1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

This event will be conducted in accordance with the current 2023/2024 BIS Generic Criteria, BIS Policies, and where relevant the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, as well as all updated ISU

Communications.

Any UK national skaters entering must be current members of British Ice Skating and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102.

By entering this Competition you confirm you are an eligible skater and you agree to abide by the Competition Regulations.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

Arena: Dundee Ice Arena, 7 Dayton Drive, Dundee, DD2 3SQ

A heated indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m.

3. CATEGORIES OF EVENTS

All categories as per the generic criteria (Beginner to National 8 Singles and Basic Novice Pairs)

National 6/7/8 Short and Free will be run as separate events

4. ENTRIES

Entries of skaters

Entries must be submitted as soon as possible but no later than the closing date via

Entries will open on 20th April at 2pm Entries will close 27th April 2024 but we reserve the right to close early or extend if required.

Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis **in each competition section**, subject to the clearance of entry fees, PCS and Music being received on time. This does mean that later entries in quieter sections may gain entry while the more in demand categories may fill up sooner.

Qualifying date for age is as per the ISU rule, 1st July 2023

The organiser has the right to limit the maximum number of entries in each category if needed.

A waiting list may be in operation. Further spaces may be released as they become available through withdrawals or other, up until the draw.

spaces must be accepted with checkout complete including payment within 24 hours of the space being offered. Skaters may only enter a maximum of one

free programme and a maximum of one short programme.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without reason.

Entries will close on 27nd April 2024 at 11:59pm but we reserve the right to close early if full or extend if still spaces

5. ENTRY LIST AND RESULTS

A provision entry list will be released by no later than 30th April 2024 (we reserve the right to publish early or extend if necessary) Results and draw will be online, the link will be shared via the Sportity app

Entries of Coaches

Rink-side access will be provided to those who are named on entry, and who hold a valid licence.

Entries of Chaperones/spectators

There is no accreditation given for Chaperones. Entry to the rink is by spectator ticket which can be purchased on the day at the front desk on

arrival. The cost is £5 (cash is preferable due to irregular signal in the ice arena for our card machines)

Entry fee

The fee for each skater is £84 for 1 programme or £135 if competing in a short and free programme. This is paid upon application. If you are competing at different levels for short and free you should only pay £135

Withdrawals

Withdrawals before the draw should fill out the withdrawal form link on sportity app

Due to the increasing cost of competitions, Successful entries are strictly non-refundable from Dundee Opens and any unforeseen circumstances should be claimed against your personal travel insurance. Any entries who paid and were not successful will be refunded prior to the event.

Skaters withdrawing after the official draw will need to have a valid reason and evidence of need to withdraw proof (submitted via above Withdrawal Form). Failure to do so might affect future entry into this event or Tayside Trophy events

6. MUSIC AND PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

The skater is responsible for submitting their music electronically in mp3 format. Music MUST be saved as "Level short or free skater name music name" for example SeniorMenShortJohnStonesHigherGround.mp3 or Beginnergirlsalicejonespiratesofcaribbean

Each skater must register elements no later than 30th April 2024 at 12 noon (link on Sportity)

Music must be uploaded as a music file in mp3 not later than 5th May 2024 (link on Sportity)

Any last minute music changes after that must be uploaded here (link on Sportity)

Spare music should be brought on a clearly labelled USB, one copy should be left with at side of the rink with the coach

Any other format will not be accepted.

7. TIMETABLES

A timetable will be released as soon as possible, we realise this is vital for parents arranging travel and will prioritise this, however please do not contact the organising committee asking for this, taking time to reply may just delay the timetable being shared.

All times will be provisional and subject to change.

Skaters must be available to skate 30 minutes ahead of their scheduled time.

8. RESULTS AND DRAWS

Random electronic draws will take place approx. 1 week before the event. The Marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 252 (Determination and publication of results) to be used

9. PRESENTATIONS

The three best-placed Competitors in each event will be announced and honoured at the medal presentations. Times of medal presentations will be announced in draft form on timetable and updates sent out via sportity

10.INSURANCE/LIABILITY

Dundee Ice Skating Club, Dundee Ice Arena, British Ice Skating and the Organisers assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal

injury or property damage incurred by Competitors and Officials. The Organizing Committee reserve the right to cancel the event without liability.

Should the competition have to be cancelled for any reason the organizer accepts no liability for any arrangements made or expenses incurred by attending

skaters, coaches or family members. If insurance is required competitors should take out their own policies and ensure they cover cancellation

In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the organiser accepts no liability for injury or damages incurred by competitors or officials.

The organizer will provide medical emergency first aid during the competition. Please do not attend if you are unwell or have tested positive for COVID or

any other contagious disease. All Skaters with medical conditions are obliged to inform the Event Organiser of these underlying conditions in order that the

medical team be fully informed. Competitors/Officials must report any injuries to the entry desk or one of the organising committee.

Competitors, parents and coaches are reminded that the organisers, judges, officials and helpers are all volunteers, without whom this competition would

not be possible. Failure to treat them with respect will result in the individual being withdrawn and may jeopordise future entry to any events held at Dundee ice arena.

By entering this event competitors consent to be photographed, the images used for reporting an event marketing purposes. They also consent to being

recorded on video for judging purposes, live-streaming and video sales.

Unofficial videography and photography of the event is not permitted and flash photography is banned at all times.

11. PRACTICE ICE

It will be possible to book unofficial practice ice. A link will be shared to book once our timetable is complete. Skaters music will not be played.
