




## MEMO TO THE CLERK OF THE COURSE

Subject:		
Car #570 suffered a severe fracture of the front screen.		
This necessitated the removal of the screen.		
They team sought an opinion as to whether the car could be raced without a front screen <u>and</u> the rear screen in place.		
The circumstances under which a car may run without a screen are covered in App. 4 Sch. Z – article 13.12.		
The Chief Scrutineer (Neil Madden) and the Series Scrutineer (Cymon Hewitt) examined the car. Side glasses were in the down position and race tape was used to cover any cavities in the windscreen surround.		
They were of the opinion that the car was safe to race in this configuration. They have put this approval in writing. This is attached.		
I examined the car myself and spoke to the driver.		
As Clerk of the Course I have exercised my discretion under App. 4 – Sch. Z – article 13.12 for the car to run in Race 3.		
I observed that the car started from pit lane at the rear of the grid.
