1. INTRODUCTION

Dear Competitors,

With 14 passes on the way, in 17 special stages spread over 5 French departments, the route for this inaugural event of the 2024 FIA World Rally Championship (WRC) has moved up in latitude as well as altitude, following a strong wish of the Organizing Committee at Automobile Club de Monaco (ACM), hoping for more snow on the roads than in previous editions.

After two and a half strenuous days of recce, from Monday January 22 to Wednesday January 24, the official start of this 92<sup>nd</sup> edition of Monte-Carlo Rally will be given the next day, Thursday January 25 at 4:52pm on the Casino Square in Monaco. On the menu of the 1<sup>st</sup> Leg, two timed stages in total darkness for a total of 46.20km, in the departments of Alpes-de-Haute-Provence and Hautes-Alpes. These two legendary stages, **« Thoard / Saint-Geniez » (SS1 – 21.01km – 8:35 pm)** and **« Bayons / Bréziers » (SS2 – 25.19km – 9:58 pm)** will serve as reality checks for the expected major players in the championship.

On Friday January 26, crews will be heading for the East of Gap, where the 2<sup>nd</sup> Leg will be spread over two departments (Alpes-de-Haute-Provence and Hautes-Alpes) for a total of 105.72 timed kilometers. With a loop of three special stages to cover twice, made of **«** Saint-Léger-les-Mélèzes / La Bâtie-Neuve **»** (SS3/6 – 16.68km – 8:51 am/2:56 pm), followed by **«** Champcella / Saint-Clément-sur-Durance **»** (SS4/7 – 17.87km – 10:24 am/4:29 pm) and **«** La Bréole / Selonnet **»** (SS5/8 – 18.31km – 11:57 am/6:02 pm), setting up a very intense race day!

The West of Gap will be on the cards for Saturday January 27 when the 3<sup>rd</sup> Leg covers three departments (Hautes-Alpes, Drôme and Isère) for a total of 120.40 timed kilometers. Again, with a loop of three stages not so close to each other, to complete twice, for what will probably be the toughest race day of the week. On the menu, « Esparron / Oze » (SS9/12 – 18.79km – 8:05 am/2:05 pm), followed by « Les Nonières / Chichilianne » (SS10/13 – 20.04km – 9:53 am/3:53 pm) and « Pellafol / Agnières-en-Dévoluy » (SS11/14 – 21.37km – 11:06 am/5:06 pm). There will certainly be several ups and downs during this strenuous 3<sup>rd</sup> Leg.

In order to conclude the event in style, on **Sunday January 28**, three stages totalling 52.12 kilometers will be scheduled between **Gap** and **Monaco**. This will be a brand-new feature for a Final Leg and the last fights for honours will happen on **« La Bréole / Selonnet » (SS15 – 18.31km – 7:04 am)**, followed by **« Digne-les-Bains / Chaudon-Norante » (SS16 – 19.01km – 8:35 am)** and, last but not least, **« La Bollène-Vésubie / Col de Turini » (SS17 – 14.80km – 12:15 pm)** which will serve as Power Stage. The Prize-Giving Ceremony will then take place, as usual, on the **Casino Square**, from **4:15 pm**...

#### 4.2 Entry procedure

Any RGT and non-priority drivers wishing to take part in the "91<sup>st</sup> Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2023" must complete the electronic entry form available on the FIA website and pay online <u>before Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2023 - 24h00.</u>

Manufacturers registered in the FIA World Rally Championship, as well as the WRC2 and WRC3 Competitors must use the standard FIA entry form available on the FIA website.

By sending an electronic form, the competitor undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the prescriptions of the 2024 FIA WRC SR Art. 22.5. Competitors will sign the entry form at the Administrative Checks.

If a competitor cannot make the entry on the internet, he must contact the rally secretariat before close of entries for further instructions.

#### 4.3 Number of entrants accepted and categories

The maximum number of entrants is 70, divided in 4 priority groups: priority 1 (P1), priority 2 (P2), priority 3 (P3), and non-priority (NP).

The classification "Promotion" is reserved to non-priority drivers entered in the name of the driver (driver = competitor).

#### 5.3 Service park regulations and environmental requirements

5.3.1 Environmental requirements

Draining of waste water, car washing and any drilling for stakes into the ground are not permitted in the service park. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards who may impose penalties.

A washing area will be set up at the entrance to the Service Park.

<u>Unauthorized power supply from street fittings is forbidden. In case of infringement a penalty</u> of 1,500 € will be applied. Any such application of the regulations by the Clerk of the Course will be notified by him to the competitor concerned.

Floor mats must be used. Failure to comply will result in a penalty of 1,500 € per vehicle. Any such application of the regulations by the Clerk of the Course will be notified by him to the competitor concerned.







# 5.3.2 Regulations

<u>Only vehicles identified "Service", "Auxiliary" or "Route Note Car" are allowed in the service</u> <u>park</u>. If these vehicles do not fit in the competitors' allocated area, they must be parked outside the service park.

These vehicles must not be driven in the lanes used by the competing cars 30 minutes prior to the expected arrival of the first competitor at TC service park IN until the last competitor has checked-in at TC service park OUT.

Any vehicle which is not parked inside the competitor's allocated area in the service park will result in a penalty of 1,500 € per vehicle. Any such application of the regulations by the Clerk of the Course will be notified by him to the competitor concerned.

The circulation of any vehicle with a Total Loaded Weight (PTAC) greater than 3.5 tonnes is prohibited on the Monegasque territory between 08.00 hrs and 09.00 hrs.

# 6. TWO-WAY RADIO

# 6.1 Registration procedure

The temporary use of radio frequencies on the Monegasque and French territories is subject to prior approval. The radio forms may be completed and returned to the concerned authorities.

# 8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Vehicles from the European Union do not need a specific document for Customs clearance. Only non-EU competitors will need to show an ATA (obtainable from the Chamber of Commerce of the country of origin) to Customs Authorities at their point of entry into the European Union. # **9. HELICOPTERS**

In accordance with articles L363-1 to L363-3 of the French Environment Code, amended by law no. 2022-217 of February 21, 2022, article 63, which prohibits the landing of aircraft in mountainous areas (+800m altitude) for commercial purposes, only security and television helicopters will be allowed on the event.

18.2 Accreditation procedure

- 18.2.1 Principles
  - 1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 92<sup>e</sup> Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.

- 2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The Central Offices or premises of the main International Agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
- 3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.
- 4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....
- 5. A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website.

#### 18.2.2 Procedures

 Foreign Media must submit their request to the FIA before <u>Thursday, 11<sup>th</sup> January</u> <u>2024</u>. The international accreditation form is available on the FIA website:

- 3. Press photographers under contract with agencies or publications must provide documentation justifying the publication of a minimum of 15 pictures of the previous edition (2023).
- 4. The request must include:
- The accreditation form completed;
- An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
- A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
- Copies of the published articles covering the 2023 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly also those dealing with the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo;
- A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2024;
- Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2024, with details on release dates or broadcast.
- 5. Documents submitted late and/or incomplete will not be considered.
