The Stewards have received a report from the Competitors Relations Officer regarding competitor of car No 16 (Ahmed Binkhanen)

Facts: The competitor was unable to attend and participate in the practice session due to force majeure and therefore did not take a part of the required practice lap.

Offence: Breach of Article 3.1.3 of the Sporting and Technical Regulations of the Saudi Toyota Time Attack Championship.

Decision: Disqualified. The disqualification decision is suspended until the end of the Championship.

The Stewards acknowledge the force majeure that prevented the competitor from attending the practice session. However, as the competitor did not take a part of the required practice lap under Article 3.1.3, the prescribed sporting consequence must be applied consistently to all competitors

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limit.
