# 1. JURISDICTION

This Meeting is a National Race Meeting with Foreign Participation, promoted by New Zealand Motorsport Group and organised by MotorSport New Zealand Inc. to be held at Taupo International Motorsport Park, Taupo on 17-19 November 2023.

### 5. BRIEFINGS:

**5.1 Drivers Briefings:** Drivers Briefings will be held verbally for the Toyota 86 and GT New Zealand Championships at the times confirmed below and will be supplemented by a Written Drivers Briefing. All other categories will be provided with a Written Drivers Briefing only which will be uploaded on Sportity.

# 5.2 Verbal Drivers Briefings:

- **Toyota 86 Championship:** will be held at 0900 on Friday 17th November 2023 in the Toyota 86 Lounge.
- **(b) GT New Zealand Championship:** will be held at 1000 on Friday 17th November 2023 in the GT New Zealand Lounge.

### 5.3 New Drivers:

Any driver(s) who are racing at one of their first three (3) race events or who have not previously competed at the circuit must attend the new drivers briefing at 8am below the control tower on Friday 17th November 2023

### 6. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Timing:** will be done via electronic means, via MyLaps and published live on Speedhive. Transponders must be fully operational and charged during all sessions, including practice on Friday.
- **6.2** Race Radio: will be used for major announcements.

The frequency for GT New Zealand and Toyota 86 Race Radio frequency is 489.681250MHz code 10 digital.

The frequency for all other classes is 455.168750MHz code 6B analogue.

**6.3 Circuit Walks:** will be available on Thursday 16th November from 17:30hrs to 19:00hrs. Those participating in the circuit walks will be required to wear hi-vis vests.

### 6.4 Fuel Handling and Storage:

Competitors are reminded to ensure that they are familiar with and abide by the MotorSport NZ Code of Practice – Fuel Handling. This can be found on the MotorSport NZ website – www.motorsport.org.nz

#### 6.5 Paddock and Pit Parking

The Paddock allocation has been planned at the discretion of the Event Organisers,

The Pit Paddock area is for Competition Vehicles only – for Competitors and Teams located on the asphalt behind the Pit Lane a specific area has been set aside (see Pit Layout Map) for your Transporters and Service Vehicles.

For Categories Pitting on the grass area, limited space will be available within your Pit Area for your Transporter, covered in trailer or Service Vehicle.

All open Trailers Must be Parked in the allocated Trailer Park Location, as per the attached Paddock Layout Map.

### 6.6 Access to the Circuit Venue & Paddock Area

From Saturday 18th November, Ticket Passes will be required to gain entry to the venue throughout the Event, and competitors should ensure that all persons associated with them keep their Ticket passes with them at all times.

All Team personnel leaving the circuit and wishing to return the same day or the next day must ensure they have their Ticket with them when they leave the venue. If you don't have your Ticket you will have to pay to gain access.

Competitors should note that there will be limited Security in the paddock throughout the Event and that you should take your own Security precautions at all times, particularly when your vehicle is on the Circuit.
