- 1. Gates will be open at 6.45am, Unloading inside gate of venue, and please follow marshals instructions from here,
- 2. Scrutiny will start at 7am in the venue. Competitors are asked to present their cars as early as possible at the Scrutiny tent and please queue in an orderly fashion to avoid congestion.
- 3. Once you have completed scrutiny, please proceed to rally office, where door numbers will be issued and signatures will be required from all competitors on their entry forms. One day licences will be arranged here also.
- 4. Drivers and navigators under 18 years of age must also have a signature of a parent or guardian on the entry form.
- 5. Reminder to all competitors to ensure they have OK/SOS board and warning triangle in the car, and if possible try have a tow rope also, to speed up the towing out of a car from the stage, should the need arise.



- 6. Reminder to all competitors to keep their car numbers clean, these numbers will be provided on the morning, and to all double drivers to change their numbers. The onus is on you (the competitor) to have the correct number displayed before starting your run.
- 7. Drivers briefing for Juniors and J1000 Competitors will be done at 9.15am at the start line, and only these competitor's will do a familiarisation run immediately after briefing. We ask that ye have your cars at the line at 9.00am and be ready to go when requested after the briefing; if you're not queued you may forfeit your familiarisation run.
- 8. Drivers briefing for main field will be at 9.30am in the paddock, at the scrutiny tent and the first timed run will be at 10.00am.
- 9. The running order will be J1000's, Juniors, Double Drivers, 2wd cars in class batches from Class 1 upwards, then 4wd cars will be last to run. Remember the entry list is just for numbers.
- 10. Please listen to the PA system and join the pre start queue when asked to do so.
- 11. Cars will start at 30sec Intervals.
- 12. If You have any queries on the day, please contact the CRO Grace O'Brien (087 2250453) who will endeavour to help resolve your issue. Grace will be around the paddock all day and you can send a query via WhatsApp also. Please do not approach any other event official.
