## 4 SERVICE PARK

### 4.1 Number and Location

- There will be one Service Park for the duration of the Rally.
- The Service Park is located in Service Area – Dead Sea.
- Service can be done only inside the Service Park.
- A detailed drawing of the Service Park and the designated areas is enclosed in Appendix 22.3
- GPS location: [31° 42.432'N – 35° 35.234'E](#)

### 4.2 Service Vehicle Registration

A service vehicle registration form is available on [www.jordanrally.com](http://www.jordanrally.com) and Sportity which should be completed and sent to the Organizer or submitted during documentation. There will be a dedicated area for auxiliary vehicles next to the team's Service Area.

### 4.3 Service Area

Each Team/Competitor will be allocated a designated space at the Service Park of 10x15 meters.

If a competitor wishes to have extra space in the Service Park, he/she must submit a formal request to the Organizer indicating the size required no later than **Thursday May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025**.

#### 4.4 Admission to Dead Sea Service Park

The Service Park will open on **Monday May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025**, @ 10:00hrs for all Competitors.

All costs of moving equipment either within or outside the Service Park to its final position will be borne by the relevant owner of the equipment.

The Service Park access time to service vehicles:

- Day 1: until 19:30hrs Friday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- Day 2: until 20:30hrs Saturday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

All parties are kindly asked to respect these opening/closing hours. Competitors are kindly asked to remind all their team staff to always carry their Service Passes, as the organizers will be checking passes and Service Vehicles plates randomly. During the Rally, only vehicles with affixed Service or Auxiliary plates will be granted access to the Service Park. Auxiliary Vehicles may only enter the Service Park to bring or collect personnel and/or equipment, except when they can be accommodated within the designated team area or locations shown by the organizer as Auxiliary parking area.

During the Rally, Service Vehicles are not allowed to move inside the Service Park.

#### 4.5 Facilities in the Dead Sea Service Park

The Organiser will be providing the following facilities in the Service Park:

- Power supply
- Toilet facilities
- First aid station with doctor
- Waste collection.
- Water supply

#### 4.6 Security

The Organiser has arranged a security company for the general security at the Service Park.

For special security requirements at your designated area, please contact the Organiser.

#### 4.7 Media Facilities

The official Media Centre is located in the Rally HQ, no satellite media centre in the Service Park.

#### 4.8 Environment Protection

All Competitors are kindly requested to preserve the environment and protect the Service Park ground by using a mat in their service area.

#### 4.9 Garbage Bins

Inside the service park, the organiser will place garbage bins. Competitors must ensure their service location is clean before, during and after the rally, the Clerk of the Course will award a penalty of €150 to the competitor who has registered the car.

## 5 TWO-WAY RADIOS

As per the country Regulations, Two Was radio communication is **NOT ALLOWED FOR PUBLIC**.

Two-way radio communications run through the Rally Control Centre located at the Rally HQ.

## 6 FUEL/TYRES

### 6.1 Fuel

6.1.1 In the Service Park it is forbidden to refuel.

6.1.2 Refuelling Areas: Competitors may only refuel in the Refuelling Areas or Remote Refuelling Areas designated by the Organisers in the Road Books as detailed under Articles 61 and 62 / V3 of the FIA 2025 RRSR.

### 6.2 Tyres

6.2.1 All tyres must comply with Article 13 and V3 of the FIA 2025 RRSR.

6.2.2 The use of studded tyres is prohibited.

6.2.3 Tyre Changing is permitted only in the Service Park.

6.2.4 A wheel/tyre marking zone will be established at the exit of the Service Park.

6.2.5 Tyre Marking/Checking Zones will be at each Technical Zone in accordance with the Rally Itinerary.

## 7 IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

All foreign Competitors must report at the customs when crossing borders. All vehicles must have a valid carnet and a detailed packing list of all spare parts and tools.

It is preferable if all details, including packing lists are sent to the Organiser as soon as possible. The information must include vehicles' details, date, and border point of entry. All information to be conveyed to [info@jordanbaja.com](mailto:info@jordanbaja.com) or faxed to the Organiser.

## 11 RECONNAISSANCE

### 11.1 Procedure for Registration

A reconnaissance record card will be supplied which must be carried in the car for the duration of the reconnaissance. This card will be signed appropriately recording every run on each Special Stage. Failure to produce this card will result in refusal to participate in the reconnaissance.

Competitors will be issued with three reconnaissance number plates that must be fixed to the front windscreen (top centre) and the right and left rear side windows and kept visible for the duration of the reconnaissance period.

These numbers and the record card will be available from Rally Office in Rally HQ in accordance with Article 3 above.

Kindly be reminded to bring Recce car insurance papers and to fill in the Recce car registration form.

It is recommended to appoint a representative for any matters during rally week, a written signed authorization should be submitted at this time.

### 11.2 Specific and/or National Restrictions – Speed limit on the Special Stages

11.2.1 Competitors are permitted a maximum of two passes over each Special Stage during Reconnaissance.

11.2.2 The maximum speed on special stages during Reconnaissance is 80 km/h.

11.2.3 The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment during reconnaissance is not permitted.

### 11.3 Collection of Speed Control Checking Devices

- Competitors will be required to install a tracking system in their vehicles during reconnaissance.
- These trackers must be collected from Rally Office in Rally HQ in accordance with Article 3 above.
- The trackers must be returned to Rally Office in accordance with Article 3 above.

