1. Introduction

1.1. The **Southern Ohio Forest Rally** (SOFR) is the 4th event in the 2026 ARA National Championship. The event also includes the **SOFR Super Regional Rally**.

1.2 **Southern Ohio Forest Rally** will be run in accordance with the current ARA General Competition Rules, Rally Competition Rules, Rally Technical Rules, and bulletins, as supplemented by these regulations. The current ARA rules and Series Bulletins can be found at <https://www.americanrallyassociation.org/rulesandbulletins>

Modifications, amendments and/or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated Bulletins. All bulletins become an integral part of these regulations. Bulletins will be posted on the Sportity App at SOFR2026

1.3 Stages are smooth gravel with some paved sections. SS #1 and #2 the only fully paved stages.

1.4 The Regional route will be approximately 225 miles in length with approximately 118 miles of stages.

The National route will include the power stage (SS #20) and will be approximately 245 miles in length with approximately 123 miles of stages.

1.5 The **Southern Ohio Forest Rally** starts in the city of Chillicothe with a stage through Yoctangee Park on Thursday evening. Friday the rally moves to the Shawnee State Forest, and Saturday the Zaleski State Forest.

4. Entries

4.1 Entry and payment must be paid via credit card online at www.enterrally.com. ARA will send an email to ARA license holders announcing the opening of online entries. You may contact ARA@ara-rally.com for issues with the online entry system.

All rally participants including competitors, crew members, media, and event officials must have an ARA License obtained from www.rallylicense.com

4.2 A 75 car limit will be employed with 5 entries reserved for the current top 5 overall drivers in the 2026 National Championship until the end of REGULAR entries. If more than 75 entries are received a wait list will be used based on order of full payment.

The Subaru Early Entry Discount is available to the first 5 paid Subaru teams in the National and the first 10 paid Subaru entries in the Regional rally. Teams receive the National credit \$500 when they pay their entry fee by using the coupon code National26SOFR, and the regional credit \$300 using the code Regional26SOFR

4.4 Entry fees include recce participation, one route book, use of a single service spot and RallySafe tracking and timing.

4.5. Competitors may revise or withdraw their entry prior to the closing date by completing an entry update/withdrawal form available in the Registrar Folder on the Sportity App. Once entries close, withdrawals and entry revisions are carried out by filing an inquiry.

4.6 Withdrawn entries will be refunded in accordance with ARA GCR 4.9.

- Prior to 23:59 on 5/15/2026 – full refund
- After 23:59 on 5/15/2026 and until 19:00 on 6/5/2026 – full refund less \$500.
- After 19:00 on 6/5/2026 – no refund.
- If the event is cancelled a full refund will be issued.

5. Insurance

5.1 Third party liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage, effective during the competition, will be provided by a policy secured by USAC.

5.2 Competitors, service crew members and all event participants including officials, marshals, staff, stewards and all other volunteers who have obtained an ARA license, signed an ARA waiver and have been issued and are in possession of an event wristband confirming the signature of the waiver will be covered by a secondary USAC participant accident insurance policy which covers excess medical expenses to their primary medical insurance provider.

6. Advertising and Identification

6.1 ***Southern Ohio Forest Rally*** will use the event sponsor advertising space allowed by the current ARA rules. Teams may refuse the rally sponsor's (Wagner Subaru) advertising by contacting the chairman and paying a \$2500 fee. All ARA series advertising must be properly displayed on competition cars.

7. Fuel

7.1 Competitors are required to supply/purchase their own fuel and must comply with the ARA fuel requirements noted in the ARA RTR and in ARA Bulletin 2026-2.

7.2 VP fuel will be available for delivery only and must be ordered by May 28th. Details are found at the following link: [VP Fuels order form](#)

7.3 Fuel ordered from VP Fuels will be delivered to M&M Fabrication, 18828 US-50, Chillicothe, OH 45601. An update will be posted to Sportity when VP delivers the fuel.

8. Reconnaissance (recce)

8.1 Drivers and co-drivers must be checked in at the event, prior to participating in recce.

8.2 Recce Info:

- The speed limit on stages during recce is 30 mph and will be monitored with the ARA RS Lite tracking system per ARA Bulletin 2026-4.
- The stages are open as posted in the Event Schedule with the following exceptions:
 - Courtney's Webb SS #11/16 & Irish Ridge SS #13/18, which are gated, will open at 7am on Wednesday and Thursday and close at 5pm on Wednesday and 4pm Thursday.
 - Yoctangee Street Stage SS#1/2 will be open from 3am Wednesday until 4pm on Thursday.
- All recce roads will be open to the public including logging trucks, forestry trucks, hunters, hikers, bikers, horses and the ODNR police.
- Vehicles used for recce must be quiet street vehicles with no lettering or advertising.
- There will be no organizer supplied course notes offered.

