FINISH PROCEDURE

The final podium ceremony will take place at Red Barn Arena on Sunday 12th February.


After finishing the Power Stage, all cars must immediately proceed to the final time control of the rally (TC18A) at the holding area before the podium and follow the instructions of the marshals, with the exception of the final car in the Live TV component of the Wolf Power Stage. This car must not stop at the Stop Control of SS18, but proceed directly to and through the Holding Area and drive directly on to the Podium. Time Card procedures for this car will happen on the ramp.

The procedure for the prizegiving ceremonies for WRC, WRC2 and JWRC will be as follows:

- Overall winning crew drives on to podium for celebration.
The crew will be invited to celebrate including a photo opportunity on the roof of their car.
- 2nd and 3rd placed overall crews in the category will be invited to the podium area.
- 3rd placed crew will be invited to step on to the podium.
- 2nd placed crew will be invited to step on to the podium.
- 1st placed crew will be invited to step on to the podium.
- Winning Manufacturer representative invited to the podium area (P1 only).
- The national anthem of the winning crew will be played, and flags of top 3 crews displayed.
- The national anthem of the winning manufacturer will be played and flag of the manufacturer displayed (P1 only).
- Trophies for 3rd placed crew presented by dignitary.
- Trophies for 2nd placed crew presented by dignitary.
- Trophies for 1st placed crew presented by dignitary.
- Trophy for Winning Manufacturer presented by dignitary (P1 only).
- Magnums of sparkling wine presented to each member of the top 3 crews. **All crews are reminded that the presence of alcohol in a Driver's body during competition is prohibited (2023 FIA ISC, Appendix C, Art. 1.2).**
- Winning crew and their team are invited for a photo opportunity with the winning car.
- The winning crews of FIA WRC2 Challenger Championship, FIA WRC3 Championship and FIA WRC Masters Cup will be presented trophies as they pass over the podium.

The holding area comprises of a fenced area for the cars to be parked under parc ferme conditions (Supplementary Regulations, Art. 12.11), as well as an area for the Media Zone (Bulletin 1, Art. 12.16). Drivers are required to make themselves available for interviews. Team members with access to the media zone are allowed to this area and Art. 56.2.2 of the 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations applies.

All crews are required to drive their cars from the Podium to the final Parc Ferme.
