

## Refueling

- All on-site refueling whether during competition or not must be done in the designated refueling location. The location is purposely away from all other areas in order to contain any incident that may occur.
- There will be absolutely no smoking in this area either during refueling process or any other time, due to the possibility of residual fuel or oil in the area.
- A fire extinguisher must be present in the refueling area when the fueling process is taking place.
- It is HIGHLY recommended that another person man the fire extinguisher during the refuel process.

## Weather

- In case of lightning: take shelter in a nearby vehicle or one of the on-site buildings. DO NOT stand under the open grandstand seats.
- In case of hail or wind take shelter in any sturdy structure including vehicles
- In case of tornado take shelter in one of the sturdy track infield buildings or any designated tornado shelter. DO NOT shelter in your car.
- In case of wildfire take shelter in the infield of the track or off site at a location away from the fire.

## Off Track Incidents

- **Minor injuries:** There is first aid assistance onsite. Contact one of the event officials to request assistance.
- **Serious injuries:** Contact one of the event officials to request assistance through immediate first aid and contact of proper local emergency response.
- **Property damage:** Contact one of the event safety stewards to report the damage and fill out an incident report.
