1.1 Preamble

Qatar International Baja will be run in compliance with the following FIM Codes and Regulations:

and the National Sporting Regulations which comply with the FIM regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

The National Road Traffic Regulations shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to the Rules and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins. These bulletins will be issued by the Organiser with the approval of the FIM up until the commencement of administrative checks, and with the approval of the Jury once the administrative checks have started. Exceptionally, modifications to the itinerary may be made by the Organiser. Additional information will be published in the Rally Guide.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Closing date for entries

4.2 Entry procedure

Entries must be submitted as specified in article 82.4 and 82.6 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations.

Anyone wishing to take part in the Baja must send the entry form, duly completed, to the secretariat of the event accompanied by at least:

- Photocopies of the competition licences
- A valid Starting Permission from the competitor national federation to participate specifically in this event. If the competitor has a "one event" licence, a Starting Permission is not required.
- Photocopies of the driving licences corresponding to the type and capacity of the machine used.

An entry application will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fees. The entry fee must be credited in full to the organiser's bank account:

4.3 Categories and classes

- Category 2: Quads (three-wheel vehicles are forbidden)
- Class 1: Women
- Class 2: Junior
- Class 3: Veterans

- Competitors are required to pay a deposit of 1500 QR which will be refunded at the end of the event upon return of Stella and Sporttrax equipment in good conditions

4.5 Payment details

Any entry not accompanied by the entry fee shall be null and void. The entry fee shall be paid by cheque attached to the entry form or by bank transfer to the account indicated in SR Art. 4.2 (in the latter case, adequate proof of payment must be attached to the entry form).

4.6 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- if the event does not take place
- to teams whose entry application is rejected

The Organisers may refund 50% of the entry fees to those entrants who, for reasons of force majeure (duly certified as such by their ASN), were unable to start the Baja.





5. INSURANCE

As per article 82.5 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations and Art 110.1 of the FIM Sporting Code.

- **5.1** Competitors are reminded that only damage caused to third parties by the FIM, Baja officials and/or entered competitors is covered by the insurance policy taken by the Organization. Injury to the drivers themselves or damage to participating vehicles is not covered by this insurance.
- **5.2** The coverage limit per any one occurrence is **tba** QR. Insurance Company: Qatar General Insurance Policy No: **tba**
- **5.3** The service vehicles, even those bearing special plates issued by the organizers, may never be considered as official participants in the Baja. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the Baja and remain the sole responsibility of their owner.
- **5.4** Competitors with a valid FIM Licence are covered for Emergency Medical treatment as per the FIM Riders' insurance information enclosed. See SR Appendix 9
 - Riders' are free to take on at their own convenience any individual insurance policy that they deem fit, independently from the above-mentioned liability insurance, in addition to the insurance coverage provided by the FIM Licence.
- **5.5** By submitting their entries, the competitors and vehicle owners waive any claims or rights to pursue action for damages in connection with the event against the organizer.

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

As per articles 82.7.5 and 82.7.6 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations.

6.1 Organiser's advertising / Optional organiser's advertising

6.2 Advertising restrictions

No political, religious or abusive advertising is permitted. The advertising of tobacco (or related products), alcohol and/or pornography is forbidden on vehicles, competition/service equipment and on the team members' outfits.

6.3 Identification numbers, Baja plates and all organizer's advertising must be fitted to the vehicle for scrutineering and must be visible for the duration of the Baja.

7. TYRES

As per articles 82.7.4 of 2023 FIM Bajas World Cup Regulations.

8. FUEL - REFUELING

As per article 82.9 and 82.16.4 of 2023 FIM Bajas World Cup Regulations.

All vehicles must have sufficient fuel range at least to cover 125 km between official refuelling points. An extra safety margin of 10% is recommended.







The organiser will provide an environmental mat and fire suppression system at all refuelling zones. Fuel must be transported by the teams to the refuelling zones, including the remote zone. The route to be followed from the Service Park to this remote refuelling zone is available in the Rally Guide.

Restrictions

- At the refuelling zone close to the service park area, only actions directly involved in the refuelling of the competing vehicle are permitted.
- At the remaining refuelling zones, all external assistance on a machine is forbidden on pain of penalties at the discretion of the Jury. Only competitors still in the competition are allowed to help other competitors.

