The Race Director finds that:

Driver: Hunter Robb			
Session: Race 1			
After a hearing at which evidence of past technical settings was presented along with vehicle parts and video footage the following is determined. Camber is performance enhancing. While excessive camber has not been an issue with this Car in the past, the measurement this time, with double checks has given a breach reading.			
The post race setting was measured at 5.4 degrees. Schedule TR article 9.3.1(1) allows for a maximum of 5 degrees.			
The video footage shows contact with Car 23 but the amount of force and the effect of this is not measurable.			
It was the opinion of Technical Officer Justin Scelly that the force should not have moved the setting but that it could have.			
The exact force is unknown. The plate presented had four screws and showed wear. The uneven surface left by the wear could have attributed to the movement but this is not confirmed.			
Article 9.3.1(1) makes no allowance for accident damage or component wear.			
The measurement of 5.4 degrees is in breach of Article 9.3.1(1)

YOUR RIGHTS

4. Every protest shall be in writing and accompanied by a fee, the level of which shall be prescribed by MotorSport NZ in Appendix One of the National Sporting Code, which fee shall only be returned if the protest is prima facie well-founded or if so directed by MotorSport NZ.
