7. TYRES

7.1.2 Tyre quantities (replace with this)

The maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 28 for Rally1 cars and 26 for all other cars. In accordance with Art. 13.2.5 of the 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations the maximum number of tyres of the alternative choice for all 4WD cars is either 8 or 12.

The FIA must be notified at wrc-technical@fia.com before the start of the Shakedown (8.56 on Thursday 3 August) of the number of tyres of the alternative choice that the competitor wishes to use (P1 competitors must notify of their choice by Tuesday, 1 August, 18:00 hrs). Alternative compound tyres are not required to be used in the Shakedown.

This choice neither increases nor decreases the maximum number of tyres for the rally. If the competitor wishes to have 12 alternative compound tyres for use in the rally instead of 8, the number of tyres of the first choice will automatically be reduced by 4 tyres.

8. Fuel

8.4 Distribution for Non-Priority Drivers (add)

Contrary to SR, Art. 8.1, as a second option for refuelling pump fuel, competitors may use regular 98E fuel pumped from their own cans/drums directly to the rally car. This must be done at locations shown by the organiser, inside or directly next to the FIA WRC refuel zones as marked in the itinerary of the rally.

One vehicle and two (2) mechanics may be sent to the refuel zone to transport the fuel and to help in the process. The team members must use designated safety equipment and the Environmental Mat. If an adaptor/funnel must be used, it needs to be transported in the rally car.

All other prescriptions of SR, Art. 8.4 and 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 61 and 62 apply.

9. Reconnaissance

9.1 Procedure for Registration (add)

The competitors will be divided into two groups:

- Group A (yellow): P1 and P2 drivers
- Group B (white): P3 and others

9.2.1 General Running of Reconnaissance (add)

Competitors may use the 1.63 km of SS 19/21 Moksi-Sahloinen on Road Book page 72, box 10-11 while on reconnaissance road section from finish of SS 19/21 back to the start.

12. Other Procedures

12.4 Start of the Rally

12.4.1 Ceremonial Start

A Ceremonial Start will be organised on Wednesday 2 August 2023 starting at 20.00 in the Jyväskylä harbour area, directly next to the service park. Cars and crews will be required to report at the pre-start ~~holding area~~ **check-point (same location as usual TC IN Service Park)** latest ~~15~~ **5** minutes before their start time, ~~and crews must be available for giving autographs to the spectators.~~ There will be no time cards for the Ceremonial Start, any lateness will be recorded by timekeepers and reported to the Stewards.

Short interviews will be held on the start ramp, after which the cars can be driven back to their service bays. Driving overalls required. For ceremonial start, the passing of scrutineering is not compulsory.

12.10 Overnight Parc Fermé (add)

Crews are allowed to bring drinks and install "camel bags" in their cars in the parc fermé using only tools carried in the rally car on

- Friday 4 August before TC1D
- Saturday 5 August before TC10D
- Sunday 6 August before TC18D

12.12 Running of Super Special Stage Harju 1 and Harju 2 (add)

From TC 9B (Holding Area OUT), the organiser may start any car at a different order than that of the arrival at TC 9A (Holding Area IN).

12.13 Promotional Activities with Drivers (amend)

~~Promotional activities will be arranged on Thursday 3 August at 14.00-15.30. All drivers requested to participate will be informed personally after the close of entries. Individual driver involvement will be around 30 minutes. More information given in Rally Guide 2 or subsequent communications.~~

The prescriptions of FIA WRC, Art. 38.4, concerning the availability of all Priority drivers for 10-minute autograph sessions on arrival to both midday and evening services, will be applied.

12.13.1 Driver Interviews (new article)

Selected drivers will be called for interviews on Wednesday, 2 August 2023 at 19.10-19.25 on the start podium in Jyväskylä Harbour. Individual invitations will be sent.

12.13.2 FIA WRC Media Pen (new article)

An FIA WRC Media Pen will be organised on Thursday, 3 August 2023 at 12.30-13.45 in the Service Park. The FIA WRC Media Pen is mandatory for all P1 drivers and invited P2 drivers (individual invitations will be sent), as well as P1 manufacturer team representatives, and upon request by the media to the FIA Media Delegate or National Press Officer for all other priority drivers or co-drivers. Attending competitors are required to be present for a duration of 30 min. minimum, or until dismissed by the FIA Media Delegate.

12.13.3 Autograph Session (new article)

An autograph session will be organised on Thursday, 3 August 2023 at 14.30-15.30 on the Secto Stage in the service park. Timing for different driver groups will be as follows:
