How to reach the Spanish Steps – Piazza di Spagna, Rome City Centre Family Photo

As provided for in Bulletin 2, **the attendance of all crews at the Rally di Roma Capitale Family Photo is mandatory.** The event will take place on **Thursday at 20:00** at the [Spanish Steps](#), Piazza di Spagna.

We understand that travelling to the city centre may require some additional effort. However, this event will provide an excellent opportunity to promote the crews, the teams and rallying itself, while creating a memorable "family atmosphere" in one of the world's most iconic locations.

Four rally cars will be displayed at the left-hand side of the Spanish Steps, while the official Family Photo will be taken on the Steps.

The following are the recommended options for travelling from the Rally Headquarters / Fan Zone at EUR to Piazza di Spagna.

1. By Metro (Recommended)

This is the quickest and most convenient way to reach the historic city centre, avoiding road traffic and restricted traffic areas.

- **Departure:** [EUR Magliana Metro Station](#) (a few minutes from the Rally Headquarters)
- **Line:** Metro B towards Rebibbia or Jonio
- **Change:** At Termini Station, transfer to Metro A towards Battistini
- **Arrival:** [Spagna Metro Station](#)

The station exit leads directly to, or within a few metres of, the Spanish Steps.

Estimated journey time: approximately 35 minutes.

2. By Private Car – Villa Borghese Car Park and ZTL Restrictions

Competitors choosing to travel by private car are reminded to pay particular attention to the **ZTL (Limited Traffic Zone)** restrictions in Rome's historic city centre.

- **Recommended parking:** [Saba Villa Borghese](#) underground car park, Viale del Muro Torto.
This is the largest and closest parking facility to Piazza di Spagna and is connected to the area through an underground pedestrian passage equipped with moving walkways and escalators.

ZTL Restrictions

The electronic access gates controlling the daytime ZTL in the historic city centre are active during the day, and entry is permitted only to authorised vehicles. To avoid traffic fines, competitors are strongly advised to enter the ZTL only after **18:00**, when the restrictions are lifted and the electronic gates are no longer active. Competitors arriving before 18:00 should follow the external routes, such as **Viale del Muro Torto**, which provide direct access to the Villa Borghese car park without passing through any ZTL access gates.
