2026 Sno*Drift Service Area Notes

The paved lots at the Atlanta High School are off-limits to Service Crews and their vehicles during Technical Inspection on Thursday and Prior to load-in on Friday afternoon.

As the Friday *Parc Exposé* is in Lewiston and the Service Area is in Atlanta, teams should either drive their car to Lewiston from their hotel or plan to find an out-of-the-way spot in Lewiston to unload. Service Crews traveling between Atlanta and Lewiston Friday between the hours of 2 pm to midnight must use CO 612 and CO 487 via the route given on Page 4.

The service area opens for load-in at 16:00 on Friday. Due to the school's activity schedule, the parking lots are not available for load-in prior to 16:00. If you arrive before 16:00 you will be turned away. Priority will be given to the larger rigs (trucks, motorhomes, and trailers greater than 24 feet) between 16:00 and 16:30. Smaller more agile service rigs should plan on 16:30 or later if possible. After 16:30 the opportunity to maneuver large rigs will be limited. Teams should complete their load-in activities at the Atlanta Service Area no later than 20:00.

Empty trailers may be parked across the street from the Atlanta Service Area.

Only vehicles with a Service Pass will be allowed in the Service Lot. Service Passes are to be picked up by the Crew Chief during check-in at the Senior Center.

Gas cans, fire extinguishers and other equipment in the refueling zone must have the car number on them and cannot be left out overnight.

Service vehicle access to the Service Area *may* be restricted while Time Controls are operating.

Registered Service Crew travel during competition is restricted to the times and locations shown on Page 5. Registered Service Crew members may exit the Service Area to spectate at a designated Spectator Area using a vehicle other than a registered service vehicle. Service crews going to a Spectator Area must use the routes provided on Page 20 and not deviate from that route.

Supplementary Regulations - Service

12 Service

- 12.1 Service will be at the Atlanta High School, 10500 Co Rd 489, Atlanta MI 49709
- 12.2 Standard service spots are 20' wide by at least 45' long. You must be able to place your vehicle(s), trailer(s) and service equipment all within the space(s) assigned to you. Teams desiring extra or oversize service spots or special adjacencies to other teams need to:
- a) Email the Chief of Service jdkloost@gmail.com by Thursday, January 29, 2026, and make their specific needs clear.
 - b) Ensure that any oversize or extra service spot payments have been received by the Event Registrar.
- 12.3 No alcohol use will be permitted in the service area. This includes everyone in the service area, no matter what their connection to the rally - all teams, crews, guests, spectators, and volunteers.
- 12.4 Only service specific registered to a team vehicles with a Service Access Pass and their trailers are allowed into the service area. All registered vehicles must always display registration cards with prominent car number on their dash. Vehicles without cards are not permitted into the service area for any reason. Parking will be available outside the service area.
- 12.5 Tarps/spill cloths must be placed under cars for all servicing operations. Service areas not cleaned will be subject to \$150 fine.
- 12.6 **Service crews must notify the Chief of Service when they leave the service area.**
- 12.7 Follow the direction of the Rally volunteer staff when parking your service vehicle at all service locations. Teams will have an assigned location based on running order and space requirements.

Required Service Crew Routes

Between Atlanta and Lewiston

1. From the blinker at M-32 and M-33 in Atlanta, go south on CO 487 and follow for 8.4 miles to CO 612.
2. Turn right onto CO 612 to go west and follow for 10 miles to the Parc Expose in Lewiston

Between Service Area (High School) and Lewiston

1. Turn left out of service onto CO 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to CO 487.
2. Turn right onto CO 487 to go south and follow for 7.65 miles to CO 612.
3. Turn right onto CO 612 to go west and follow for 10 miles to the Parc Expose in Lewiston

Service Crews must adhere to posted speed limits on this route.

Return to Atlanta/Service Area by reversing the route.