9. Check In / Registration

9.1 All participants (competitors and crew) must have completed the licensing process online <https://usacracing.redpodium.com/2026-ara-team-registration> and check in during the times noted in the event schedule. In person check-in is required.

9.2 Check-In will take place at the times and dates listed in the event schedule.

10. Scrutineering (Tech Inspection)

10.1 Scrutineering will be held at the Chillicothe Transit Garage during the times listed in the program by ***appointment only.***

- Appointments may be requested by sending an email to sofrtech@southernohioforestrally.com All requests will receive a confirmation email with the scheduled time. **Requests must be submitted by June 5, or a time will be assigned to you.**
- The email should clearly state:
 - Appointment hour requested – i.e., 2-3 pm, 3-4 pm, etc.
 - Car number and the name and phone number of the presenter.

10.2 All event required stickers and identification are to be in place when arriving at scrutineering. Competitor ID packages, including ARA door panels, series sponsor's decals, windshield decals, and number packages should be purchased in advance online at <https://rally.build/collections/vinyl/products/ara-number-backers-packages>. Event stickers will be provided at team check-in.

10.3 Only credentialed ARA officials, SOFR officials, and Crew for each vehicle are allowed in the scrutineering area. Logbooks will not be issued at the event without prior arrangement. If you need a Logbook, contact sofrtech@southernohioforestrally.com at least 14 days before the event.

10.4 The rally will use the RallySafe tracking, and timing system as detailed at www.americanrallyassociation.org/rally-safe. Units will be distributed during scrutineering. Teams must enter scrutineering with the fitting kit installed. If needed, rental RallySafe fitting kits are \$40 each, paid for during online entry. Units and kits must be returned at the final Parc Ferme or to an ARA Official after a DNF.

11. Service

11.1 Standard service spots are 20 feet by 50 feet.

- If all your service rigs don't fit within the standard space, you may purchase oversize or extra service spots with your registration.
- Teams with special service needs must contact the Chief of Service before Friday, June 5.

11.2 Service Locations:

- There is no service park on Thursday.
- Friday the service park is at Portsmouth West High School, 15332 US-52, West Portsmouth, OH 45663. All oversized or heavy rigs will be parked on the lower-level gravel bus lot.
- Saturday the service park is at Vinton County High School, 63910 US-50, McArthur, OH 45651.

11.3 Trailer parking and pre-event service space is available at M&M Fabrication, 18828 US-50, Chillicothe, OH 45601, contact Gary Timmons at 740-253-1197 for more information.

12. Testing and Shakedown

12.1 Group test sessions on a closed road representative of Southern Ohio Forest Rally stage surfaces will be available to interested competitors on Wednesday, June 10 -- a morning session from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM and an afternoon session from 1:30 PM to 4:30 PM. Sessions can be paid for during entry or added at any time in the Registrar Folder on Sportity under the entry update tab.

12.2 Practice other than the official test sessions of 12.1 or 12.3 will be in violation of RCR 6.9.1. Participation in the event reconnaissance during their scheduled times is not considered a violation.

12.3 Teams desiring a private test session should contact the event Chairperson.

13. Procedures of the Rally

13.1 There will be Parc Expose's held on Thursday at Chillicothe High School, 425 Yoctangee Pkwy, Chillicothe, OH 45601 and on Saturday on Route 50 in downtown McArthur Ohio. You are welcome to check in early, but not before the first check-in time. Check-in times will be as follows:

13.2 Friday's Leg 2 will start at TC2B (MTC) at the Friday Service Park. Start times will be assigned on the Friday Start Order. Check-in will follow the control procedures in RCR 5.3 (apart from RCR 5.3.4, as TC2B will have your timecard) TC2B will also be considered a Regrouping Control and any gaps created by cars not rejoining Leg 2 will be removed. Competitors are to be in the area of the MTC approximately 4 minutes before their assigned start time to allow time to be sorted into the correct order.

13.3 All control operations will be conducted per section 4 of the current ARA Rally Competition Rules and employ RallySafe consoles and tablets.

Stage starts will be counted down by the RallySafe console and monitored by the start marshal regarding jump starts.

All virtual chicanes will have a target minimum speed of 25 MPH.

Official time is Eastern Daylight Time as verified by RallySafe.

13.4 The rally will start with Super Special stages (SS #1 and 2).

13.5 The designated National Power Stage is SS #20 - Church of the Raccoons 2 - with 2-minute gaps for all competitors.

13.6 TC 2A, TC 10A, TC 19A (regional only) and TC20A (national) are designated as Main Time Controls and allow competitors to arrive early per ARA RCR 5.3.14.

13.7 Rejoining the event after Retirement. Competitors who have missed one or more controls and are Restarting After Retirement (RAR) or wish to rejoin as a Non-Competitive Entry (NCE), are required to complete and submit an inquiry on Sportity before they restart. The Clerk of the Course and Chief Scrutineer will verify that the team meets the safety requirements and have any required tracking or monitoring equipment before issuing a timecard for the Rally Re-Entry.

