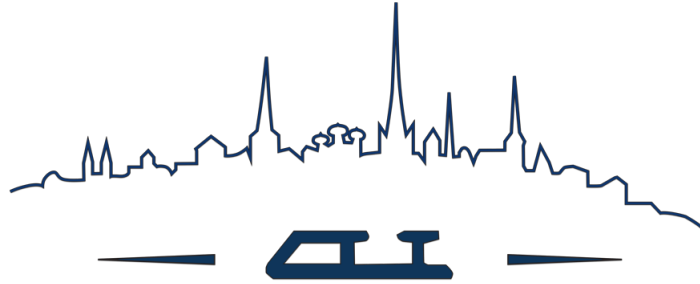

1 General Regulations

The **Tallinn Trophy Kids 2025** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024 the Special Regulations Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 , and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Tallinn Trophy Kids 2025** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and its membering Clubs, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation or its Membering Clubs.

3 Entries

3.1 General

All Entries to the **Tallinn Trophy Kids 2025** must be done through the **Sportity Online Registration System: <https://fs.sportity.com>**. The deadline for entries is Friday, **April 18th, 2025**.

3.2 Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

3.3 Entries of Competitors

The OC reserves the right to limit number of entries into one category per ISU Member of it's membering club, depending on the overall entries numbers. Special quotas might apply to the members of OC organizations. If OC have to limit the number of entries, priority or special quotas will be given to those Members that have entered a Judge.

Notice: All Members who are entering competitors first time to the **Sportity Online Registration System**, must contact **Sportity Ltd.** by email **info@sportity.com** with the Members' (Clubs) Country, Organisation Legal Name, National Registry code, contact e-mail address. Please ensure you have enough time to create initial account. The process might take up to 24 hours.

3.4 Entries of Judges

Each participating Member has the right to nominate one judge, who has at least the qualification "Judge for International Competitions".

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw. The Entries of Judges must be made via the e-mail to the OC (**info@tallinntrophy.eu**) not later than **April 18th, 2025 23:59h (local time Tallinn)**.

3.5 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

50€ per single skater in Artistic category	85€ per single skater with one(1) program
95€ per single skater with two(2) programs	100€ per Solo Dance skater
130€ per Ice Dance couple	

The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason.



Notice: All Entry Fee payments received **after 23:59 local time, April 18th, 2025** are subject to **late entry fee of 10€** per single skater/couple. The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation or Club is substituting a skater, whose entry fee was paid by the deadline by another skater. The OC reserves right to cancel Entry of skaters whose entry fee has not been paid by the published deadline.

With the entry or received payment after **after 23:59 local time, April 18th, 2025** the entry fee is:

60€ per single skater in Artistic category	95€ per single skater with one(1) program
105€ per single skater with two(2) programs	
110€ per Solo Dance skater	140€ per Ice Dance couple

4 Appointed Event Officials

This Tallinn Trophy Kids 2025 event will follow the principles of Estonian Skating Union for appointing the event officials. The members of each individual Technical Panel, Referee and Judges will have at least the qualification “sub-National”.

5 Music and Planned Program Content

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor’s music to the Organizing Committee must be submitted to the **Sportity Online Registration System: <https://fs.sportity.com>** together with the music title, author and composer. In accordance with the ISU rules each skater and/or his representative is responsible for the music rights (with permission of live show, online broadcast and/or commercial/promotions use internationally) to the program music.

6 Accreditation

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the Tondiraba Ice Hall upon arrival.

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per participating team, one Coach per Competitor, a maximum of one Team Officials of ISU Members (including the Member President), provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation and a maximum of two medical persons. Accreditation will only be granted to persons in those various functions if officially entered and named through their ISU Member. The ISU Member certifies with the signed entry form the indicated functions within the team of all team members.

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials.

7 Results

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used. Intermediate and final results will be published on competition website and in Sportity App event channel.



Info: There will be no hard-copy distribution of any printed media on this event. All required information will be available on the Information Board at the Ice Rink and on Digital Info Board (Sportity App)

8 Insurance and Liabilities

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The OC assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

9 Accomodation

There is no Official Hotel at this event. Teams are requested to organise their accomodation by themselves. The OC will organise accomodation to Invited Event Officials only.

10 Arrival of Teams

The nearest airport is **MTallinn Lennar Meri Airport (TLL)** with a distance of **6.5 km** to the venue.

The OC will not be providing transportation from the airport for competitors, coaches, Team Leaders and Team Staff.

All Referees, the Technical Panel (Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data Replay Operators) Judges are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but no later than **Monday, April 21, 2025** the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival or any other information concerning transportation and arrivals.