Friday	18:00	22:00	Crews may leave the Service Area to spectate at the Meaford – Mills Spectator Area using only the route provided on Page 20
Saturday	10:00	18:00**	Crews are allowed within a 2 mile radius of the M-32 / M-33 intersection in Atlanta. This includes the Service Area, Parc Expose, Finish and Impound.
Saturday	10:00	16:00	Crews may leave the Service Area to spectate at the Sage Creek – Von Dette Spectator Area using only the route provided on Page 20

Atlanta Area Map






Service Area Maps

2026 Sno*Drift Service to Spectator Area Routes

Prior to leaving the Service Area, you **MUST** check in with the Chief of Service to let him know that you are going to spectate. You **MUST** use a vehicle other than a registered service vehicle to go spectate.

Friday Spectator Area:

Special Stages 1 and 5 – Meaford Mills

Travel Time: 20 Minutes

If spectating at Stage 1, you MUST depart the spectator area no later than 19:40 and be back in the service area before the first car arrives.

1. Turn left out of service to go east on CO-489 for 0.31 miles to CO-487
2. Turn left onto CO-487 to go north and follow for 0.79 miles to the Blinker at M-32 & M-33
3. Go straight at the Blinker onto M-33 and follow for 2.06 miles to E. Kellyville Road.
4. Turn left onto E. Kellyville Road to go east and continue for 1.06 miles to Decheau Lake Road.
5. Turn right onto Decheau Lake Road to go north and continue for 1.44 miles to Meaford Road.
6. Turn left onto Meaford Road to go west and continue for 1.59 miles to Mills Road. This is the Spectator Area Location.
7. No designated Service Crew parking. Park per posted signs with other spectators.

Saturday Spectator Area:

Special Stages 9 and 13 – Sage Creek-Von Dette

Travel Time: 25 Minutes

If spectating at Stage 9, you MUST depart the spectator area no later than 12:30 and be back in the service area before the first car arrives.

1. Turn left out of service to go east on CO-489 for 0.31 miles to CO-487
2. Turn right onto CO-487 to go south and follow for 6.73 miles to Harwood Road.
3. Turn right onto Harwood Road to go west and follow for 1.36 miles to Sage Creek Road.
4. Turn right onto Sage Creek Road to go north and follow for 1.19 miles to Sage Lake Road. This is the Spectator Area Location.
5. No designated Service Crew parking. Park per posted signs with other spectators.

Recover Routes (From Service Area to Stage Starts and Finishes)

Before leaving Service to recover a retired entry you **MUST** inform the Chief of Service that you are leaving and where you are headed. The Chief will confirm your entry is retired (either temporarily or permanently) and indicate the correct route to your entry's location.

Be alert for oncoming spectating and rally traffic at all times.

Friday Stages:

Special Stages 1 and 5: Meaford Mills

Start of Stage: (Total Distance 7.25 miles; Approximately 15 minutes)

1. Turn right out of service onto Co 489 to go west for 1.75 miles to the tee at Baker Rd (CO 489 becomes Lake 15 at Culver).
2. Turn right onto Baker to go north and follow for 1.0 miles to the tee at M 32.
3. Turn left onto M 32 to go west and follow for 2.5 miles to Thorton Rd.
4. Turn right onto Thorton to go north and follow for 1.0 miles
5. Begin Slow Zone (25 mph) past houses and farm for 0.5 miles to the tee at Beechler Rd.
6. Turn left on Beechler to go west and follow to the stage start.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 8.4 miles; Approximately 15 minutes)

1. Turn left onto Co 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to the tee at CO 487.
2. Turn left onto CO 487 to go north and follow for 0.75 miles to the blinker at M 32.
3. Straight at the blinker on M 33 and follow for 5.2 miles to Rouse Rd.
4. Turn left onto Rouse to go west and follow for 2.1 miles to Mills Rd.
5. Turn left onto Mills to the stage finish.

