

Reconnaissance Notes for National Competitors Only

Welcome to the Visit Conwy Cambrian Rally and thank you again for your entry. We are delighted to again be a round of the British Rally Championship. Can we please ask that you take the time to read these notes carefully before you arrive to the meeting point on Friday morning.

If you are late, please wait at the START of SS3 Clocaenog for the convoy to return for the second pass. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE STAGE.

Recce Document Collection

Please arrive in plenty of time to collect your Road Book, Competitors wristband and Recce Sticker, we will be leaving at 08:00 prompt! By completing pre-event Signing On by Tuesday 25th October, you will be deemed to have signed on for recce. Please ensure you have completed your online entry form with your recce vehicle details.

Please either print a copy of these Recce Notes to bring with you or download a copy to your phone, no hard copies will be available at the meeting point and phone signal may not be available to be able to view via Sportity.

Format

Recce will be in the form of a convoy system with official cars at the front, at the mid point and at the rear of the convoy, they will all be in radio contact. The top 10 crews will be running in numerical order so please park sensibly on arrival to allow these crews through. This sequence will be maintained throughout the recce.

The route has been designed to use the event Roadbook for as much of the recce as possible. Where we deviate from it, it is only for a short distances, please follow the directions later on in this document. These sections will also be arrowed.

NRW have agreed to a strictly controlled recce, allowing a maximum of two passes per competitor per stage, with a speed limit of 30mph. NRW have asked us the organisers to remind all competitors that the roads are **not closed** to other users. Therefore, there is a very strong possibility that you will come across;

- 1. Forestry workers,
- 2. Timber hauliers,
- 3. Dog walkers,
- 4. Mountain Bikers

When on NRW land all official cars will be using flashing Amber lights, this is not only for your safety, but also for the safety of the other users of NRW land.

Please show consideration and above all exercise great caution, anyone found to be abusing this will be penalised accordingly at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Nebo

This year is the first time the event has used the Nebo stage. It is very important to note that the stage will **NOT** be closed during the recce. It is imperative to the future use of this stage that competitors drive with consideration to other road users, members of the public and the residents who live on the stage. Anyone found to be bringing the sport into disrepute through careless driving **will be penalised**.

Penalties

Please remember that the Regulations allow for the awarding of stated penalties for recce infringements, including delay of the recce. It may not be possible to advise you of a first offence before we receive notification of a second offence, so please do remember this.

There will be monitoring of driving standards (including the use of speed guns). In addition, there will be rally officials within each of the stages, setting up in preparation for the rally itself,

along with representatives from NRW. **All** of these individuals will be empowered to report on the conduct of you the competitor, so please keep a constant steady pace, do not stop and start and never reverse back to have another look at a corner, all of these things will see you awarded with a penalty so **BE WARNED**.

Since there is likely to be Police presence on the public highway please pay attention to the speed limits and show consideration to the other road users, particularly on the narrow roads around the forest. Finally the stages could potentially to be very muddy so when coming out onto the public highway please ensure that your number plates and lights are clean and clear to view.

Fuel

Competitors are reminded to please turn up with a full tank of fuel. There is a fuel station on the route, the Shell Garage in Betws Y Coed, which can be accessed **briefly** between the second pass of SS6 and the first pass of SS1 but please don't rely on this.

Tyres / Spares

Please make sure that you have more then one spare tyre (A space saver does not work in a forest). We have previously had competitors unable to complete any of the recce as they had a punctured tyre on their hire car and it had no spare.

Please note, lots of cars now have inflation kits that also do not work well in a forest.

Schedule

The recce schedule in this document has been set at a more than achievable pace; we hope the recce will finish earlier than scheduled. If we arrive ahead of the below schedule and all crews are accounted for and in the queue, we **will** press on ahead of schedule.

We have not included a break in the schedule for refreshments so that it may finish earlier in the afternoon. Please bring sufficient food and water with you to ensure you remain hydrated and fed during the day.

