The Stewards have received a report from the Clerck of the Corse, and having summoned the competitor of car No 40 (Mohammed Habbal)

Facts: The competitor did not record a timed lap during the practice session.

Offence: Breach of Article 3.1.3 of the Sporting and Technical Regulations of the Saudi Toyota Time Attack Championship.

Decision: No Further Action.

After hearing the competitor and reviewing the circumstances, the stewards determined that the car commenced a lap from the starting start/finish line after completing his hot lap and subsequently entered the pit lane due to a mechanical issue. Accordingly, the car completed a full lap as defined by the regulations that no lap time was recorded.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limit.
