## Amendment to the Supplementary Regulations

### 8. FUEL

#### 8.4 Fuel for non-priority drivers (amend)

Non-priority drivers may use either FIA fuel following the same conditions and rules as the priority drivers, Avgas fuel or commercially available pump fuel, dispensed only from pumps at filling stations marked in the Road Book. The distances between these filling stations may be different from those given in the Itinerary (Appendix 1).

Avgas may be ordered for use by non-priority drivers using the fuel order form for Avgas found on [www.safarirally.ke](http://www.safarirally.ke). Orders must be placed no later than Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026.

All non-priority competitors using pump fuel ~~or Avgas~~ are reminded to pay attention to 2026 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 62.3.7; cars equipped solely with FIA-specified refuel couplings and using fuel as per Art. 62.1.2 must transport the adaptor in the car and show it at pre-event scrutineering.


**Non-priority drivers using Avgas fuel are permitted to refuel at the designated Refuel Zones as indicated in the Itinerary. Teams' service personnel are permitted to use their own fuel drums and pumps at these Refuel Zones. The number of team personnel is limited to two persons per assisted car.**

**All personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear fire-resistant clothing that offers adequate protection. This includes, as a minimum: long trousers, a long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves, and a balaclava.**

**The Organiser will provide the Environmental Mat as per Art. 61.2.4 of the 2026 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.**
