2.1 **Environmental Sustainability**

As part of our commitment to minimise the environmental impact, the Visit Conwy Cambrian Rally's aim is to actively continue to make our event more sustainable, working both internally, and with external partners, to ensure our event impacts on the environment as little as possible.

This is, and will be, an ongoing process and includes every aspect of the event; provisions on special stages, in the Service Park and within our general administration tasks, including those within Rally HQ. The specific aims for the 2022 Visit Conwy Cambrian Rally are as follows:

- Become a paperless event as far as practicable by introducing a Digital Noticeboard.
- Introduce hybrid and/or EV vehicles to the Official Course Car team where available.
- Minimise impact on ground and water contamination within the Service Park
- Encourage waste reduction and separation by providing recycling bins within the Service Park and Rally HQ and to provide waste bags in Spectator Areas to encourage visitors to take their rubbish home.
- Reduce the level of vehicular movement within the event as much as possible.
- Encourage competitors to make use of the specific Motorsport Carbon Offset scheme available through Carbon Positive Motorsport.

Recce is open to all National Competitor Crews only. Recce will now commence at 08:00hrs prompt, please arrive by 07:45 as we may leave earlier if it is a clear morning. On completion of Event Signing On (Monday 24th October), all crews will be deemed to have signed on for recce—there will be no additional signing on required. **Please take the time to read the Recce Instructions via Sportity.**

Registration procedure

All competitors must provide the details of the reconnaissance car on their entry form **PRIOR** to completing the Signing On procedure. There will not be a separate electronic Recce Registration form. Should the competitor be required to change their car details, they must email the entries secretary at the earliest opportunity – a cross check will be carried out before recce commences.

7. Procedure: Friday 28th October

It is **CRUCIAL** that all crews follow the below procedure on Friday 28th October. Trailers are not permitted within the Service Park. Anyone who arrives to the service park with their trailer on or without their passes fixed to their vehicle and personal passes not worn will be turned away.

Trailers: Please park your trailers sensibly and ensure it is secure – we cannot accept any liability for loss or damage.

Under no circumstances must trailers be taken into the Service Park or onto the Promenade in Llandudno.

7.2 Rally Pack Collection & Noise Test

National Crews: Your Road Book, Competitor Passes and Recce stickers can be collected at the Recce meeting point on Friday morning. Your Service Personnel can then collect all other documentation in the Rally Packs **from 11:00 as advertised**

Non-National crews inc Bowlers, Your Road Book, Competitor Passes and other documents can be collected from the noise test location (Builder St) on the Friday at your designated time...

There will be no facility in Llandudno for refueling on Saturday morning. All crews are responsible for the ordering of their fuel, the event is NOT responsible for this. Please familiarise yourself with SR Art 8.

Super Unleaded fuel is available just off route at Black Cat Garage, Glan Conwy Corner (at the junction of A470) and at Shell in Betws y Coed.

Service Personnel may present the car for Noise and Scrutineering. You will be provided with a Scrutineering time in a separate bulletin, please ensure you arrive at the time provided. **Please familiarise yourself with SR Art 11** – 2 members of the Service Crew can present the car to Scrutineering. Maximum of 2 people per competing car in scrutineering.

The Bowler Defender Challenge cars will be scrutineered at **Rybrook Conwy Land Rover at 11:00.**

Due to the volume of entries received, there will be no facility to Scrutineer on the Saturday morning. If you are stuck, please ring and we will try and accommodate you!

7.4.1 On Board Cameras & Auxiliary Lights

Those running in-car cameras & auxiliary lights must ensure the cameras are installed prior to Scrutineering, where they will be assessed as part of the Scrutineering process.

7.4.2 Number Plates


North Wales Police are strict on vehicle registration numbers – please ensure that these are legal (correct size, font and spacing) at the time of Scrutineering – if not the vehicle is not road legal and you will fail scrutineering

7.5 Overnight Parking

There is also overnight parking available within Victoria Centre Car Park as per previous years for a fee of £10. This must be paid via your entry form; anyone parking in the car park without a sticker will be invoiced for £10 following the event. There will be spare stickers available at the Trailer Park.

7.6 Identification

Reminder of identification requirements (SR Art 6). These will be checked at scrutineering. As a reminder, the number on the WRC Style header MUST point towards the FRONT of the car. The header must be placed towards the top of the door on the and as far forwards on the door as possible.



Competitors are requested that the rear rally plate is affixed to the centre of the rear screen (when viewed from the rear of the car).

Please **DO NOT** attempt to gain access to the Service Park without your passes. The service vehicle sticker MUST be stuck to the outside of the nominated vehicle and all service personnel must be wearing the allocated wrist bands. Individuals with damaged ones will not be allowed entry.

