Topic: PV Super Special, Updated Radio Points, and Scrutineering Information

The following information is applied to the running of the Super Special Stages (SS 7 & 8) in Prescott Valley. The location of the stages will be directly west of the service area.

Operation of stage

- Competitors are going to run the stage in current running order at the end of stage 6.
- The stage will be run with the same 2-minute interval already in place.
- Although indicated in the Route Book, there will be no controls for ATC 7 & 8. Teams must be at each of the locations marked ATC 7 & 8 by their calculated times, but there will be no check-in at these locations. Marshals will direct them to the start and start time will be assigned.
- SS8 will start 2 minutes after the last car starts SS 7.

Track Information

Definition and Recce

- The track definition will be defined by a clear cut in the land.
- Competitors will be allowed to recce the stage no more than 3 times on Thursday March 26th, between the hours of 17:00 – 19:00.
- Speed limit for recce is 25mph and RSLite must be utilized.
- No rally cars are to be used for recce.

Rules and Penalties

- Cutting is defined as 4 wheels off on the inside of the defined stage. Cutting will result in a penalty of shortcutting a stage defined in RCR 6.2
- Did not finish (DNF) - If a competitor is unable to finish a Super Special Stage, pull completely off the course if you can. Please activate your hazard light if able to do so. You will receive a DNF for the stage.

Crew will be allowed to watch the super special stage. They are required to be within the spectator area. Any crew that is found outside of the area and near their competitor's vehicle will be deemed to be an illegal service subject to penalties under RCR 6.4.

Updated Radio Points in Route Book.

The following instructions are changes to radio locations.

- Stages 1, 11 – Mile 5.37, Instruction 13 – No Radio
- Stages 4, 6, 10 – Mile 6.23, Instruction 9 – No Radio
- Stages 9, 13 – Mile 4.36, Instruction 15 – No Radio
- Stage 12 – Mile 6.71, Instruction 13 – No Radio
- Stage 13 – Mile 15.54, Instruction 32 – No Radio

Personnel allowed in Scrutineering Area.

Only credentialed ARA officials, Prescott Rally Officials, ARA approved media and competitor car presenters, are allowed in the scrutineering area. All others will be asked to leave the area.
