

Service Crew Information

First of all, we'd like to thank you for attending the 2022 Visit Conwy Cambrian Rally, we're delighted to be able to welcome you to Llandudno and North Wales for this years event.

This Service Book is designed to help make the process of arrival, setting up and competing on the event as easy and as fluid as possible. Please help us to help you by taking the time to read through the information provided. **Competitors – please ensure you pass this information onto your service personnel.**

Only 6 service personnel and one service vehicle displaying the Service Pass on the exterior of the vehicle are permitted per car. Please ensure you are wearing your wristbands upon entering the Service Park – No wristband, No entry, No exceptions!

New for 2022, the Service Park is situated within the Car Parks of the Welsh Assembly Government building, 3.7 miles from Llandudno. It is **imperative** that you respect the facilities provided; use the litterbins provided or take your rubbish home with you, use the portaloos placed around the Service Park. The Service Park is adjacent to a number of residential properties – please respect the local residents by driving in a courteous manner.

Please familiarise yourselves with Article 12 within the Event Regulations. All teams are allocated a space of 7m x 7m; teams who are servicing more than one competing car and those who use a vehicle larger than 7.5T must inform the Service Park Manager before Friday 21st October.

Traffic Movements

The speed of cars in the service and trailer parks may not exceed 15 mph. Failure to comply with this limit shall result in a penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course.

Competitors may bring their recce cars into the Service Park providing they can park them within the designated areas. Due to limitations on space, any parking of team vehicles outside of their designated area is strictly prohibited. Failure to comply will result in a penalty of 10 minutes at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Please keep the flow of traffic moving.

Environmental Requirements

All competitors must use a suitable size plastic ground sheet to cover the whole area where service work is being carried out. This ground sheet must be impervious to all fluids. The penalty for not adhering to this is £100 per offence.

Washing cars within the service park is prohibited at any time due to the risk of contamination. All waste material must be disposed of in the facilities provided at the service park – please take all used fluids and tyres with you. Please do not be responsible for contamination within the Service Park.

Management Vehicles

Management Vehicles are NOT permitted on this event. Any competitors found to be receiving outside assistance, including from members of their Service Crews, will be **DISQUALIFIED** from the event.

Friday Procedure

It is **CRUCIAL** that all crews follow the below procedure on Friday 28th October. Trailers are not permitted within the Service Park. Anyone who arrives to the Service Park with their trailer on and without their passes will be turned away.

On arrival to Llandudno, please head straight to the Dale Road Car Park to unload your trailer. Please park considerately to other competitors and other car park users.

The landowner regularly uses this area; **please** take your rubbish with you.

Trailers: Please park your trailers sensibly and ensure it is secure – we cannot accept any liability. **Under no circumstances must trailers be taken into the Service Park or onto the Promenade in Llandudno.**

BRC Crews: Your Road Book, Competitor Passes and Recce stickers can be collected at the Recce meeting point on Friday morning. Your Service Personnel can then collect all other documentation in the Rally Packs as normal.

From this point, Service Vehicles can head to the Service Park.

Vital Equipment and Old Hall Performance will be placed here for refuelling on Friday only. There will be no facility for refuelling on Saturday morning. All crews are responsible for the ordering of their fuel, the event is NOT responsible for this. Please familiarise yourself with SR Art 8.

BRC Crews: There is no refuelling during Friday's schedule. Please ensure your car has sufficient fuel to complete the Friday loop to RZ1 on Saturday, including travelling to Llanrwst for MC0.

There is strictly no refuelling in the Service Park except in the following instance: When necessary as part of changing the fuel pump or fuel tank, this can only be done by prior permission from the Service Park Manager.

Super Unleaded fuel is available just off route at Black Cat Garage, Glan Conwy Corner – at the junction of A470 and at Shell in Betws y Coed.

Service Personnel may present the car for Noise and Scrutineering. You will be provided with a Scrutineering time in a separate bulletin, please ensure you arrive at the time provided. Please familiarise yourself with SR Art 11.

Saturday Scrutineering will be between 06:30 and 07:30 by **strict appointment only**, to be held in the Victoria Centre Car Park. Please do not assume.

On Board Cameras

Those running in-car cameras must ensure the cameras are installed prior to Scrutineering, where they will be assessed as part of the Scrutineering process.

Number Plates

North Wales Police are strict on vehicle registration numbers – please ensure that these are legal (correct size, font and spacing) at the time of Scrutineering.

Service Park Facilities

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ENTER THE GOVERNMENT BUILDING. There are plenty of male and female toilets provided, together with disabled facilities, around the site. Please be considerate to other users.

Bins have been provided and can be found around the Service Area. **PLEASE USE THEM OR TAKE YOUR RUBBISH HOME.** We need to return the venue in the same condition as we found it, your assistance in this matter is greatly appreciated.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO CREWS ARE PERMITTED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN THE SERVICE PARK. THIS IS AT THE REQUEST OF THE LANDOWNER. ANYONE FOUND TO BE DOING SO WILL BE PENALISED UP TO 10 MINUTES AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLERK OF THE COURSE. THERE WILL BE SECURITY ON SITE CHECKING FOR THIS. YOU HAVE BEEN WARNED.


Overview Map


