car at the time of scrutineering. The fixings of the camera and camera recorder must comply with Appendix J, Art.253.2.





11.10 National and specific regulations

Competing cars must be equipped with two first aid kits and one reflective triangle.

12 OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 Driver's Safety briefing

It is mandatory that all drivers and co-drivers who participate in ERC 2024 must complete the FIA eLearning course and pass the assessment for the FIA Safety Tracking Device by Sunday 9 June. Certificate of the passes course must be sent to rally office by email to competitor@ercroyalrally.com See Appendix 7 for more details.

12.2 Organisers promotional activities

PR activities will take place for selected drivers on Wednesday 12 June from 18:00 in the city center of Karlstad. Information will be taken directly with the team.

12.3 Meet the crews sessions

Meet the crews session will be at Ceremonial start, BAUHAUS and in Service Park during service. Nominated crews for each session will be notified by the National Press Officer.

12.4 Time Card

Time cards will be issued at the time control, TC 0, TC 1B, TC 5A, TC 9D, TC 13A and TC 16A.

12.5 Start order and interval

The start order following ERC art 41.4 and interval art 41.5.

For Leg 1 and Leg 2 will be 2 minutes for all ERC1 cars, for all other cars the interval will be 1 minute. The Clerk of the Course may, for safety reasons and with the knowledge of the Stewards, reposition drivers or change the time interval between them.

12.6 Start procedure Ceremonial Start - Procedure and Pre-Start Area

The Ceremonial Start / opening ceremony show is on Thursday, 13 June from 18:00h at Bauhaus, Karlstad.

Participation to Ceremonial Start is compulsory for all admitted crew and cars.

All infringements will be reported to the stewards. The road from Service Park to the Ceremonial Start is included in the Road book. The meeting point for all rally cars for the Pre-Ceremonial Start Holding Area is in the same area.

Only rally cars are allowed to enter the Start holding Area, as from 17:30 to 18:00.

The start order of the Ceremonial Start will be same as for section 1.

12.7 Change of on-board camera data

The change of on-board camera data is allowed as stipulated in Art. 42.8 of the RRSR.

12.8 Permitted early check-in

Crews are authorised to check-in early without incurring a penalty at TC PF (parc ferme after QS), TC 1A (end of Section 1), TC 9C (end of Section 3), and TC 17A (final time control).

12.9 Flexi Service

Service C is carried out according to Art 59.2 RRSR.

All cars except re-starting crews must be in the overnight Parc Fermé no later than at 22:00





12.10 Retired cars restarting the rally

Any crew which has failed to complete SS1 Bauhaus - Road Section (Section 1 of Leg 1) may start Section 2 of Leg 1. With reference to Art. 54 in the RRSR any crew which fails to complete a section will be assumed to re-start the rally from the start of the next section following the overnight regroup. If not, they must confirm with the Clerk of the Course by completing the form located in the road book and lodging it with the organiser as soon as possible before the publication of the re-start list. Any crew re-starting the rally must present their cars at the overnight parc fermé at the latest ONE hour before the start of the next Section following the overnight regroup.

12.11 SS1 BAUHAUS

SS 1 BAUHAUS will be running as a super special stage with only one car starting at same time. Start order and interval will be after agreement with the Promotor and FIA. Art 51.2 RRSR

12.12 Power Stage

With reference to Art. 50 in the RRSR special stage 17, Mölnbacka 2, will be run as the Power Stage.

12.13 Finish procedure

The finish of the competition element of the rally is at TC 17A, the holding area at the podium. Thereafter crews must follow the instructions of officials during the podium ceremony. Between TC 17A and parc fermé, competitors will be under parc fermé conditions and will be observed by marshals. Cars selected for the final checks will be driven by the crews or team representatives from the podium ceremony to the scrutineering in a convoy.

12.14 Environmental prescriptions

Teams are obligated to follow the directions and objectives in the organisers environmental policy. Further information will be published in Rally Guide.

12.15 Official time used in the rally

Official time throughout the rally is that of the GPS. The time zone is Central European Time (UTC +1).

12.16 Exhibition driving

Exhibition driving ("doughnuts") is strictly forbidden everywhere due to lack of suitable place. All infringements will be penalised with a minimum of a 5-minute time penalty, applied by the Stewards.

Cars selected for final checks (communicated to the competitor concerned at the finish TC) must have one representative of the competitor as well as mechanics (in case of dismantling) present at the final checks.

15.2 Protest deposit

The protest deposit is \in 1,000.

If a protest requires the dismantling and reassembly of a clearly defined part of the car (engine, transmission, steering, braking system, electrical installation, bodywork, etc.), an additional deposit may be specified by the Stewards in accordance with Art. 13.4.3 of the Code.

The expenses incurred in the work and in the transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if it is upheld.





If the protest is unfounded, and if the expenses incurred by the protest (scrutineering, transport, etc.) are higher than the amount of the (additional) deposit, the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely, if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned.



2 x competition numbers 20 cm high - shall be placed at the top of the rear side windows. The name of the driver with his/her passport nationality national flag must appear in the rear side window of both sides of the car (under the starting numbers). For further details see 2024 FIA RRSR.

Stickers affixed by the scrutineers at scrutineering:

Check card

(6 cm x 6 cm) will be affixed on the car, at roll-cage driver side.

2 minutes sticker

Affixed on the cars (on the roof over the windscreen, co-driver side) with a start interval of 2 minutes.





APPENDIX 5 - DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT - FIA ISC, Appendix L

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment. These regulations apply to Free practice, Qualifying stage and Shakedown as well.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

- 8859-2015 (Technical List N°49), - 8860-2010 (Technical List N°33) or - 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List N°69)

Frontal Head Restraint (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74).

Standard 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74) is mandatory for FIA, ERC, ERC3 and ERC4 Priority driver (and accompanying co-driver).

Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also the RRSR, Art. 53.1.

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a standalone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of any type of jewellery, such as but not limited to, neck chains, bracelets or watches is prohibited during the competition. Exceptions to this rule, providing the CMO and/or Medical Delegate do not consider that due to size or location they may delay rescue or hinder emergency care, are:

i. the wearing of watch(es) by co-drivers, on the condition that the watch(es) is worn over the overall,

ii. the wearing of a single band-style ring providing it does not restrict the natural range of motion of the hand, and

iii. the wearing of body piercing(s) providing they are not worn in and/or around the oral cavity.