## 12 SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

### 12.1 Venue and Timetable

#### 12.1.1 Venue

- The Scrutineering venue is at the Dead Sea Service Park.
- Layout Diagram is available in Appendix 22.3.

#### 12.1.2 Timetable

- Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- Cars Individual times will be announced in a Bulletin.
- A representative of the Team may present the car at Scrutineering.

### 12.2 Mud Flaps

- Fitting of transversal mud flaps is mandatory, they comply with Appendix J, Article 252.7.7.

### 12.3 Windows/Nets

- The use of silvered/tinted windows is permitted.

### 12.4 Driver's Safety Equipment

- At Scrutineering, competitors must produce all items of clothing including helmets and HANS intended to be used. Compliance with Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.
- In reference to Article 53.2.2 of the FIA 2025 RRSR: each competing car shall carry a red "SOS" sign and on the reverse a green "OK" sign measuring at least 42 cm x 29.7 cm (A3).
- After Scrutineering, if a car is found not to comply with technical and/or safety regulations, the Stewards may set a deadline before which the car must be made to comply or may refuse the start.

### 12.5 Noise Level in Special Stages

- At any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with Appendix J.

## 12.6 Special National Requirements

- Each competing car must be equipped with a first aid kit and one reflective triangle. Competitors are also reminded that in addition, two belt cutters must be carried on board at all times. They must be easily accessible to driver and co-driver when seated with their harnesses fastened (Appendix J, Art. 253.6.1.3).

## 12.7 Installation of Safety Tracking System

- All competitors must make provision in their cars for the installation of the tracking system and the emergency button. Installation instructions will be provided in Appendix IV of the Supplementary Regulations. The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked at Scrutineering.
- Immediately after Scrutineering the Safety Tracking device will be installed by a representative of the service provider (Anube Sport).
- A refundable deposit of €500, will be required from all competing cars. The deposit will be refunded upon returning the equipment.

## 12.8 Final Scrutineering

- Final Scrutineering will take place at the Scrutineering Venue – Service Park – Dead Sea. Cars will be escorted to the Scrutineering venue.

## 13 SHAKEDOWN, FREE PRACTICE & QUALIFYING

Not applicable in Jordan Rally.

## 14 START PROCEDURE

### 14.1 Ceremonial Start Procedures & Order

- The Ceremonial Start will take place in the ~~Dead Sea Service Park~~ **Royal Automobile Club of Jordan** in accordance with Article 3 above, it is mandatory to attend by all competitors.
- A Holding Area will be setup on-site; Competitors MUST enter the Holding Area in accordance with the program in Article 3 above.
- The Holding area will be secured. Access is limited to Crew members and Media representatives carrying the appropriate identification.
- No Timecards will be given; competitors will follow marshal's instructions.
- A representative of the team may deliver the car.
- Competitors reporting late to the Ceremonial start will be penalized with €30 per minute up to a maximum of 15 minutes. Thereafter, they will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties at their discretion.
- The Ceremonial start will be in descending car number order, starting from the last competitor to the first.
- Cars will start at one (1) minute interval.
- It is mandatory for all crew members to wear their racing overalls and shoes during the Ceremonial Start. Crews not complying with this will be reported to the Stewards.

### 14.2 Leg 1 – Start, Friday May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Procedure:

- Cars will start from "TC 0" Service OUT - Refuel.

### 14.3 Leg 2 – Start, Saturday May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025, Procedure:

- Cars will start from "TC 6D" Parc Fermé OUT – Service IN.

## 15 FINISH PROCEDURE

- The rally will finish at “TC 12C” Service OUT – Finish Holding IN; thereafter crews must follow the marshals’ instructions during the Podium & Prize Giving. From the Podium, Crews will immediately drive to the Final Parc Fermé.
- Between “TC 12C” and Final Parc Fermé, cars are under Parc Fermé conditions and will be observed by marshals.

## 18 USEFUL FACTS AND SERVICES

### 18.1 Climate

Jordan is located 80 kilometres east of the eastern coast of the Mediterranean Sea. It's located between 29°11'N and 33°22'N, and between 34°19'E and 39°18'E with an area of 89329 km<sup>2</sup>, more than 80% is classified as arid areas.

The Dead Sea's climate offers year-round sunny skies and dry air with low pollution. It has less than 50 mm mean annual rainfall and a summer average temperature between 32 and 39 °C. Winter average temperatures range between 20 and 23 °C.

The region has weakened ultraviolet radiation, particularly the UVB rays, and an atmosphere characterized by a high oxygen content due to the high barometric pressure.

The shore is the lowest dry place in the world. Proximity to the sea affects the temperature of a place because the sea temperature changes due to the penetration of the sun in the summer. During winter months, sea temperatures tend to be much higher than summer temperature and vice versa during summer months, this is the outcome of slow penetration from the sun into the sea as it is a huge mass and takes a long time to warm up. The region's climate and the unique conditions created by its low elevation have made it a popular centre for several types of therapies.






### 22.1 Scrutineering Venue Layout


