Amendments to the Supplementary Regulations of the Rally

8. FUEL (replace)

All Priority drivers must use FIA fuel as provided by the FIA appointed supplier.

See also Articles 61 and 62 of the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The supplier appointed by the FIA is TotalEnergies. Supply, refuelling services and fuel orders will be handled by Sodifuel.

For environmental and safety reasons, all competitors must refuel in the designated refuel zones. Refueling is not allowed in the Service Park (no refuel from cans, drums or similar except as detailed in Article 58 of the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations).

8.1 Ordering procedure and price per litre (replace)

The fuel order form, available in Sportity, must be sent by email to wrc@sodifuel.com by **Thursday 27 March 2025**.

The cost of the FIA fuel is € 8,75 + VAT per litre. Only credit card payment or pre-payment by bank transfer is accepted. A copy of the transfer must be sent to Sodifuel before the deadline of the orders.

8.2 Closing date for ordering FIA fuel (no change)

Fuel orders must be placed no later than on **Thursday 27 March 2025**.

8.3 Distribution for non-priority drivers (no change)

Non-priority drivers may use either FIA fuel following the same conditions and rules as the Priority drivers or at commercial filling stations marked in the Road Book.

8.4 Refueling procedure (no change)

Crews are required to remain outside their cars during the refueling. A member of the crew will open the vehicle to allow an operative to attach the pipework. The crew will be responsible to indicate to the refueller the amount of fuel required. The crew only shall close the vehicle and secure the opening once the requested amount of fuel has been added. The use of mobile phones and radio communications is forbidden at the Refuel Zone.