13.8 Vehicles will be impounded in Parc Ferme for final checks immediately following the final MTC at the Vinton County High School.

13.9 Podium Ceremonies for the Regional and National category winners will be conducted adjacent to the event finish at the Vinton County High School. The Vinton County School District is a drug and alcohol-free zone. SOFR participants are prohibited from the display or consumption of alcohol while on the property. The finishers' podium ceremonies will be conducted with alcohol-free champagne for the spray.

13.10 Officials will be identified by their credential card displayed on a lanyard. Marshals will have a high visibility vest in addition to their lanyard.

13.11 Competitors who are permanently retiring from the competition are required to complete the withdrawal form on Sportity and hand in their ARA provided equipment to an ARA Official.

14. Sanctioned Exemptions

14.1 SS #1 and SS #2 will be started at 30 second intervals. A bulletin will be issued outlining the procedures prior to the event.

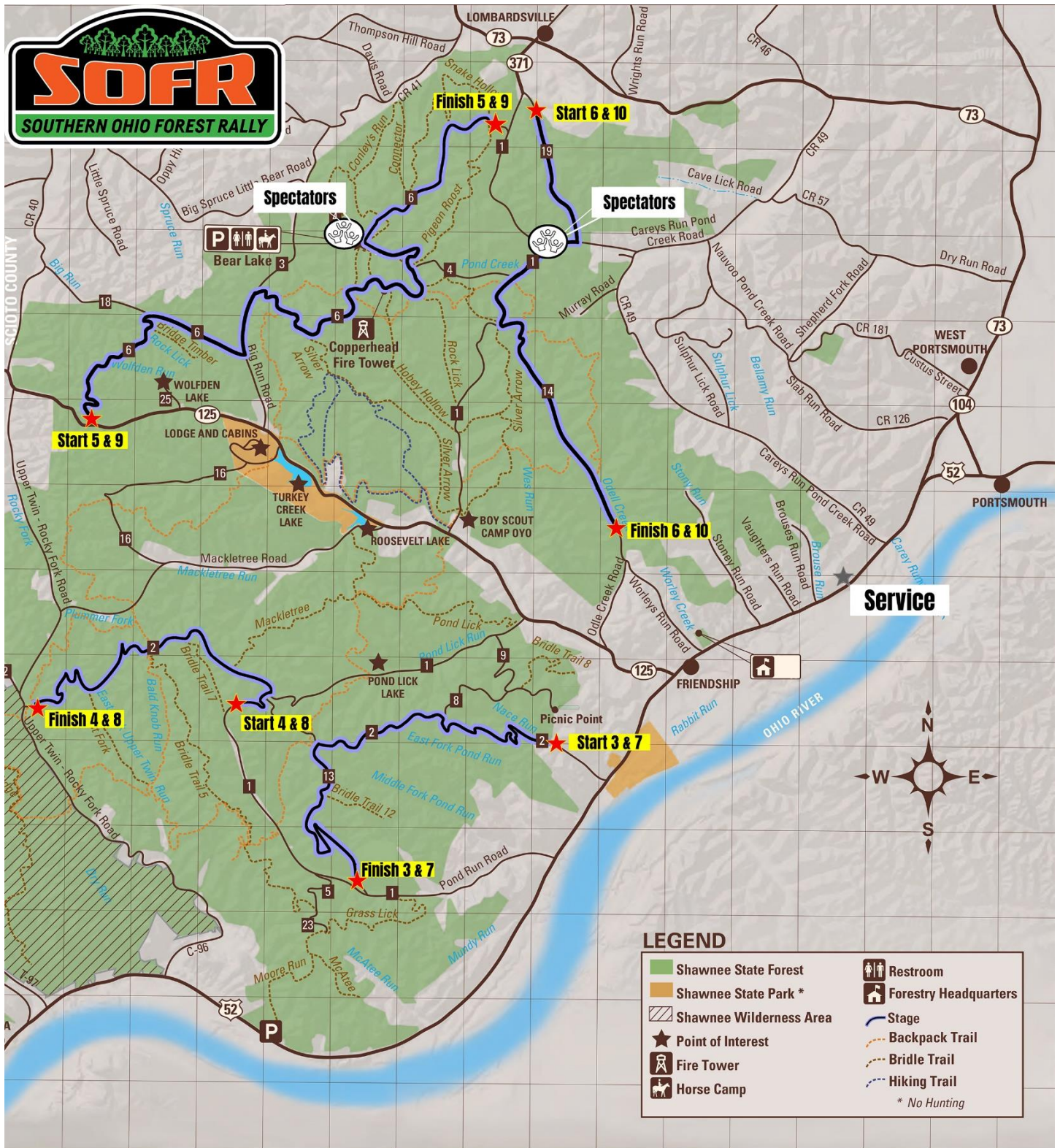
