EGNA DANCE TROPHY 2024
INTERNATIONAL ICE DANCE COMPETITION
8 - 11 FEBRUARY EGNA/NEUMARKT, ITALY



1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Egna Dance Trophy 2024 Ice Dance International Competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations for Season 2023/24, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance for Season 2023/24, and the relevant ISU Communications. All Members of the ISU and Clubs being members of National Skating Federations associated with the ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. Couples taking part in the Senior and Junior category must be entered through their respective Member Federation through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS). Participation in the Egna Dance Trophy is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented for verification at the accreditation of the event. All participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extant necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, sex.

ACCESS TO THE COMPETITION

Accreditation and access to the competition will only be possible for athletes, coaches and one team leader for each Nation.

2. COMPETITION VENUE

All practice and competition will take place at the WürthArena, the address Via Brennero, 7 - 39044 Egna/Neumarkt (Bz), Italy. This complex features an indoor ice rink, temperature controlled with ice surfaces 60m x 30m.

SENIOR

Rhythm Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 709 and pertinent ISU communications, rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 2560 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec





Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710, the required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2560 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR

Rhythm Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 709, rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 2560 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communications 2560 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICE

Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 711.

Pattern required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 2555 and subsequent updates.

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated:

Rocker Foxtrot - Starlight Waltz

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Free Dance duration: 3 min., +/- 10 sec

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communications 2555 and subsequent updates.

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE

Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022/23, Rule 711. Pattern required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 2555 and subsequent updates.

One of the two groups, announced for the season, shall be drawn before the first practices of the competition. Each group contains two (2) Pattern Dances:

Group 1: Fourteenstep - Tango

Group 2: Foxtrot - European Waltz

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Free Dance Duration: 2 min. 30 sec +/-10 sec





In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communications 2555 and subsequent updates.

BASIC NOVICE

Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 711.

Pattern required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 2555 and subsequent updates.

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated:

Fourteenstep - Willow Waltz - Tango Canasta

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Free Dance duration: 2 min., +/- 10 sec

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communications 2555 and subsequent updates

4. ENTRIES

<u>ENTRIES OF COMPETITORS</u>: All Entries must be made by the ISU Member. The Entries by names must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS): - https://fms.sportresult.com/isu and will be submitted via the ORS simultaneously to the OC. In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

The "Program Content Sheet" must be must be returned to the Organizing Committee (not later than 22 January 2024). It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled by each couple in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

<u>ENTRIES OF JUDGES</u>: Each participating ISU Member may nominate one judge and one substitute judge for the event in which the Member has Competitor(s) entered. Only ISU and international judges will be accepted. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of judges in accordance with the number of the couple's entries. The confirmation of the list of judges will be announced in due time.

<u>DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES:</u> All entries must be must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by January 8, 2024. <u>All entries sent after January 8, 2024 are declared to be late entry.</u> Entry Fees are requested to be paid <u>no later than January 8, 2024</u>, by bank transfer. Please note that all banking charges have to be on the sender.

Payment of the fee is necessary to confirm the entry.

For all the nominated judges the Organizer will provide accommodation and meals beginning with dinner on Thursday, February 8, 2024 through lunch on Sunday, February 11, 2024. Please consider that it could be necessary to leave on Monday morning, and in that case the meals will be through the breakfast on Monday, February 12, 2024.

Please note that the OC will not organize transfer for the judges, who have to arrange them with their federations.

The OC will arrange travel and transfers only for the invited Officials (Referee and Technical Panel).

Judges and officials involved in the Competition are however requested to announce their flight/train numbers, dates and times of arrival and departure or any other information concerning transportation to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but no later than January 15, 2024, to organize check-in and check-out.

6. REGISTRATION - ARRIVALS AND TRANSPORTATION

Accreditation will be at the Ice Rink starting from <u>February 8 2024.</u> All the Couples are requested to present a valid passport as per ISU rules at the time of registration.

The Organizing Committee does not provide any transportation to the participants.

7. DRAW

The draw for the starting orders will take place on <u>Thursday February 8th at 16.00 at the ice rink.</u> No draw after Rhythm Dance and Pattern Dance. Starting order for Free Dance will be according the reverse of the Rhythm Dance and Pattern Dance results.

8. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:





• the ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (music.egna@gmail.com) until January 24th 2024.

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

• each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

 Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced.

 The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

9. REWARD

Awarding ceremonies will be just for the first three places in every category. Presents for all participants at the accreditation point. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time.

10. LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2024 Egna Dance Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.
