The Stewards, having received through the Clerk of the Course a request from the above Competitor to grant *force majeure* regarding his non-participation in SECTO RALLY FINLAND due to medical reasons, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Facts** The Competitor mentioned above requested *force majeure* to be granted for the withdrawal of their Crew MAURO MIELE / LUCA BELTRAME from SECTO RALLY FINLAND. This withdrawal is due to the driver's inability to participate in the Rally due to medical issues.

**Decision** To accept, under Art. 6.2.3.1 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, the non-participation of the above Competitor as a case of *force majeure* for this Rally. Therefore, SECTO RALLY FINLAND shall not be considered as one of the rallies entered by the Competitor to score points in any of the 2024 FIA WRC2 Support Championships.

**Reason** The Stewards studied the medical report provided by the Competitor and consulted with the FIA Medical Delegate.

The Stewards accept the request received from the Competitor and consider the withdrawal of Competitor No. 36 from SECTO RALLY FINLAND as a case of *force majeure*.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