Special Stages 2 and 6: 622 – East Branch

Start of Stage: (Total Distance 24.5 miles; Approximately 50 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto Co 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to the tee at CO 487.
2. Turn left onto CO 487 to go north and follow for 0.75 miles to the blinker at M 32.
3. Straight at the blinker on M 33 and follow for 5.2 miles to Rouse Rd.
4. Turn left onto Rouse to go west and follow for 5.35 miles to Stop sign at CO 622.
5. Turn right onto CO 622 to go north and follow for 2.1 miles to the stage start.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 23 miles; Approximately 50 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto Co 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to the tee at CO 487.
2. Turn left onto CO 487 to go north and follow for 0.75 miles to the blinker at M 32.
3. Straight at the blinker on M 33 and follow for 13.0 miles to pass the El Bo Inn on left.
4. Continue straight on M33 and follow for 3.0 miles to Canada Creek Hwy.
5. Turn left onto Canada Creek Hwy to go west and follow for 4.5 miles to East Branch Rd.
6. Turn left onto East Branch Rd to go southwest and follow for 0.3 miles.
7. Keep left to remain on East Branch Rd (Shan-Gra-La continues straight).
8. Follow East Branch Rd for 1.0 miles.
9. Turn left to continue to follow East Branch Rd for 5.0 miles to the stage finish.

Friday Stages Continued:

Recover Routes (From Service Area to Stage Starts and Finishes)

Special Stages 3 and 7: Black River – Camp 30

Start of Stage: (Total Distance 24 miles; Approximately 50 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto Co 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to the tee at CO 487.
2. Turn left onto CO 487 to go north and follow for 0.75 miles to the blinker at M 32.
3. Straight at the blinker on M 33 and follow for 13.0 miles to pass the El Bo Inn on left.
4. Continue straight on M33 and follow for 3.0 miles to Canada Creek Hwy.
5. Turn left onto Canada Creek Hwy to go west and follow for 4.5 miles to East Branch Rd.
6. Turn left onto East Branch Rd to go southwest and follow for 0.3 miles.
7. Keep left to remain on East Branch Rd (Shan-Gra-La continues straight).
8. Follow East Branch Rd for 1.0 miles.
9. Turn left to continue to follow East Branch Rd for 5.0 miles to Blue Lakes Club Rd.
10. Turn right onto Blue Lakes Club Rd for 0.9 miles to Black River Rd.
11. The stage start is left on Black River Rd.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 14.2 miles; Approximately 30 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto Co 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to the tee at CO 487.
2. Turn left onto CO 487 to go north and follow for 0.75 miles to the blinker at M 32.
3. Straight at the blinker on M 33 and follow for 5.1 miles to Rouse Road.
4. Turn left onto Rouse Road to go west and follow for 5.35 miles to Stop sign at CO 622.
5. Turn left onto CO 622 to go west and follow for 2.65 miles to Camp 30.
6. Turn right onto Camp 30 to go north and the stage finish.

Special Stages 4 and 8: Huff – Old State

Start of Stage: (Total Distance 24 miles; Approximately 40 minutes)

1. Turn right out of service onto Co 489 to go west on Co 489 for 1.75 miles to the tee at Baker Rd (CO 489 becomes Lake 15 at Culver).
2. Turn right onto Baker to go north and follow for 1.0 miles to the tee at M 32.
3. Turn left onto M 32 to go west and follow for 12.4 miles to Meridian Line Road.
4. Turn right onto Meridian Line Road to go north and follow for 8.6 miles to Huff Road.
5. Turn right onto Huff Road to go south to the stage start.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 6.4 miles; Approximately 15 minutes)

1. Turn right out of service onto Co 489 to go west for 1.75 miles to the tee at Baker Rd (CO 489 becomes Lake 15 at Culver).
2. Turn right onto Baker to go north and follow for 1.0 miles to the tee at M 32.
3. Turn left onto M 32 to go west and follow for 3.45 miles to Manier Road.
4. Turn right onto Manier Road to go north for 0.1 miles to Old State Road.
5. Turn left onto Old State Road to go west and follow for 1.1 miles to the stage finish.

