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## 1 Service Park

### 1.3 Access Times

**Gates Open:** 14:00, Thursday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>  
**Gates Close:** 10:00, Sunday, July 26<sup>nd</sup>

### 1.4 Service Area Size

Standard service areas are a minimum of 20 feet by 50 feet per race vehicle. All competition and registered service vehicles, trailer(s) and service equipment must fit completely within the space(s) assigned. Additional service spots of 20 feet by 25 feet will be an additional \$100 each. See Supplementary Regulations.

### 1.5 Service Assignments

Service assignments will be made by the Service Park Manager and posted in the Advance Information folder on Sportivity. Teams with special service requests (2 cars near each other, last-minute change or space needs, etc.) must contact the Chief of Service before the close of entries.

### **1.6 Service Park Access for Individuals**

All individuals accessing the Service Park, including spectators, are required to have an event wristband. Any person attempting to enter the Service Area without a spectator or participant wristband will be denied entry. During the event, Service Crews and Service Vehicles are only allowed to leave the Service Area on official transit routes as defined in Section 2.2.

### **1.7 Service Park Access for Vehicles**

Only competition and vehicles officially registered with a team as a Service Vehicle are allowed in the Service Park with organizer supplied identification. Each entry will be provided with 2 parking “passes”; one for the service vehicle and one other.

### **1.8 Alcohol**

Alcohol is not permitted in the Service Park at any time.

### **1.9 Direction of Travel in Service Area**

Service Park travel is on-way, counterclockwise.

### **1.10 Environmental Considerations**

Tarps must be placed under race vehicles while servicing to capture potential ethyl glycol and petroleum product spills. Teams should be prepared to quickly clean up any spills using their ARA required spill kit before ground contamination occurs. Boards or supports are required under the jackstands if on a soft surface.

### **1.11 Camping at AOT**

Camping will be available at the AOT Spectator Stage for competitors and crew members.

## **2 Parc Fermé location**

Parc Fermé will be located immediately following the final time control at the Appalachian Overland Triangle (37.481297, -83.815538).

Any post-rally inspections and tear downs of a competing vehicle will be performed within this impound area at the discretion of the event officials. Podiums will be conducted with provisional results at the Appalachian Overland Triangle. Trophies for the class winners in positions 1st – 3rd will be awarded. Trophies not collected at the awards ceremony may be shipped at the competitor’s expense.

### 3 Official Notice Board

There will be no physical notice board. All competitor documents will be distributed via the Sportity App.

### 4 Fuel and Tires

The event places no restrictions beyond the ARA regulations on fuel or tires.  
All refueling must comply with RCR 5.8.

#### 6.1 Scrutineering Location & Time

Scrutineering will be held at Eco-Tech USA (50 Easy Street, London, KY 40741) and is by appointment only. Requests must be submitted by close of entries, or the scrutineer will assign a time to you.

The email must clearly state:

- The appointment hour requested (i.e. 9-10 AM, 2-3 PM, etc)
- Competitor's name
- Car number
- Name and phone number of person presenting car to tech

All requests will receive a confirmation email with the scheduled time.

## **6.2 Logbooks**

## **6.3 RallySafe**

Units will be distributed during scrutineering and teams must enter scrutineering with the fitting it installed. If needed, RallySafe fitting kits are available for rental. You must request the RallySafe fitting kit rental with entry.

All ARA ID Packages and Event provided stickers and identification are to be in place when arriving at scrutineering. ARA Competitor ID packages will not be available for purchase at the event.

The event places no restrictions on service crew spectating.