A Service Book will be made available via Sportity prior to the event, please forward this onto your Service Personnel for their attention.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO CREWS ARE PERMITTED TO STAY OVERNIGHT IN THE SERVICE PARK. THIS IS AT THE REQUEST OF THE LAND OWNER. ANYONE FOUND TO BE DOING SO WILL BE PENALISED UP TO 10 MINUTES AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLERK OF THE COURSE. THERE WILL BE SECURITY ON SITE CHECKING FOR THIS. YOU HAVE BEEN WARNED.

Management vehicles are strictly **PROHIBITED** on the event.

The following rules will applied to all competitors:

The presence of team personnel or any team conveyance is prohibited within 1 mile radius of its competing car except:

- In service parks and in remote service zones (RSZ)
- In refuel zones two team personnel are allowed
- For one team member per car in official car wash areas
- In special stages (from the yellow sign at the beginning of the time control to the stop sign at the end of the special stage)

- Whilst the cars are in a media zone
- Where the competing cars following the route as prescribed in the road book are required to use the same road(s) at the same time as team personnel, provided that they do not stop at the same location at the same time.


The passing of food, drink, clothing and information (data card, road book, etc.) to or from the crew is permitted in service parks, remote service zones, regroups or whilst the cars are in a media zone.

8.1 Environmental

Please take responsibility for your rubbish. Place all waste in the bins provided or take it with you on your departure. Try to prevent oil stains occurring if possible. Make sure that you have the means to remove any oils that you drain or have leaked from the vehicles off-site.

Please ensure that you take with you all the mud that you may have scraped off the rally car and rubbish. We MUST return the area back to its original state for Monday morning we appreciate your support with this please. Thank you.

8.2 Facilities

The Service Park is well equipped with plenty of toilets and refreshments – please use them.

8.3 Tyre Trucks & Trade

All tyre trucks & trade will be placed within Mostyn Broadway Coach Park on Friday 28th. The tyre trucks will then relocate to the service area for Saturday 29th.

8.4 Parc Fermé


All vehicles in the National Event including Bowlers must be presented to Parc Fermé (MC2) at their due time.

Crews must be aware of Yearbook sections R38.2/R38.2.

Crews can only access their vehicle 10 minutes before their due time at MC2A.

Re-start times for MC2A will be issued at 22:00hrs along with MC3 due time.

R38.2. Crews may work unassisted on their own cars, using equipment carried in their car, in 'No Service Areas' except:

- (a) Within 100m of any Control.
- (b) Between a Special Stage Arrival Control and the Special Stage Start Control.
- (c) In any Parc Fermé.

R38.2.1. The only work permitted in these areas is the following (unassisted): Cleaning lamp glasses, windscreens, windows, identification markings and vehicle registration numbers.

9. Start/Finish Procedure

9.1 Start Location

Friday Leg1: National & Bowlers will begin from MC1 at Llanwrst, at 19:05. Start times will be issued at 16:00 on Friday 28th October via Sportity. TIME CARDS WILL BE ISSUED AT MC1.

Saturday: Leg 2 of the event will begin at MC3 on the Promenade in Llandudno at 08:01. This is the Re-start for the Nationals and Bowlers, and the Start for Interclub. Start times will be issued at 22:00 on Friday 28th October via Sportity. TIMECARDS WILL BE ISSUED AT MC3.

9.2 Finish Location

The event will conclude at MC6 on Llandudno Promenade, near the Cenotaph. Event Media will be present and all winning crews are expected to remain at the finish location for the media to take photographs and conduct any interviews.

9.3 Leaking Fluids

If your car is leaking fluid please **DO NOT** bring your car onto the Promenade – the co-driver must inform the marshals and proceed on foot to the control. If you proceed to drop fluid on the promenade we will have to employ the services of a commercial cleaner, the cost of which will be passed onto the competitor responsible.

"In line with GR R31.1.3, please note that times will be recorded to whole minutes for all sections, except Special Stages which will be timed to the nearest preceding 1/10th of a second. Penalties will be applied in accordance with R32.2(f)."

10.3 Award Eligibility:

Award eligibility will be based off the number of entries starters in each class

10.4 Running Order:

Leg 1: Cars running in order of anticipated performance starting with car 1, followed by Bowler Defenders running in order of anticipated performance starting with car 401.

Leg 2: The order of starting will be at the organisers discretion, based on R24.1.4. The organisers reserve the right to re-seed any change of car, driver and/or class. Permission has been granted by Motorsport UK to place classes RF1.0, RF1.4, RF2.0, 1400C, 1400S, H1/2 at the front of the field and run in reverse order, followed by a 5 minute gap to the main field which will include all the remaining National and Interclub crews in seeded order. The BRC competitors will be group seeded within the main field