Please note: SS3 Clocaenog uses a slightly different route to SS7 Clocaenog; we will be providing crews with the opportunity to note the SS7 route as part of the second pass of SS3. Please pay particular attention to the notes provided below.

Convoy Written Schedule

To SS3 & 7 Clocaenog East

- Exit the meeting point and join the B4501 towards Cerrigydrudion.
- Follow for 3.7 miles/6km; at the T-Junction turn **Left** rejoining RS2D at Page 42 Box 22. Continue to follow RS2D to the stage.

SS3 & 7 Clocaenog East

First Pass – Follow Road Book for SS3

To Second Pass

• At the stage exit, turn **Right** rejoining RS2D at Page 43 Box 26, follow to the stage.

Second Pass – Please follow the below guidance;

- On commencing the second pass use the tulips for SS7 Clocaenog East 2, following to Page 88 Box 10.
- At Page 88 Box 10, continue **Straight**, following the forest road for 170m.
- At the triangle, keep right. You will rejoin the route at Page 87 Box 3 (keeping right on approach)
- Repeat the above to complete a second pass of SS7 Clocaenog East 2
- On arrival at Page 87 Box 3 after the second pass, please turn to Page 45 Box 3 (SS3 Clocaenog 1) and follow to the end to complete a second pass of SS3.

To SS4 & 8 Brenig

• Follow Roadbook – RS3 Page 49 Box 1 to Page 50 Box 1.

SS4 & 8 Brenig

To Second Pass

- Follow the roadbook from Page 57 Box 1 to Box 4. At Box 4, turn Left NOT Right.
- Follow the B4501 for 1.8 miles/2.9km; turn **Left** (into single track road). After 140m turn **Left** again.
- Follow the single-track road for 3.2 miles/5.2km. Please take absolute care past all residential properties in Pentre-Ilyn-cymmer.
- At the Giveway, turn **Right** onto RS3 at Page 49 Box 5; continue to follow RS3 to stage.

To SS5 & 9 Alwen

- Follow Roadbook RS4 Page 57 Box 1 to Page 58 Box 1.
- SS5 & 9 Alwen

To Second Pass

- Follow Roadbook RS5 Page 65 Box 1 to Box 2.
- At Box 2, turn **Left**, rejoining RS4 at Page 57 Box 4; continue to follow RS4 to stage.

To SS6 & 10 Penmachno

• Follow Roadbook – RS5 Page 65 Box 1 to Page 67 Box 1.

SS6 & 10 Penmachno

To Second Pass

- Follow Roadbook RS6 Page 73 Box 1 to Page 73 Box 5
- At Box 5, turn Right NOT Left. Follow A5 for 1.6 miles/2.6km
- Turn **Right** SP: Penmachno. Rejoin RS5 at Page 66 Box 8, follow RS5 to stage.

To SS1 & 2 Nebo

- Follow Roadbook RS6 Page 73 Box 1 to Page 74 Box 8.
- From Box 8, continue to follow for 0.3 mile/500m, turn **Right SP: Nebo and IMMEDIATELY Right** again (also SP: Nebo).
- Join RSO at Page 11 Box 4, continue to follow to stage.

SS1 & 2 Nebo

To Second Pass

- Follow Roadbook RS1 Page 19 Box 1 to Box 5.
- From Box 5, continue to follow for 0.2 mile/300m then turn Left.
- Follow for 0.3 mile/550m, turn Left BEFORE T-Junction.
- Rejoin RSO at Page 11 Box 4, continue to follow to stage.

On completion of the second pass of Nebo, competitors are free to make their way back towards Llandudno. Competitors are encouraged to follow the roadbook, please follow RS2 Page 29 Box 1 onwards.

Note: For the purposes of ensuring you have enough fuel to complete the day; it is approximately 31 miles from the Service Park to Llyn Brenig Visitor Centre via the A470. It is then 15 miles from the end of Nebo to the Service Park following RS2.

Finally, have a good day but remember these basic rules. It has taken us a long time to establish a good relationship with all parties affected by the holding of this event, NRW and the communities.
