The Stewards have received a report from the Race Director (Document No.13), have considered the following matter, and determine the following:

Offence:

No breach of the FIA International Sporting Code or the Sporting Regulations was established.

Decision:

No further action

Reason:

The Stewards determined that cars 78, 8, 61 and 555 were involved in the incident. Car 78 abruptly changed direction, causing the cars behind to react. Car 8 took avoiding action and, as a consequence, cars 8, 61 and 555 collided.

After reviewing the available onboard footage and other evidence, it was established that car 78 changed direction in order to avoid a collision with car 86, which was experiencing a technical problem with its electronic signalling system.

- Neither driver was to blame for the incident.
 - The incident occurred as a result of a combination of factors.
 - The contact was considered a racing incident.
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- The incident occurred under challenging racing conditions (start phase).
