Good Evening,

Jameelat..... Great job, well-done.

2 more selective sections to go and we will celebrate together at the finish ramp on Saturday in Al Qassim,

Keep up the good work. And the results might change any time.

Tomorrow we will start from the service out at 09:30 in the morning so take a good rest tonight and enjoy the stay in a hotel room after 3 nights in the camp.

SS3 is 27.17 km longer than what you did today but much easier stage, you will enjoy the stages in Hail.

Again again speed is not the name of the game, by collecting all the way points and maintain the average speed while in the ASC, you will win the stage.

The max time for Selective Section 3 is only four hours, so manage your time properly to avoid any early or late penalties.

The road section from the hotel to the selective section is 110.02 km with a target time of 1 hour and thirty minutes.

While in the ASC 1 you will face a speed limit zone, danger 2 and danger 3, Average speed in ASC 1 is 42 km/h.

The speed limit zone is 40 km/h, not within the calculation for the ASC.

In general most of the track tomorrow is Gravel some part of the stage is rough with a possibility of flat tires, and limited part of the track is Sandy.

You will face lots of Crests, so take care as track is open for public.

Any time you reach to a danger 1 or 2 or 3 on a downhill make sure you slow down before you reach the cliffs and try to go down on the 1st gear without sudden breaks.

Road Book Delivery & Notes

STAGE 2: Wednesday, March 10th, 2023 first car start from TC 2B Hail Service out at 09:30 am.

Always, Always, Always, Always Follow the road book and the cap especially in all the sections with undefined track, which is a lot in this stage.

There will be 4 Speed Control Zones in SS3.

There will be 2 Check points in SS3 where you have to stop for at least 15 seconds and make sure the track is clear before you cross the road.

There will be 2 Average Speed Challenge (ASC) Zone in SS3.

The 1st one after 9.79 km with an average speed of 42 km/h. ASC1 is 20.92 km long.

The 2nd ASC after 93.69 km with an average speed of 43 km/h and 13.32 km long.

If you have a danger 1, 2 or 3 during the ASC you have to slow so as not to put yourself in a risk

Always keep in Mind that the Selective Section is not closed for the Rally cars, you are driving in an open Desert, and you might face some other people who are using the same route, reaching their destination, or camping in the desert, this is normal and you have to deal with such a situation. So expect other vehicles, people and animals. Our advice is to slow when approaching people or animals.



All WPM way points will open at a radius of 800 meters and will be validated in a radius of 90 meters
All WPS way points will open at a radius of 1000 meters and will be validated in a radius of 30 meters (!!! WPS alarm will turn on in 300 meters radius)

- At 19.97 km Slow Down Danger 2 keep Max R wadi Crossing
- At 28.60 km the Danger 3 is for 300 meters cliff use the 1st gear and avoid sudden breaking.
- At 33.78 km Sand possibility of getting stuck
- At 35.26 km Steep downhill after the Crest.
- At 40.82 km stay on track over Crest so as not to hit the cement blocks on the left
- At 43.25 km Slow Over Crest
- At 45.95 km Stop at CP1 for at least 15 seconds
- At 49.70 this is a danger 3.... slow down and keep right to avoid wadi and ditches on left. the stella might not alarm.
- At 62.41 km keep Right on downhill, 1st gear and avoid sudden breaking.
- At 64.23 km up hill on heavy dune, make sure you have enough speed to climb.
- At 80.15 km till 81.09 km Camels
- At 102.04 km till 103.52 km Camels.
- At 112.49 Add danger 1 very Bumpy
- At 94.15 km till 102.04 km over Graded track (Radmiyya ردميه) into Under Green Arch in the track Dunes Challenge Festival, there is a cone in the middle of the track.

Some Tips / Advice for you

Make sure you have enough drinking water with you throughout the Race.

Pay attention of your time cards don't lose it.

The Average speed challenge is only is the Yellow boxes.

In case of any incident make sure that you report is immediately to the police or any official car, CRO of Rally HQ

2023 RALLY JAMEEL COMPETITION FORMAT:

STAGES:

The four days Rally will consists of:

4 Legs / 1 per day

2 Types of Sections:

- Road Section – Tarmac road, by following roadbook to arrive at Selective Section.
- Selective Section – off-road, roadbook competition where scoring occurs.
- Each Selective Section contains a minimum of 2 Average Speed Challenge (ASC).
- Approximately 50 scored waypoints per day in a Selective Section. Competitor - **JAMEELAH** - will gain 10 Score points for each way point validated during the Selective Section.



SCORING:

Highest score wins

954 Points will be possible to validate and collect During Leg 3

36 way points to be validated equal to 360 points

In an average speed challenge, the absolute speed is not the main objective, but rather the control of the speed, the time and distance travelled.

Definition of Scored Segment = Distance between two hidden points inside an Average Speed Challenge when following the Roadbook route.

There will be two Average Speed Challenges in Leg # 3.

Target Average Speed = 42 km/h for the first ASC and 43 km/h for the second ASC

Number of scored segments = 8 segments in the first ASC and 6 segments in the Second total of 14 segments

Maximum points scored in each segment in the 1st ASC = 42 points total = 42 x 8=336 points

Maximum points scored in each segment in the 2nd ASC = 43 points total 43 x 6 = 258 points

Total points possible in Average Speed Challenge = 336 + 258 = 594 points

The Maximum Speed at any time during an Average Speed Challenges is 8 kph over the Target Average Speed.

Maximum Speed for the 1st ASC = 42 + 8 = 50 kph.

Maximum Speed for the 2nd ASC = 43 + 8 = 51 kph

The Speed control zone will not be calculated part of the ASC

Stella will calculate your Average Speed in each scoring segment. The Average Speeds of each segment are scored independently of each other. For example, if you miss a turn in a segment and take time to return to the track, you may score very few points. However, once you are back on the track, you can resume the Average Speed and continue to earn points in the next segment.

See Regulations section 11.11.2 for the scoring formulas.

Penalties for exceeding the Maximum Speed are described in the Regulations in section 11.12.2