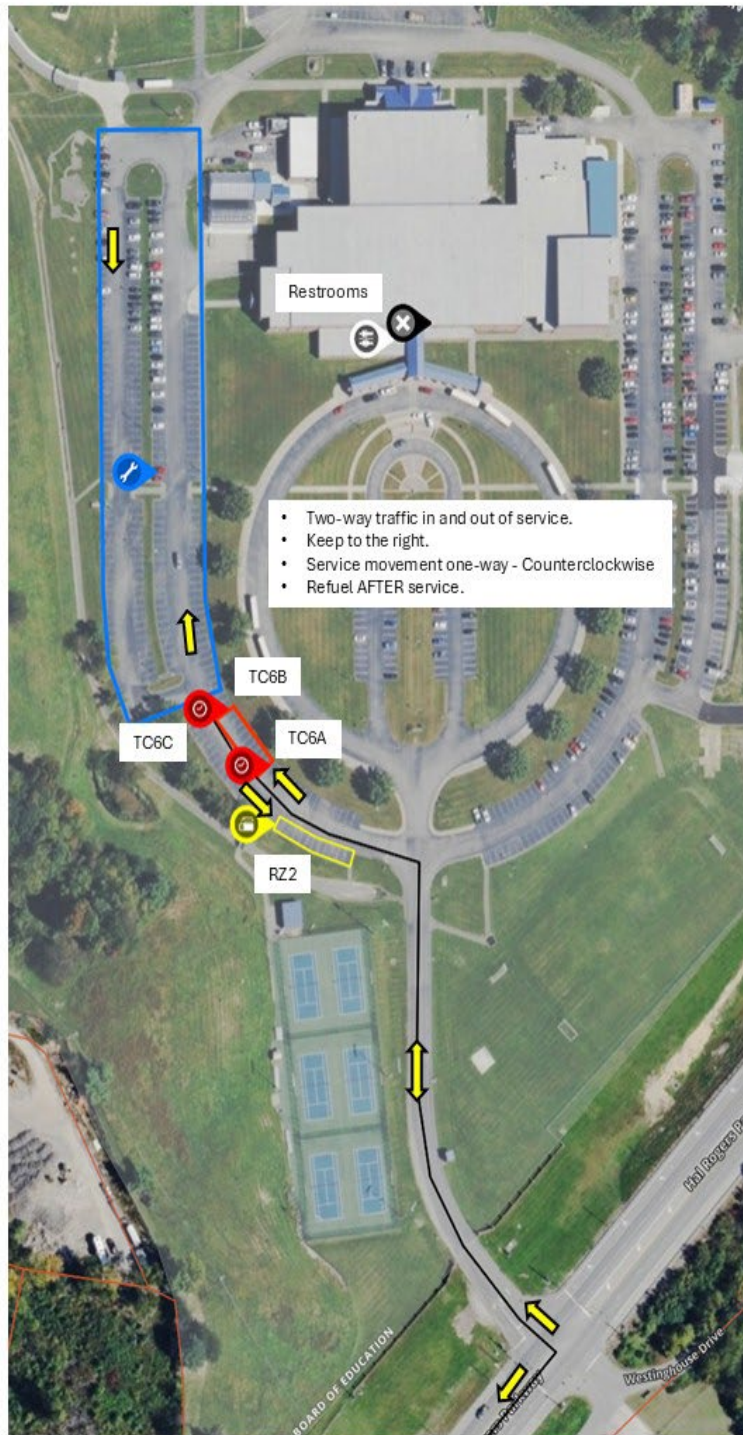

Friday Parc Expose Plan

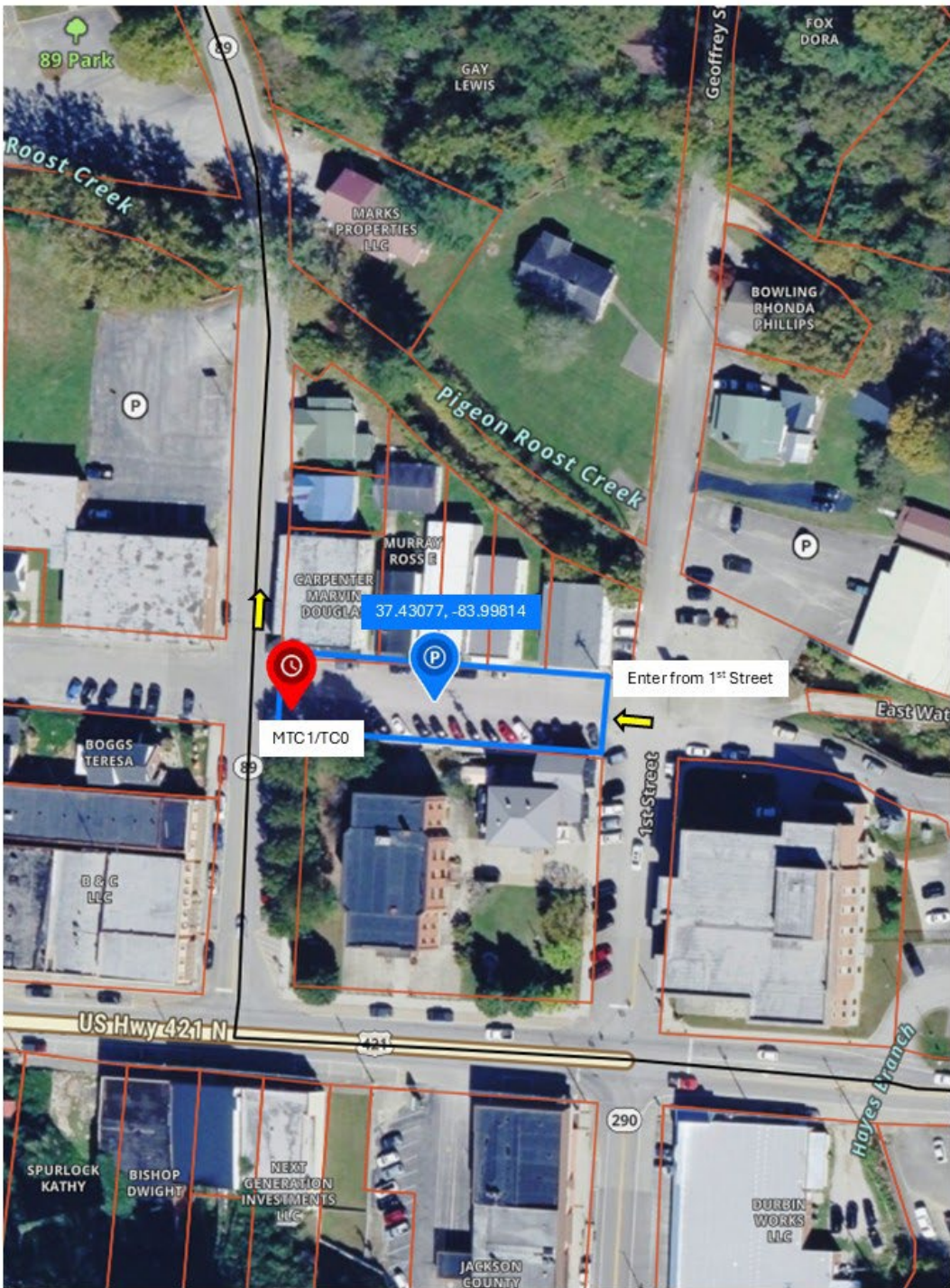




## Service Plan – TC6A/B/C + RZ2