10. PRELIMINARY TECHNICAL CONTROL, SEALING AND MARKING

As per article 82.8.2 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations.

10.1 **Preliminary Technical Control venue and timetable**

The exact schedule will be published by means of a bulletin.

Bike may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team.

Time control 10.2

Any delay on the presentation at the time control installed immediately before scrutineering will result in the following penalties:

from 1 to 15 minutes	QR 200
from 16 to 30 minutes	QR 400
> 30 minutes	will be reported to the Jury

10.3 Installation of Tracking System and NAV-GPS

All competitors must make provision in their competition vehicles for the installation of the Tracking System and NAV-GPS.

10.3.1 Safety Tracking System (article 82.2.16 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations)

The system to be used on 2023 Qatar International Baja will be the SPORTTRAXX

Tracking devices shall be collected during the Administrative Checks. Sporttraxx will collect the devices from the cars at the finish Parc Fermé. The installation will be checked at scrutineering.

10.3.2 Navigation System (article 82.2.17 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations)

Competitors are obliged to be equipped with one Navigation System (NAV-GPS) downloaded with the waypoints given by the Organiser.

Crews on 2023 Qatar International Baja will be equipped by the organisation with ANUBE'S STELLA system that integrates the «vehicle-to-vehicle communication system» into the GPS. NAV/GPS devices shall be collected during the Administrative Checks. Anube will collect the devices from the cars at the finish Parc Fermé.

The information relevant to the installation of the system on the vehicle is available on the rally website and from ANUBE.

The Competitor must contact directly ANUBE to order the support/power supply kits for this equipment.

All competitors on the rally must have this system to pass scrutineering.







- 10.4 When checking in at the time control installed immediately before scrutineering, competitors must comply with the following:
 - All Baja plates, competition numbers and advertising plates must be already fitted.
 - Produce safety helmets, protective gear and backpack for approval.
 - Produce GPS and the «vehicle to vehicle alarm system» in working order, permanently fitted to the vehicle.

10.5 **On-Board Camera**

Cameras or any additional devices, including the holders, on the competitors including the helmets are forbidden.

First offense: warning

• Second offense: 5 min penalty

Also refer to article 80.7.7 of 2023 FIM World Rally-Raid Championship.

11. OTHER PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

11.1 Driver's briefing

The General Briefing will be hosted electronically on the Sportity App (See Appendix 8) on Wednesday, 15 March at 19:00h.

11.2 Pre-start areas

The Organiser will assemble the competing vehicles in a starting area, into which each vehicle must be driven - by one of the drivers or a team representative - no later than 30 minutes before its due start time:

- On Thursday, 15 February, before TC0 (start of Stage 1 / Section 1)
- On Friday, 16 February, before TC1B (start of Stage 1 / Section 2)

The penalty for late arrival at the starting area will be QR 100 per each 5 minute or fraction of lateness.

No service is allowed in the start area.

11.3 Ceremonial Start Procedure and Order

The Ceremonial Start will take place according to the program (SR Art. 3).

Vehicles must be ridden by the rider or a team representative to the pre-start holding area, where they will enter between 18.00h and 18.30h. The penalty for late arrival at the holding area will be QR 100 per each 5 minute or fraction of lateness.

The holding area will be under vigilance. Access to the holding area is limited to team members and media representatives with appropriate identification. No service is allowed inside the holding area.

11.4 Start procedure and starting order

As per art. 82.14.1 and 82.15 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations.

Electronic start procedure

See SR Appendix 6.









11.5 Prologue

As per article 82.13 of 2023 FIM BAJAS World Cup Regulations.

The mandatory itinerary of the Prologue is defined in the Road book by the road direction diagrams and between the road direction diagrams, by the road/track if it exists.

To assist competitors and clear define the limits of the track, the route of the prologue will be marked with a number of QMMF flags - maroon colour on the right side and white colour on the left side of the route – each one associated to a metallic fence.

The dimensions of the fence and the flag as well as the aspect of the set are shown in Appendix 7. Any touch on a metallic fence and/or the associated flag as well as a deviation from the route limits defined by the flags will be penalised as follows:

• 1st offence: 5 seconds 2nd offence: 10 seconds

• 3rd offence: 30 seconds

• Beyond 3 offences: penalty at the discretion of the Jury.