Recover Routes (From Service Area to Stage Starts and Finishes)

Saturday Stages:

Special Stages 9 and 13: Sage Creek – Von Dette

Start of Stage: (Total Distance 6.1 miles; Approximately 10 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto CO 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to CO-487.
2. Turn right onto CO 487 to go south and follow for 4.8 miles to Avery Lake Road.
3. Turn right onto Avery Lake Road to go west and follow for 1.0 miles to Sage Creek Road.
4. Turn left to onto Sage Creek go south Road to the stage start.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 13.1 miles; Approximately 20 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto CO 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to CO 487.
2. Turn right onto CO 487 to go south and follow for 7.65 miles to CO 612.
3. Turn right onto CO 612 to go west and follow for 4.6 miles to Avery Lake Road.
4. Turn right onto Avery Lake Road to go north and follow for 0.35 miles to Quinnan Road.
5. Turn right onto Quinnan Road to go north for 0.2 miles to Von Dette Road and the stage finish.

Special Stages 10 and 14: Blue Lake – Fish Lab

Start of Stage: (Total Distance 10.25 miles; Approximately 15 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto CO 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to CO 487.
2. Turn right onto CO 487 to go south and follow for 7.65 miles to CO 612.
3. Turn left onto CO 612 to go east and follow for 0.4 miles to Hunt Creek Road.
4. Turn right onto Hunt Creek Road to go south for 0.05 miles to Blue Lake Road.
5. Turn left onto Blue Lake Road to go east for 1.85 miles to the stage start.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 12 miles; Approximately 20 minutes)

1. Turn left out of service onto CO 489 to go east for 0.31 miles to CO 487.
2. Turn right onto CO 487 to go south and follow for 7.65 miles to CO 612.
3. Turn right onto CO 612 to go west and follow for 3.95 miles to Fish Lab Road.
4. Turn left onto Fish Lab Road to go south and the stage finish.

2. Turn right onto Baker to go north and follow for 1.0 miles to the tee at M 32.
3. Turn left onto M 32 to go west and follow for 7.8 miles to CO 491.
4. Turn left onto CO 491 to go south for 2.85 miles to Agren Road.
5. Turn left onto Agren Road to go east for 1.0 miles to the stage start.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 5.5 miles; Approximately 12 minutes)

1. Turn right out of service onto CO 489 to go west for 0.25 miles to the intersection with Culver Road.
2. Turn left at the intersection to go south following CO 489 for 3.25 miles.
3. Turn left to go south (Fitz Road is straight ahead) following CO 489 for 1.0 miles.
4. Turn right to go west (Shoreline Road is straight ahead) following CO 489 for 1.0 miles to Hunters Road. The Stage finish is on your right.

Special Stages 12 and 16: Orchard – Shoreline

Start of Stage: (Total Distance 9.1 miles; Approximately 20 minutes)

1. Turn right out of service onto CO 489 to go west for 0.25 miles to the intersection with Culver Road.
2. Turn left at the intersection to go south following CO 489 for 3.25 miles.
3. Turn left to go south (Fitz Road is straight ahead) following CO 489 for 1.0 miles.
4. Turn right to go west (Shoreline Road is straight ahead) following CO 489 for 1.0 miles to Hunters Road.
5. Turn left to go south following CO 489 for 3.6 miles to Orchard Road.
6. Turn left onto Orchard Road to go east and the stage start.

Finish of Stage: (Total Distance 4.5 miles; Approximately 10 minutes)

1. Turn right out of service onto CO 489 to go west for 0.25 miles to the intersection with Culver Road.
2. Turn left at the intersection to go south following CO 489 for 3.25 miles.
3. Turn left to go south (Fitz Road is straight ahead) following CO 489 for 1.0 miles.
4. The stage finish is straight ahead on Shoreline Road.
