The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Technical Delegate, summoned the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Facts During pre-event scrutineering, the FIA Technical Delegate found that on Car No. 21 (Lancia Ypsilon HF Rally2), the markings linked to the FIA Technical Passport were not fitted to the car.

Offence Breach of Article 251-2.1.8 of Appendix J to the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code.
Breach of the 2026 Homologation Regulations for Cars in Group Rally2.

Decision 1. **Fine of € 500 imposed on LANCIA, Manufacturer of car No. 21.**

In accordance with Art. 12.8 of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code, fines shall be paid within 48 hours of their notification. Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.

2. **The missing FIA marking (sticker) must be affixed as soon as possible and, in any case, before the car (chassis) participates in its next rally.**

Reason The Stewards examined the report of the FIA Technical Delegate.

A hearing was held on Thursday 28th May 2026 at 13.30 hrs, in the presence of Mr. Didier CLEMENT (representing Lancia Corse HF), Ms. Enola PIALLAT (representing the Competitor) and Mr. Jérôme TOQUET (FIA Technical Delegate).

The FIA Technical Delegate confirmed that the FIA Technical Passport associated with Car No. 21 exists, is valid and correctly registered. The FIA Technical Delegate further confirmed that this is the first rally participation of this chassis and that the absence of the markings linked to the FIA Technical Passport does not create any safety concern with regard to the car.

The Stewards note that, according to the applicable regulations, Rally2 cars homologated from 1st January 2025 onwards must be identified both by an FIA Technical Passport and by the associated markings fitted to the main rollbar.

Mr. CLEMENT explained that the omission resulted from an administrative error during the preparation process of this new car and confirmed that the required sticker had effectively been issued and was in the possession of LANCIA.

He provided evidence showing that the sticker was located in Paris at the time of the hearing.

The Stewards consider that the absence of the required markings constitutes a breach of the applicable regulations. However, the Stewards also consider that this matter is administrative in nature, that the technical identity of the car could be verified, that no safety concern existed and that the Competitor (NIKOLAY GRYAZIN) itself bears no responsibility for the omission.

The Stewards note that, pursuant to Articles 12.3.1 and 12.5.1 of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code, breaches of the Code or FIA regulations may be penalised and fines may be imposed not only on Competitors but also on other *Persons* who do not comply with the applicable regulations. Furthermore, Article 12.1.1.c of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code provides that any natural or legal *Person* taking part in an infringement, whether as instigator or accomplice, is also punishable.

Having considered the circumstances of this case, the Stewards are satisfied that the omission originated from the manufacturer and not from the Competitor. The Stewards therefore consider that a financial penalty imposed on LANCIA, rather than on the Competitor, represents an appropriate and proportionate sanction in the circumstances.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the 2026 FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
