1. INTRODUCTION

Dear competitors friends,

Following the huge success of its previous edition, and under the recommendation of the Organizing Committee at Automobile Club de Monaco (ACM), Rally Monte-Carlo 2023, the inaugural event of FIA World Rally Championship (WRC), will again settle down next winter in the Principality.

The official start will be given on Thursday January 19th from 6.30 pm, in the sumptuous setting of Place du Casino in Monte-Carlo. On the menu for this very first "Turini" night session, two special stages for a total of 40.02km, including a brand new version of "La Bollène-Vésubie / Col de Turini" (SS1 - 15.12km - 8:05 pm), starting for the very first time from Camp de Millo, and a very pacy stage "La Cabanette / Col de Castillon" (SS2 - 24.90km - 9:03 pm) which, for the very first time in the history of the rally, will allow drivers to race through five passes in a row: Col de l'Orme (1000m) then Col de l'Ablé (1149m), Col de Braus (1002m), Col Saint-Jean (642m) and Col de Castillon (706m).

On Friday January 20, crews will be heading for the north of the Alpes-Maritimes department and the second day of racing will total 105.34km against the clock. With a loop of three special stages to be covered twice, and an intermediate stop for a regroup and change of tires in Puget-Théniers, this will be a tough cocktail of hardships! Starting with "Roure / Roubion / Beuil" (SS3/6 - 18.33km - 09:09 am / 2:18 pm) to be run at the foot of the Mercantour National Park, via Col de la Couillole (1678m), then a demanding sequence consisting of "Puget-Théniers / Saint-Antonin" (SS 4/7 - 19.79km - 10:22 am / 3:31 pm) followed by "Brianconnet / Entrevaux" (SS5/8 - 14.55km - 11:25 am / 4:34 pm) via Col du Buis (1196m) and Val-de-Chalvagne. In other words, this 2nd leg promises to be lively!

Next on the menu are Alpes-de-Haute-Provence for the third day of racing on Saturday January 21. The longest day of the Rally, starting with the 2022 version of "Le Fugeret / Thorame-Haute" (SS9/12 - 16.80km - 8:24am / 2:25pm), and continuing « Malijai / Puimichel » (SS10/13 - 17.31km - 10:05am / 4:05pm) and «Ubraye / Entrevaux» (SS11/14 -21.78km - 12:23am by day / 6:23pm by night). This loop will be run twice for a total length of 111.78km for six special stages, before and after a tyre changing zone and a compulsory regroup in **Puget-Théniers**, just like Friday.

Last but not least, for the final leg on **Sunday January 22**, four special stages totaling 67.88km are scheduled, still without assistance. Two well-known stages in the hinterland, in the northeast of Alpes-Maritimes, to be covered twice by all the remaining crews, and not limited to 50 competitors by the regulations, as in previous years, in order to thank amateur crews for their commitment over the past few years. They will all have to deal with the long version of a traditional stage, "Lucéram / Lantosque" (SS15/17 - 18.82km - 07:57 am / 10:40 am) and a couple of passes in the inaugural stage of this 2023 edition "La Bollène-Vésubie / Col de Turini (SS 16/18 - 15.12km - 09:05 am / 12:18 pm). This famous special stage, at the second pass, will serve as Power Stage. Crews will then return to **Monaco** around **2:30 pm** to pass the finish line, the best of them heading then to the Prize-Giving Ceremony on **Place du Casino** at **4:15 pm**.

5.3 Service park regulations and environmental requirements

5.3.1 Environmental requirements

Draining of waste water, car washing and any drilling for stakes into the ground are not permitted in the service park. Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards who may impose penalties.

A washing area will be set up at the entrance to the Service Park.

Unauthorized power supply from street fittings is forbidden. In case of infringement a penalty of 1.500 € will be applied. Any such application of the regulations by the Clerk of the Course will be notified by him to the competitor concerned.

5.3.2 Regulations

Only vehicles displaying a "Service" sticker are authorized to enter in the service park. If these vehicles do not fit in the service park competitors' allocated area, they must be parked in the public car parks.

These vehicles must not be driven in the lanes used by the competing cars 15 minutes prior to the expected arrival of the first competitor at TC SP IN until the last competitor has checked-in at TC SP OUT.

Vehicles displaying "Auxiliary" or "Route Note Car" stickers must mandatorily park in the public car parks.

Any vehicle which is not parked inside the competitor's allocated area in the service park will result in a penalty of 1,500 € per vehicle. Any such application of the regulations by the Clerk of the Course will be notified by him to the competitor concerned.





The circulation of any vehicle with a Total Loaded Weight (PTAC) greater than 3.5 tonnes is prohibited on the Monegasque territory between 08.00 hrs and 09.00 hrs.

6. TWO-WAY RADIO

6.1 Registration procedure

8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Vehicles from the European Union do not need a specific document for Customs clearance. Only non-EU competitors will need to show an ATA (obtainable from the Chamber of Commerce of the country of origin) to Customs Authorities at their point of entry into the European Union. 9. HELICOPTERS

9.1 Registration procedure

In relationship with the FIA Safety Regulations and the requirements of the Civil Aviation authorities, all helicopters participating in the Rally must be registered with the Organiser by submitting the form and will have to present the derogations of the Prefectures of the Alpes-de-Haute-Provence and the Alpes-Maritimes following the articles n°L363-1, L363-2, L363-3 and L363-4 of the law 3DS dated April 24, 2022.

18.2.1 Principles

- 1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 91st Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.
 - Only one pass will be issued to websites. Photo, TV or Radio tabards are not issued for websites.
- 2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The Central Offices or premises of the main International Agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
- 3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.
- 4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....
- A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website.





18.2.2 Procedures

1. Foreign Media must submit their request to the FIA before **Thursday**, **5**th **January 2023**. The international accreditation form is available on the FIA website:

- 2. Monegasque Media must send their request on the ACM official website www.acm.mc before Thursday, 29th December 2022.
- 3. Press photographers under contract with agencies or publications must provide documentation justifying the publication of a minimum of 15 pictures of the previous edition (2022).

- The accreditation form completed;
- An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
- A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
- Copies of the published articles covering the 2022 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly also those dealing with the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo;
- A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2023;
- Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2023, with details on release dates or broadcast.
- 5. Documents submitted late and/or incomplete will not be considered.
