

Safety Harness / Seat Belts:

For a S1 Rallysprint, a **minimum of a Type C seat belt** complying with Schedule I is required for each crew member (as per the table below):

Please Note that a Safety Harness is not compulsory for the event but if YOU DO HAVE a 5 Point or 6 Point harness installed, it cannot be used if it is dated after 31 December, five years after the year stated on the compliance label.

Art. 3 SCRUTINEERING & DOCUMENTATION (Additional Instructions)

If you have elected to have your car and apparel scrutineered at any 2023/24 Whiteline Tarmac Rallysprint Series Event, please ensure the following:

1. Present your car in 'ready to race' condition. Please follow the following instructions before attending Scrutineering to aid the Event Scrutineers:
 - a. Empty the boot;
 - b. Have your Helmet/s ready for inspection. To aid the scrutineers, please locate the 'standard' identification sticker before lining up. (Please make sure it is a compliant helmet as per the details above in Art. 2)
 - c. If you have a Fire Extinguisher installed (not compulsory for this event) and it is dated prior to 11-2020 please remove it from your vehicle.
 - d. Safety harnesses / Seat Belts will be checked for compliance (Please see the Safety Harness details above in Art. 2).
