YOUR OBLIGATIONS

MotorSport New Zealand no longer accepts cheques as a method of payment.

Where a penalty applied includes an Endorsement of Licence, you are required to retain the Decision Form and present it should you be called to any further hearing(s) during the period of the Endorsement.

Endorsements and/or Suspensions are processed within the MotorSport New Zealand database which will provide automated emails to the competitor.

YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to Protest, in accordance with the provision of the National Sporting Code, to the Stewards of the Meeting.

If you decide that you wish to exercise this right, then:

- 1. Consult the National Sporting Code Part IX Protests.
- 2. Time limits for Protest are specified in the National Sporting Code. It is essential you consider these immediately.
- 3. Competitor Relations Officers can assist you research your rights on these matters.
- 4. Every protest shall be in writing and accompanied by a fee, the level of which shall be prescribed by MotorSport NZ in Appendix One of the National Sporting Code, which fee shall only be returned if the protest is prima facie well-founded or if so directed by MotorSport NZ.
