### Race Director's Communication 5 v3

#### **Clarification on the Qualifying Session Procedure**

Due to the organizational needs of the event, the qualifying sessions that will define the starting grids for the races will be run consecutively, with one stop in between.

The procedure will be as follows:

The first qualifying session, which will determine the starting grids for races 1 and 2 by using the first and second fastest lap times of each of the drivers, will start at 10:10 and will finish at 10:30.

There will be a 10-minute pit stop, which will start at 10:30 and will last until 10:40.

At 10:40 the second qualifying session will start, which will determine the starting grid for race 3 by using the best lap time of each of the drivers. It will last 20 minutes and will therefore last until 11:00.

The following points shall be taken into consideration:

The checkered flag will be displayed at the end of each of the qualifying sessions.

During the pit stop, the same regime as during qualifying will apply. Therefore, the following operations may be carried out on the vehicle:

- Any mechanical operation, if it is carried out in the slow/working lane of the Pit Lane (at 45°).
- Tyre changes are permitted. No other solid, liquid, or gaseous matter, or of any other nature whatsoever, may be placed on or removed from the vehicle (Except the blanking of the radiators). Data can be downloaded from cars.
- Vehicles may be stopped randomly for weighing during both sessions, according to Art. 26.1 of the Sporting Regulations.
- During the stop between both sessions, the use of blowers to generate an air stream to the side intakes will be permitted.
- Cars recovered with external mechanical assistance before the start of the second qualifying session will be allowed to take part in it.
- All cars will be in Parc Fermé Regime at the end of the second session.