The sets flag/metallic fence will be already in place during reconnaissance.

Each diagram of the road book will correspond to a WPP (Precise Waypoint) with an opening radius of 100 meters and validation radius of 20 meters.

The penalty for each missing waypoint is 2 minutes organization vehicle driven by an organization marshal.

During administrative checks, each crew will be given the possibility of choosing a slot of their convenience inside the period mentioned in Art. 3 – Programme.

Any service on a Bike / Quad once it has started the Prologue is prohibited. All vehicles which participate in the Prologue must immediately and directly be brought to the parc fermé designated by the organiser and remain there until released by the Jury.

11.6 Finish procedures

The Baja will conclude at TC3A. From this point, all vehicles are subject to Parc Fermé rules until the Parc Fermé is opened at the instructions of the Jury.

Post-event scrutineering will take place as soon as possible after the arrival of the vehicles at TC3A.

The finish ceremony and prize giving will take place according to the program.

The attendance at the finish ceremony and prize giving is compulsory for all classified competitors and all participants must wear their approved clothes.

In the event a vehicle is not drivable for the above procedure, this must be reported to the clerk of the course and the rider concerned must still attend the podium finish ceremony wearing their approved overalls and boots.

11.7 Permitted early check-in

Competitors are authorised to check-in ahead of time without incurring a penalty at the following time controls:

TC1A / TC2A / TC2B / TC2C / TC 3A

11.8 Official time used during the event

Official time throughout the entire Baja will be GPS time (Local time is UTC+3).









11.9 Road book delivery

Section 1

• At the start of the Baja (TCO)

Section 2

- For the first road section: at the start of the section (TC1B)
- For SS2: at TC2, 15' before the start of the selective section

Section 3

- For the first road section: at the start of the section (TC2D)
- For SS3, 15' before the start of the selective section

11.10 Servicing of vehicles

Service is permitted only at the service park.

Location of the Service Park

Lusail Circuit Sports Club / Karting Academy (25° 29.536'N 51° 27.587'E).

Access of service vehicles to the service park

See SR Art. 3.

Timed service areas (maximum time)

After SS2 (TC2A > TB2): 02.00h

The movement of service/assistance vehicles is strictly controlled and is forbidden along the route of any selective section. For any infringement of this rule a penalty of up to and including disqualification from the event may be imposed by the Jury on the rider for whom the transgressors are servicing.

The competing vehicle may be ridden outside the service park for technical testing by the rider or a team member, in which case tracking NAV/GPS system must be switched on.

The competing vehicle may be driven by an authorised representative of the Team:

- from Service Park to a Pre-Start Area (SR Art. 11.2),
- from Service Park to the Ceremonial Start Holding Area (SR Art. 11.3),
- from the Ceremonial Start location (after the conclusion of the function) to Service Park,
- from Service Park to TC2B and/or TC2C respecting all formalities of Timecard presentation and related penalties

Service teams and accompanying persons

Each competitor is reminded that he/she is jointly and severally responsible for his or her service teams and accompanying persons.

Any infringements of the regulations as well as the use of unauthorized equipment – whether or not this has a direct or indirect influence on the results or sporting running of the event – will be judged by the Jury who will be entitled to decide as far as the disqualification from the event of the competitor(s) involved, directly or indirectly.

11.11 Any special procedure / Organiser's promotional activities

- 15 March (Wednesday) 18:00 Pre-Baja Press Conference
- 18 March (Saturday) 18:30 Post-Baja Press Conference

The exact location of the functions and the list of competitors required to participate will be announced by means of a CoC Communication.







11.11.1 Availability of participants

Teams and riders who parked their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, must remain available by phone (mobile) until the Final Classification have been posted.

11.11.2 Classification

The Final Classification will not be distributed after the event. The final classification will be published on the website on the Digital Notice Board (SPORTITY – Password FIMQIB23

For each crew, the maximum time at the finish of a selective section or at the finish of a part of a selective section is obtained by adding the respective start time for the selective section and the time mentioned on the right column above, both in **hours:minutes** format.

