- Tyres used for FP (free practice) are free and not included in the overall quantity, but must be Pirelli.

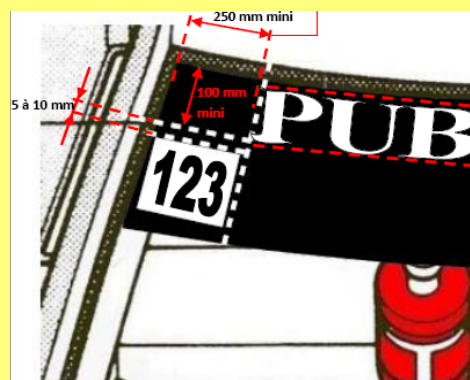
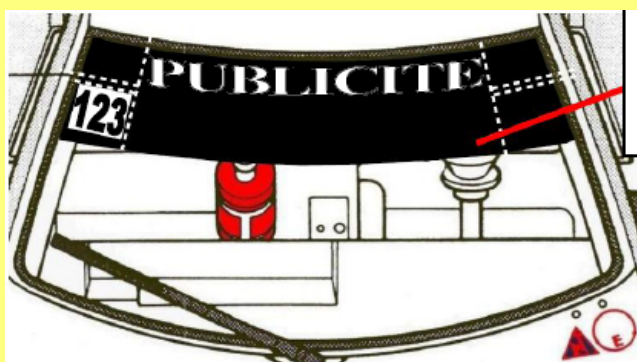
Appendix 4 – Decals and supplementary advertising

REAR REGISTRATION PLATE

• ~~FIA Motorsport Games Team Plate as supplied~~

Due the French traffic law, it is forbidden to drive a rally car on the road with registration plates. For this reason, every crew will receive 2 additional numbers 210mm X 140mm white background, black numbers.

The front number MUST be stick on the top right of the front windscreen (see the below description) and the back on the center of the rear registration plate position.



RESERVED AREAS FOR PROMOTER SPONSORS

- Windshield Banner reserved for the promoter
- As per all Motorsport Games disciplines, the tyres supplier PIRELLI logo must be stick on all 4 corners of the car, front and rear bumper corners. Stickers will be provided on site by Pirelli.

HELMETS ONROAD SECTION

Due the French traffic law, driving on road section with a racing helmet is strictly forbidden.

You will find these 2 logos on Road Book, do not wear your racing helmet before the green position and you should remove it at the red one after stop point.


