# ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

It is the intention of SAR MOTORISMO, in line with the guidelines issued by the environmental commissions of FIA, FIM, and FPAK, and working directly with the FPAK sustainability commission, to develop and implement a set of strategic environmental solutions with the

aim of reducing the event's ecological footprint.

By implementing the 3 R's rule, the first priority is to REDUCE the consumption of all resources as much as possible. Whenever that is not achievable, the goal will be to REUSE, and as a last resort, with everyone's commitment, to RECYCLE.

One of our initiatives, besides raising awareness among all event participants, will be to implement a waste management plan for the waste produced by teams, support crews, spectators, and other participants. This plan aims, among other things, to reduce paper consumption, promote environmental communication and training, prevent soil and water pollution, and manage solid waste through integrated



transport and management actions that ensure the principles of environmental sustainability.

It is about a sports event without parallel in this region, which makes it essential to celebrate a partnership with GESAMB, the entity responsible for waste management in our district, and the Municipality of Reguengos de Monsaraz.

These entities will provide all recycling furniture to be implemented at the event, as well as being responsible for the collection and recycling of all waste produced after its conclusion. Therefore, these are two extremely important partners in this event.

The Municipality of Reguengos de Monsaraz, an excellent partner, allows this Baja to be unique in Portugal by having a service park that is completely self-sufficient in terms of energy production. It was one of the major initiatives of the Municipality, taking advantage of the strong Alentejo sun by installing solar panels that provide shade, thereby offering some thermal comfort on hot days in this fairground park while also producing green energy.

This was a sustainable investment made in most of the municipality's infrastructure.









### **Specific Recommendations:**

To mitigate greenhouse gas emissions from competition vehicles, assistance, organization, and the general public, it is strongly recommended to:

- Use the engine only when necessary;
- Minimize noise pollution;
- Do not park outside designated areas;
- At the end of the event, collect all the waste you produced, place it in appropriate bags, and dispose of it at the respective recycling points or the first municipal waste container you find.

Photometric tests will be conducted during technical inspections to verify that all vehicles comply with FIM technical regulations. The exhausts will be marked, and at any time, the technicians may repeat the same tests to ensure that noise pollution is minimized throughout the event. This aims to protect the environment as much as possible in the cities, towns, streets, and areas affected by the event.

## Climate

At Reguengos de Monsaraz, summer is short, warm, arid and almost cloudless sky; winter is cool and partly cloudy sky. Throughout the year, the temperature generally ranges from 5°C to 33°C and is rarely below 1°C or above 38°C.

Based on <u>the beach/pool index</u>, the best time of year to visit Reguengos de Monsaraz and enjoy warm weather activities is from the end of June to the beginning of September.

The hot season lasts for 2.9 months from June 16 to September 12, with maximum average daily temperature above 29 °C. The hottest month of the year in Reguengos de Monsaraz is August, with a maximum of 32 °C and minimum of 17 °C on average.

The cool season lasts for 3.7 months, from November 16 to March 6, with maximum daily temperature on average below 17 °C. The coldest month of the year in Reguengos de Monsaraz is January, with a maximum of 5 °C and minimum of 14 °C on average.

## Reguengos de Monsaraz





At Évora's disctric, the Municipality of Reguengos de Monsaraz stands out, by framing of the magnificent Alentejo plain and the blue water of the Alqueva reservoir making it a reference tourist destination of the region.

Confined by the municipalities of Redondo and Alandroal to the north, Mourão to the east, Moura and Portel to the south and Évora to the west, the municipality of Reguengos de Monsaraz it is located in a predominantly agricultural region, which conditions the ways of life linked to the exploitation of land – essentially extensive agriculture of cereals, olive growing and vines.

The climate, typically Mediterranean with hot and dry summers and short and rainy winters, marks the vegetation, fauna, landscape, as well as the people of this region.

Reguengos de Monsaraz offers exceptional environmental conditions, and invites for the enjoyment of outdoor activities in contact with nature, such as boat trips, walking or horseback riding through dirt paths, hunting, fishing... Here you can also enjoy a trip back in time by wandering through the historic medieval village of Monsaraz and visiting the various archaeological testimonies of megalithic monuments throughout the area. Located particularly in the parish of Monsaraz, some of them are worthy of prominence at European level.

In addition to a very rich historical heritage and an excellent landscape, the municipality has a strong identity marked by traditional uses and customs, which are reflected in gastronomy, wines and handicrafts, highlighting S. Pedro do Corval, the largest pottery centre in Portugal.













## Mourão

The municipality of Mourão is located in the district of Évora, in the Alentejo region and is divided into 3 parishes, Granja, Luz and Mourão.

Embraced by the Alqueva reservoir, this municipality has landscapes that provide a unique identity.

An example of this uniqueness, provided by the Alqueva is the so-called Lousa Castle, or Roman Castle of the Blackboard. Classified as a National Monument, the area where it was located, the old Village of Light, was submerged by the lake.

With the efforts of the Alqueva Development and Infrastructure Company and the Portuguese Institute of Archaeology, actions were developed to preserve this monument. Although the fortification is fully submerged, it is wrapped with sandbags covered by a cement paste, to avoid the wear caused by the waters.

The natural or inhabitant of Mourão is called Mouranense. The municipality is bordered to the north by the municipality of Alandroal, to the northeast and east by Spain, to the west by Reguengos de Monsaraz and to the south by Moura and Barrancos in the district of Beja. It has a climate of markedly Mediterranean influence, characterized by a very marked dry season in summer. Rainfall is around 500 mm between October and March and 170 mm in the driest semester, being quite irregular. Its morphology is marked by a relatively flat and smooth relief, but higher than average elevations, 150 m: Head (276 m), Cantarinho (253 m), Cerro (188 m) and Atalaia das Ferrarias (190 m). As water resources, to mention the Guadiana River and the Alcarrache river.

There are many popular and cultural manifestations in the county, most nodding to the feast of Senhora das Candeias, held on February 2nd; the pilgrimage of St. Peter on Easter Monday; the feast of S. Brás, in August, and the feast of Light, on the first weekend of September.

The agriculture, has a great importance in the economy of the municipality. We highlight the cultivation of cereals for grain, temporary grassland and forage crops, industrial crops, pousio, olive groves, grassland and permanent pastures. Livestock farming is also of some importance, namely goats, sheep and cattle. About 14.4% (200 ha) of its territory are covered with forest, the main tree species being olive tree, holm oak and cork oak..