11.13 Section Penalties

Only rider who having received a total number of Section Penalties not exceeding 50% of the total number of sections of the competition can be classified.

To be classified, a rider who is imposed a Section Penalty on the final Leg of the competition must arrive with the vehicle at the final parc fermé one hour before the posting time of the Provisional Classification.

For any competitor who has completed a selective section as required by the regulations (i.e. within the maximum time, with less than 40% of missed waypoints, etc...) the sum of its total time and the penalties for missed waypoints will be limited to the maximum time for the selective section concerned in addition to 50% of this maximum time.

11.14 Safety equipment

Inflatable jacket and other protections

For the entire course, the wearing of a waistcoat or airbag jacket, back and chest protection is compulsory, under pain of disqualification. The airbag system must comply with FIM standards. The list of airbags is available here:

The neck-brace is not compatible with the airbag use and is therefore prohibited.

SPORTTRAXX GPRS TRACKER

For Bikes/Quads

The tracker will be delivered at the start of race and must be worn using the adjustable armband. In case of accident, its position on the arm is the easiest and fastest to be reached, even in case of serious injuries.

For Cars/SSV

The tracker will be inserted at the start of the race in a small bag or a velcro strip that will be setup in the vehicle at technical scrutineering by Sporttraxx technicians. For some SSVs the tracker might be worn on the arms using the armband.

Use in case of accident

Press and hold the SOS button till a vibration can be felt. 5 following vibrations confirm the reception of the medical rescue request, at the race control. Missing these vibrations, please repeat the pressure on the SOS button.



Stella equipment can also be used for tracking the competition vehicles and as SOS device.

Both devices together increase the level of safety and increase the range of use, especially on the bikes, where they have one device on the rider and one on the bike.

















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FIM Riders' insurance information

The rider's insurance policy set up by the FIM is a service for all the Federations that are part of the programme

for the period from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2024.

Who is covered:

- Riders with a FIM licence issued by a Federation which is part of the FIM riders' insurance programme.
- Riders with a FIM licence issued by ACCR, DMSB, FMS, KNMV, NMF and SMF are not part of the FIM riders' insurance programme and must follow the guidelines of their respective Federation.
- Riders competing in MotoGP, Moto2, Moto3 and MotoE are not part of the FIM riders' insurance programme and must follow the guidelines of their respective Federation.
- Riders competing in a Cross Country Rally must follow the guideline of the Rally organiser.

Validity of the insurance:

- For all events on the FIM Calendar with an International Manifestation Number (IMN).
- · For racing activities included in the official programme of the event only!
- Travel to and from the event venue.

Scope of coverage:

In case of racing incident, the FIM riders' insurance programme would cover:

- Emergency Medical treatment on the event's place (subsidiary and complementary to any other insurances the rider may hold)
- Repatriation to the rider's country of residence (as declared on the FIM Licence extranet by the rider's FMN)
- Death and Disability (Riders with a FIM licence issued by FFM and FMI have not subscribed this benefit from the FIM riders' insurance programme and must follow the guidelines of their respective Federation for this benefit)

Please note that this is an EMERGENCY insurance and in order to avoid any problems please follow the correct procedure.

What to do?

Before departure:

- Always check beforehand whether your personal health insurance card is still valid.
- For European citizens, please travel with your European Health insurance card.

In case of an Emergency Incident /Urgent medical assistance need:

- Make sure your Federation indicates the correct country of residence in your details and your correct emergency and authorized contact persons. Any repatriation will be to the address/country provided by your Federation on the FIM Extranet site.
- The FIM riders' insurance programme is only valid at FIM-approved events with a valid Number (IMN). If you are attending private test and/or non-event practice days, YOU WILL NOT BE COVERED by the FIM insurance.
- Always follow the instructions or you may no longer be covered by the FIM riders' insurance programme!
- Please ensure you agree upon any medical care or medical arrangements with the FIM insurer before taking any action whatsoever!



- Do not delay in contacting the emergency helpline. Make the call as soon as you can to advise of your accident!
- Do not change or leave the hospital, before contacting the emergency claims line, or the FIM insurance services may not be provided.
- Do not leave the country in which the incident occurred, before contacting the emergency claims line, or the FIM Insurance services may not be provided.