## PRTC Refuel Plan – RZ1 (on transit from SS4 FTC to TC5)

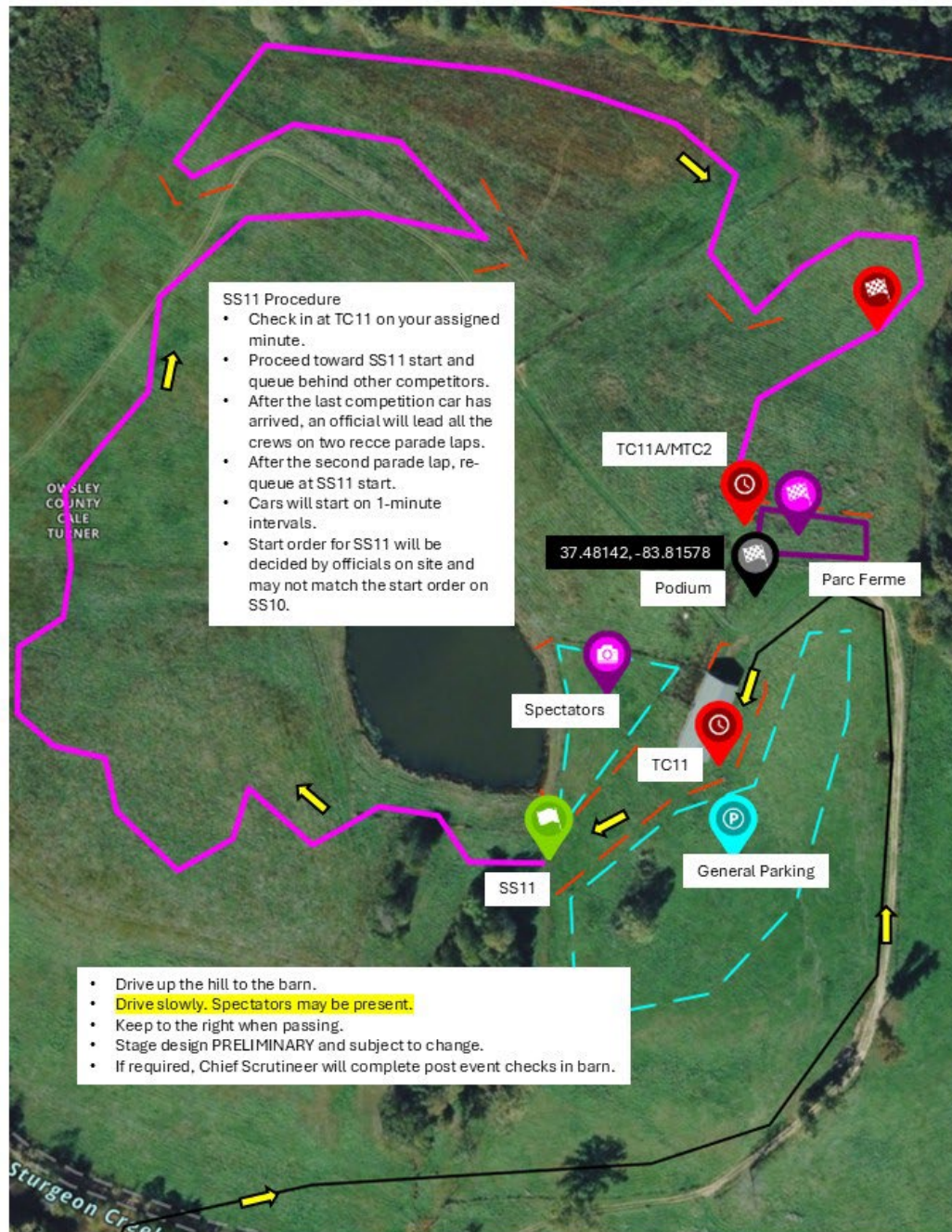




## AOT Regroup and Refuel Plan – TC8A/B + RZ3
