

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.2.2 TRAFFIC AND RECONNAISSANCE VEHICLES

A maximum speed limit of 80 km/h is imposed on all special stages during reconnaissance unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or by signs placed by the organiser. On Super SS Harju 1/10 and on SS 18/20 Laajavuori a maximum speed limit of 40 km/h is imposed on the whole stage, and on SS 2/6 Laukaa a maximum speed limit of 50 km/h is imposed on the whole stage, unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or signs place by the organiser.



12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 DRIVERS' SAFETY BRIEFING

All P2, P3, P4 and non-priority crews are required to attend Reconnaissance Safety Briefing on Monday 29 July at 20:00 in the Rally HQ. Non-participation will be penalised with a fine of 250 € unless a prior authorisation is granted by the FIA Sporting Delegate. This fine is notified to the competitor by the Clerk of the Course.

All drivers / co-drivers who have not yet participated in a WRC event in 2024 must complete the FIA eLearning course and pass the assessment for FIA Safety Tracking Device by 21.00 19:00 on Monday 29 July and are required to attend the safety briefing on 10.00 Monday 29 July at 20.00 20:15 in the Rally HQ.


