1. INTRODUCTION

Dear competitors friends,

Following the huge success of its previous edition, and under the recommendation of the Organizing Committee at Automobile Club de Monaco (ACM), Rally Monte-Carlo 2023, the inaugural event of FIA World Rally Championship (WRC), will again settle down next winter in the Principality.

The official start will be given on Thursday January 19th from 6.30 pm, in the sumptuous setting of Place du Casino in Monte-Carlo. On the menu for this very first "Turini" night session, two special stages for a total of 40.93km, including a brand new version of "La Bollène-Vésubie / Col de Turini" (SS1 - 15.52km - 8:18 pm), starting for the very first time from Camp de Millo, and a very pacy stage "La Cabanette / Col de Castillon" (SS2 - 25.41km - 9:11 pm) which, for the very first time in the history of the rally, will allow drivers to race through five passes in a row: Col de l'Orme (1000m) then Col de l'Ablé (1149m), Col de Braus (1002m), Col Saint-Jean (642m) and Col de Castillon (706m).

On **Friday January 20th**, crews will be heading for the north of the Alpes-Maritimes department and the second day of racing will total 106.18km against the clock. With a loop of three special stages to be covered twice, and an intermediate stop for a regroup and tires change in **Puget-Théniers**, this will be a tough cocktail of hardships! Starting with "Roure / Beuil" (SS3/6 - 18.33km - 09:14 am / 2:08 pm) to be run at the foot of the Mercantour National Park, via Col de la Couillole (1678m), then a demanding sequence consisting of "Puget-Théniers / Saint-Antonin" (SS 4/7 - 20.06km -10:22 am / 3:16 pm) followed by "Briançonnet / Entrevaux" (SS5/8 - 14.70km - 11:25 am / 4:19 pm) via Col du Buis (1196m) and Val-de-Chalvagne. In other words, this 2nd leg promises to be lively!

Next on the menu are Alpes-de-Haute-Provence for the third day of racing on Saturday January 21st , which will total 98,43km spread over five special stages. Starting with the 2020 version of "Malijai / Puimichel" (SS9/11 - 17.47km - 09:38 am / 2:08 pm) and continuing with "Saint-Geniez / Thoard" (SS10/12 - 20.79km - 11:26 am / 3:56 pm) via Authon and its dreaded Col de Fontbelle. Between the two loops, there will be a "tire" stop and mandatory regrouping in the heart of Digneles-Bains. Eventually, at the end of yet another day without service, crews will have to take on "Ubraye / Entrevaux" (SS13 - 21.91km - 5:59 pm), at night, via Route de la Clue along Ravin-de-Chalvagne.

Last but not least, for the final leg on Sunday January 22nd, four special stages totaling 68.98km are scheduled, still without assistance. Two well-known stages in the hinterland, in the north-east of Alpes-Maritimes, to be covered twice by all the remaining crews, and not limited to 50 competitors by the regulations, as in previous years, in order to thank amateur crews for their commitment over the past few years. They will all have to deal with the long version of a traditional stage, "Lucéram / Lantosque" (SS14/16 - 18.97km - 08:01 am / 10:40 am) and a couple of passes in the inaugural stage of this 2023 edition "La Bollène-Vésubie / Col de Turini (SS 15/17 - 15.52km - 09:08 am / 12:18 pm). This famous special stage, on the second run, will serve as Power Stage. Crews will then return to **Monaco** around 2:30 pm to cross the finish line, the best of them heading to the Prize-Giving Ceremony on Place du Casino at 4:15 pm.

4.2 Entry procedure

Any RGT and non-priority drivers wishing to take part in the "91st Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2023" must complete the electronic entry form available on the ACM website and pay online before Friday, 16th December 2022 - 24h00.

Manufacturers registered in the FIA World Rally Championship, as well as the WRC 2 and WRC 3 Competitors must use the standard FIA entry form available on the FIA website.

By sending an electronic form, the competitor undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of the competition, as well as the prescriptions of the 2023 FIA WRC SR Art. 22.5. Competitors will sign the entry form at the Administrative Checks.

If a competitor cannot make the entry on the internet, he must contact the rally secretariat before close of entries for further instructions.

4.3 Number of entrants accepted and categories

The maximum number of entrants is 75, divided in 5 priority groups: priority 1 (P1), priority 2 (P2), priority 3 (P3), RGT and non-priority (NP).

The classification "Promotion" is reserved to non-priority drivers entered in the name of the driver (driver = competitor).

9. HELICOPTERS

9.1 Registration procedure

In relationship with the FIA Safety Regulations and the requirements of the Civil Aviation authorities, all helicopters participating in the Rally must be registered with the Organiser by submitting the form and will have to present the derogations of the Prefectures of the Alpesde-Haute-Provence and the Alpes-Maritimes following the articles n°L363-1, L363-2, L363-3 and L363-4, of the law 3DS dated April 24, 2022.





The registration form (Appendices 3 and 4) must be submitted before Friday, 30th December 2022.

The fee due to the organiser is 2,000 € per helicopter (500 € for costs incurred will not be refunded if weather conditions are unfavourable and no flight can be made).

A compulsory helicopter pilots briefing will be held on Thursday, 19th January 2023.

18.2 Accreditation procedure

18.2.1 Principles

1. A maximum of three representatives (journalist and/or photographers) per publication may be accredited for the 91st Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo.

Only one pass will be issued to websites. Photo, TV or Radio tabards are not issued for websites.

- 2. Agencies must meet the same criteria as publications. The Central Offices or premises of the main International Agencies will be accredited by the FIA.
- 3. To be accredited, Media must have a distribution that meets criteria of quality and quantity of the FIA.





- 4. The advertising, public relation, marketing, agencies, etc.... shall in no case be accredited as Media, and Organiser will not issue accreditation to representatives (press officer or otherwise) of sponsors, suppliers, manufacturers, drivers, etc....
- A Media holding a permanent pass issued by the FIA and wishing an additional accreditation for journalist and/or photographers must apply directly on the FIA website.

- The accreditation form completed;
- An application for accreditation on an official letterhead paper of the media or agency and signed by the editor or publisher;
- A copy of the publication and information diffusion (distribution, readership, frequency...) just for first-time applicants;
- Copies of the published articles covering the 2022 FIA World Rally Championship and possibly also those dealing with the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo;
- A photocopy of the press card of the representative who will cover the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2023;
- Information on the coverage provided for the Rallye Automobile Monte-Carlo 2023, with details on release dates or broadcast.
