## 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The United Arab Emirates Winter Sports Federation together with Alpha X Sports OC and the Organizing Committee are glad to invite you to participate in the **Union Figure Skating Trophy 2025**, which will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Union Figure Skating Trophy 2025** is open to all Competitors of the ISU Members and Clubs being members of National Federations and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3) for Novice and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

**The Organizing Committee reserves the right to enter additional skaters in each category and limit entries in any event in case of too many entries.**

Please, be aware that judges not involved in the panel have to cover their own expenses (board and lodging).

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- the ISU Member / Club is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee ([Event@alphaxsports.ae](mailto:Event@alphaxsports.ae)) until January 27, 2025. Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows sending large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

- each submission shall be labeled with the name of the ISU Member / Club, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

Example: \* UAE\_Gold I category\_FS\_EXAMPLE-John

The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

## 9. REGISTRATION OFFICE

The office of the Organizing Committee and the registration office will be located at the ice rink and will be open every day during the competition. Participating teams are kindly asked to announce
