Clarification regarding Main Time Controls, Timecards and Due Start Times

This year the event will take place over two days (Legs).

National and Bowler Defender Challenge

Leg 1 starts from Llanrwst (MC1) on Friday 28th October, at 19:05h where timecards will be issued.

Due start times for Leg 1 will be published via Sportity at 16:00h on the Friday.

After completing the evening stages and service, this Leg will finish in Llandudno Junction, parc fermé (MC2), where Leg 1 timecards will be collected.

Due start times for Leg 2 (Saturday) will be issued at 22:00h, Friday 28th October.

Leg 2, starts on Saturday 29th October from Llandudno Junction, parc fermé out (MC2A). Timecards for Leg 2 will be distributed at parc fermé 'out' (MC2A), 10 minutes before your due parc fermé 'out' time.

Crews will follow the road book route (p35 to p37) to Llandudno promenade (MC3)

Due start times for parc fermé 'out' (MC2A), along with due times at MC3 will be issued at 22:00h, Friday 28th October.

Interclub event

The Interclub event starts on Saturday 29th October, at 08:01h from Llandudno promenade (MC3).

Due start times for the start of the Interclub event (MC3), will be issued at 22:00h, Friday 28th October.

Timecards for the Interclub event will be distributed at MC3.

Please note that the timecards issued are "generic". Please ignore the time control boxes on Timecard Record Sheet 4 labelled Due MC2A and Actual MC2A, as these are for the national competitors only.
