# 7.2 Tyre quantities (replace with this)

The maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is **28** for Rally1 cars and **26** for all other cars. In accordance with Art. 13.2.5 of the 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations the maximum number of tyres of the alternative choice for all 4WD cars is either 8 or 12.

The FIA must be notified at <a href="wrc-technical@fia.com">wrc-technical@fia.com</a> before the start of the Shakedown of the number of tyres of the alternative choice that the competitor wishes to use (P1 competitors must notify of their choice by Tuesday, 18 July, 18:00 hrs). Alternative compound tyres are not required to be used in the Shakedown.

This choice neither increases nor decreases the maximum number of tyres for the rally. If the competitor wishes to have 12 alternative compound tyres for use in the rally instead of 8, the number of tyres of the first choice will automatically be reduced by 4 tyres.

#### 12. OTHER PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

#### 12.1 Start order and intervals (add)

The start order during the rally will be as per Art 41.2 of the 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The competition element of the rally starts at TCO on Thursday 20 July at 19:46.

The start intervals for Special Stages, except for Power Stage as stipulated in Art. 50.3 of the 2023 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and SSS1/17 as stipulated in Art.12.6 of these Supplementary Regulations, will be as follows:

- 3 minutes for P1 drivers
- 2 minutes for P2 drivers
- 1 minute for all other drivers

### For sections 2 and 3 the start intervals will be as follows:

- 3 minutes for P1 drivers
- 2 minutes for all other drivers

The Clerk of the Course may, for safety reasons and with the knowledge of the Stewards, reposition drivers or change the time interval between cars.
